### 3 Wishes® An Eerie Welcome Collection

- ⅔ yd – An Eerie Welcome Panel (22295-PNL-CTN-D)
- 2 ⅛ yds – Welcome Party (22289-MLT-CTN-D)
- 1 ¾ yds – Haunted Hollow (22291-GRY-CTN-D)
- 1 ⅞ yds – Ghoulis Ghoures (22293-ORG-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- ⅝ yd – At Your Service (22290-BLK-CTN-D)
- ⅝ yd – Rest in Peace (22294-MLT-CTN-D)
- 5 ¼ yds – Neighborhood Watch (22292-GRY-CTN-D) for Backing

### Not included in the 3 Wishes® An Eerie Welcome Collection

- 1 ⅛ yds – Solid White Cotton

### Additional Supplies Needed:

- 72 in x 92 in (182.88 cm x 233.68 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

# Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

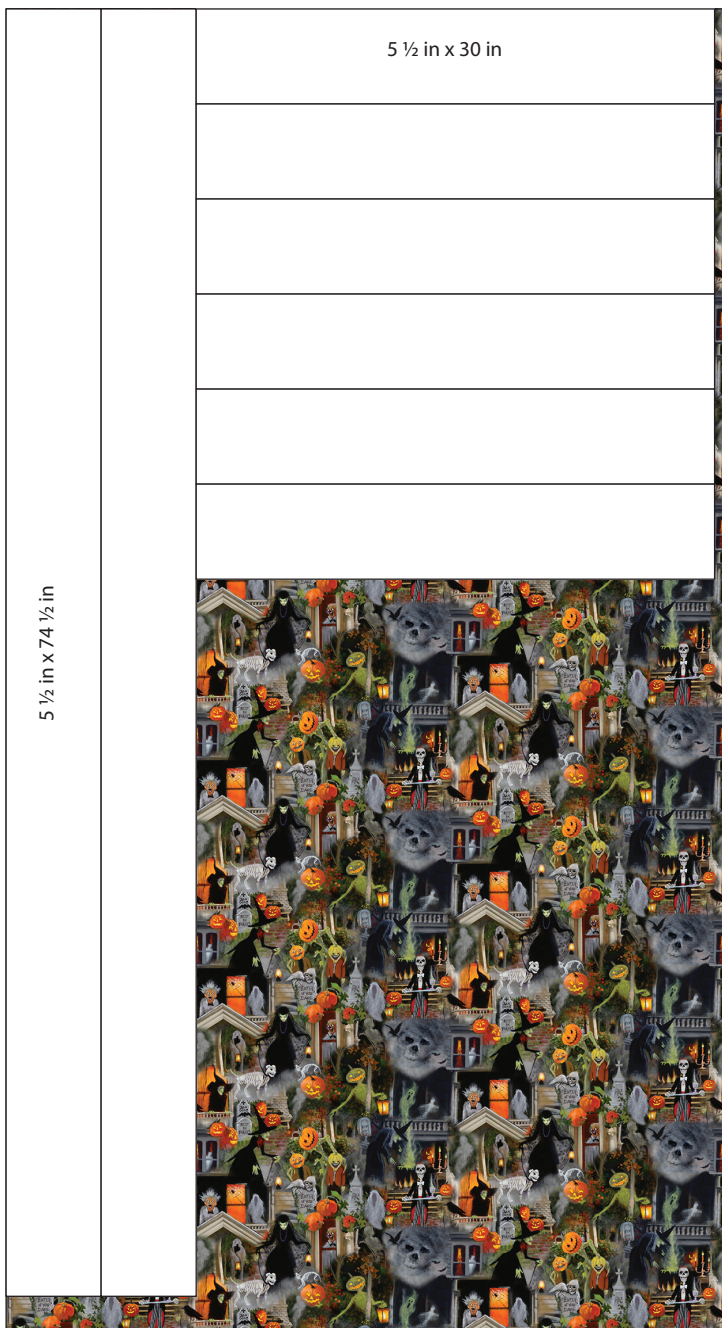
**Note:** A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

