- 7/8 yd - Snowflake Lodge Patch (22213-MLT-CTN-D)
- $7 / 8$ yd - Ski Lodge (22215-WHT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Winter Woods (22214-WHT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Woodgrain Stars (22216-GRN-CTN-D)
- 4 yds - Woodgrain Stars (22216-GRN-CTN-D) for Backing


## Not included in 3 Wishes ${ }^{\otimes}$ Snowflake Lodge Collection:

- $1 \frac{1}{8}$ yds - Coordinating Solid Green Cotton

## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 72 in x 82 in ( $182.88 \mathrm{~cm} \times 208.28 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric
Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.

Cut $84-1 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to sew a Solid Mint Green strip $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of one Ski Lodge square $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$. Sew one Solid Mint Green strip $11 / 2$ in $\times 101 / 2$ in RST to the top and bottom of the Ski Lodge square to make Block 1 measuring $10 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 10^{1 / 2}$ in ( $26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make ten Block 1 squares.

2. Refer to Diagram B to sew a Solid Mint Green strip $11 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to each side of one Snowflake Lodge Patch square $8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one Solid Mint Green strip $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 101 / 2$ in RST to the top and bottom of the Snowflake Lodge Patch square to make Block 2 measuring $10 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 10^{1 / 2}$ in $(26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make eleven Block 1 squares.

3. Place two Winter Woods strips $1 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $3.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), two Solid White strips $11 / 4$ in $\times 51 / 2$ in $(3.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$ and one Woodgrain Stars strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 51 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram C. Pin RST, sew and press to make a Unit 1 measuring 5 $1 / 2$ in $\times 51 / 2$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of designs. Repeat to make 42 Unit 1 squares.

4. Place two Snowshoes and Sleds strips $1 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$, two Solid White strips $11 / 4$ in $\times 51 / 2$ in ( $3.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and one Diagonal Stripe strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 5^{1 / 2}$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make a Unit 2 measuring $51 / 2$ in $\times 5^{1 / 2}$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 13.97 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of designs. Repeat to make 42 Unit 2 squares.