# Cutting

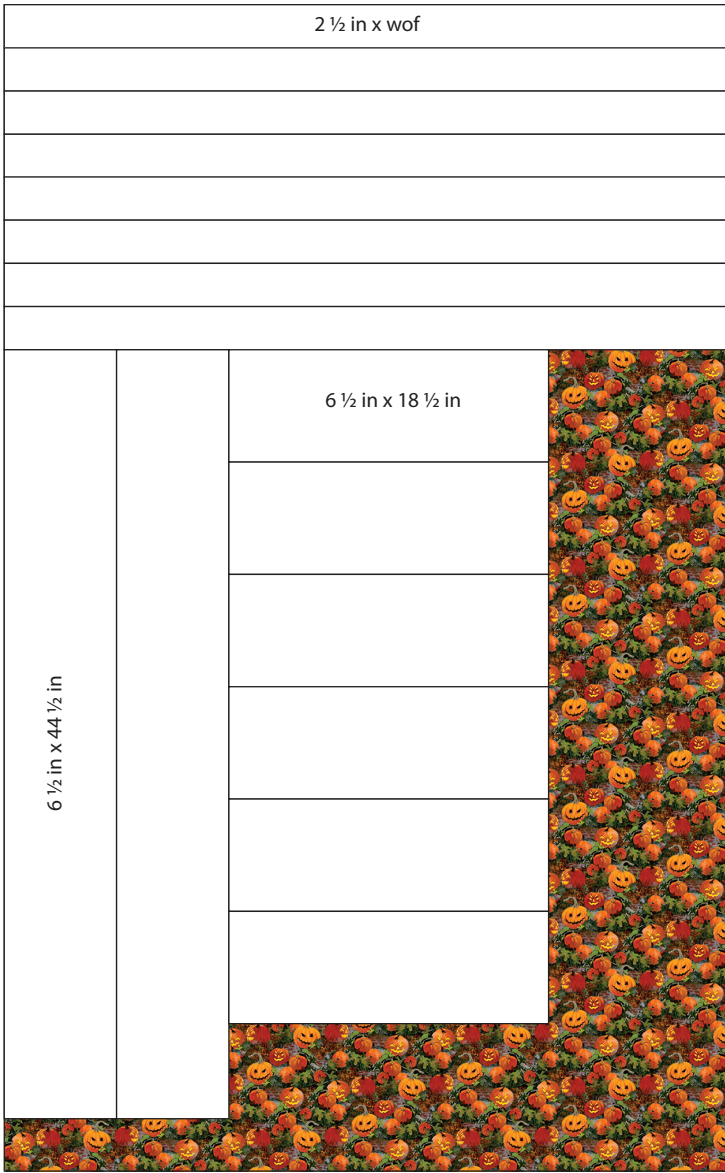
Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.



**An Eerie Welcome Panel (22295-PNL-CTN-D)**  
 7/8 yd (60.96 cm x 106.68 cm)  
 Fussy Cut 1 – 22 ½ in x 42 ½ in  
 (57.15 cm x 107.95 cm)



**Welcome Party (22289-MLT-CTN-D) – 2 1/8 yds (194.31 cm x 106.68 cm)**  
 Cut 2 – 5 ½ in x 74 ½ in (13.97 cm x 189.23 cm)  
 Cut 6 – 5 ½ in x 30 in (13.97 cm x 76.20 cm)



**Ghoulish Ghoures (22293-ORG-CTN-D) – 1 7/8 yds (171.45 cm x 106.68 cm)**  
 Cut 8 – 2 1/2 in x wof (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) for Binding  
 Cut 2 – 6 1/2 in x 44 1/2 in (16.51 cm x 113.03 cm)  
 Cut 6 – 6 1/2 in x 18 1/2 in (16.51 cm x 46.99 cm)



**Haunted Hollow (22291-GRY-CTN-D) – 1 3/4 yds (160.02 cm x 106.68 cm)**  
 Cut 2 – 2 1/2 in x 58 1/2 in (6.35 cm x 148.59 cm)  
 Cut 4 – 2 1/2 in x 21 1/2 in (6.35 cm x 54.61 cm)



# Sewing

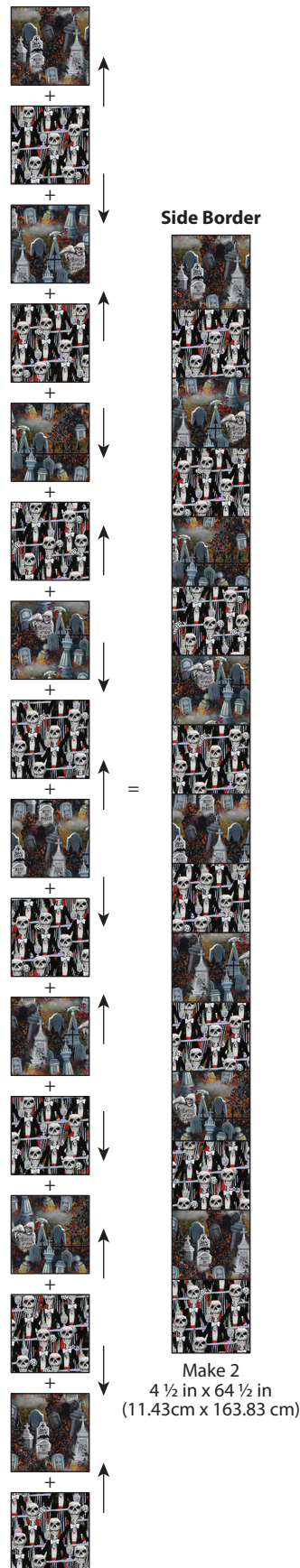
1. Sew three Solid White strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$  in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two Solid White strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm). Refer to Diagram A to sew one Solid White strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm) RST to each side of the An Eerie Welcome Panel  $22\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (57.15 cm x 107.95 cm). Sew one Solid White strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $24\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm) RST to the top and bottom of the An Eerie Welcome Panel to make the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure  $24\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $44\frac{1}{2}$  in (62.23 cm x 113.03 cm).

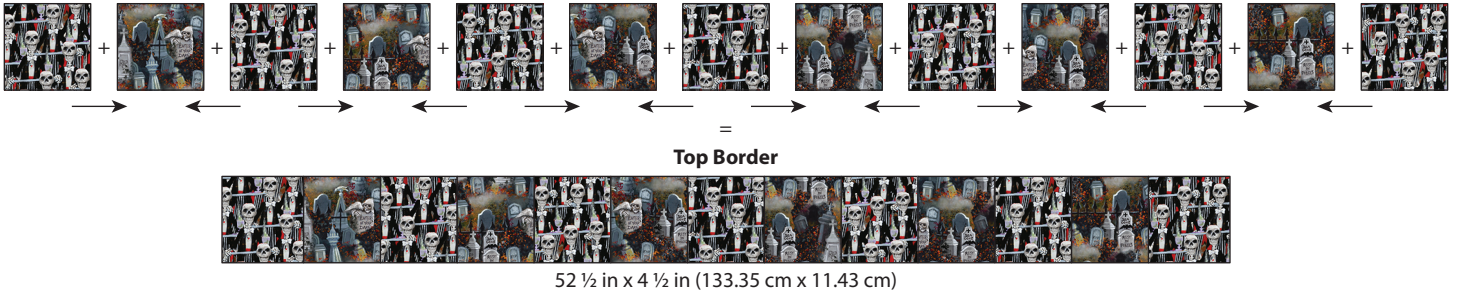
2. Place eight Rest in Peace squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) and eight At Your Service squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press to make one Side Border which should measure  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $64\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 163.83 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of the design. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

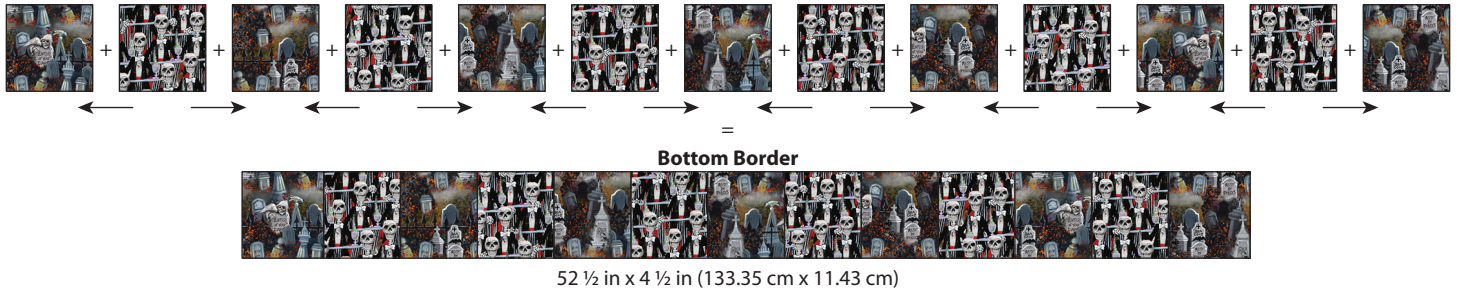
3. Place seven At Your Service squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) and six Rest in Peace squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) as shown in Diagram C. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border which should measure  $52\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (133.35 cm x 11.43 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of the design.

4. Place seven Rest in Peace squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) and six At Your Service squares  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Bottom Border which should measure  $52\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $4\frac{1}{2}$  in (133.35 cm x 11.43 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of the design.

5. Refer to Diagram E to place the borders around the An Eerie Welcome Quilt Center 24 ½ in x 44 ½ in (62.23 cm x 113.03 cm). Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin, matching center and ends. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing.

The completed Quilt Top should measure 64 ½ in x 84 ½ in (163.83 cm x 214.63 cm). **Note:** Check orientation of the designs.

#### **First Border**

Sides: 2 – Ghoulish Ghoulds strips 6 ½ in x 44 ½ in (16.51 cm x 113.03 cm)

Top and Bottom: 2 – Ghoulish Ghoulds strips 6 ½ in x 36 ½ in (16.51 cm x 92.71 cm)

Sew three Ghoulish Ghoulds strips 6 ½ in x 18 ½ in (16.51 cm x 46.99 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut one Ghoulish Ghoulds strips 6 ½ in x 36 ½ in (16.51 cm x 92.71 cm).

Repeat to make a second Ghoulish Ghoulds strips 6 ½ in x 36 ½ in (16.51 cm x 92.71 cm).

#### **Second Border**

Sides: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 56 ½ in (3.81 cm x 143.51 cm)

Sew three Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

Top and Bottom: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 38 ½ in (3.81 cm x 97.79 cm)

#### **Third Border**

Sides: 2 – Haunted Hollow strips 2 ½ in x 58 ½ in (6.35 cm x 148.59 cm)

Top and Bottom: 2 – Haunted Hollow strips 2 ½ in x 42 ½ in (6.35 cm x 107.95 cm)

Sew four Haunted Hollow strips 2 ½ in x 21 ½ in (6.35 cm x 54.61 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

#### **Fourth Border**

Sides: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 62 ½ in (3.81 cm x 158.75 cm)

Sew three Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

Top and Bottom: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 44 ½ in (3.81 cm x 113.03 cm)

Sew three Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

#### **Fifth Border**

Sides: 2 – Side Borders

Top and Bottom: Top Border and Bottom Border

#### **Sixth Border**

Sides: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 72 ½ in (3.81 cm x 184.15 cm)

Sew four Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

Top and Bottom: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 54 ½ in (3.81 cm x 138.43 cm)

Sew three Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

#### **Seventh Border**

Sides: 2 – Welcome Party strips 5 ½ in x 74 ½ in (13.97 cm x 189.23 cm)

Top and Bottom: 2 – Welcome Party strips 5 ½ in x 64 ½ in (13.97 cm x 163.83 cm)

Sew six Welcome Party strips 5 ½ in x 30 in (13.97 cm x 76.2 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two.

# Finishing

12. To make the Neighborhood Watch Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in x 92 in (106.68 cm x 233.68 cm).

**Note:** Check the orientation of the design. Pin and sew the pieces RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram F. Trim the Back to measure 72 in x 92 in (182.88 cm x 233.68 cm).

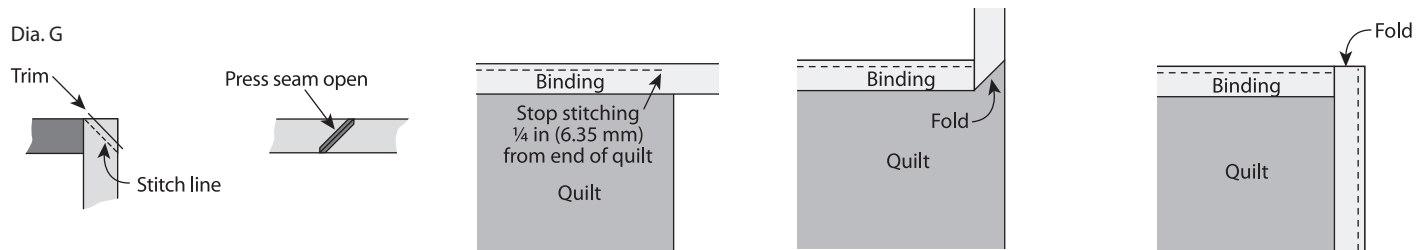
Backing

13. Press the finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.

14. Once the quilting is complete, square up the corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

15. To make the An Eerie Welcome Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the eight Ghoulish Ghourds strips 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. G). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
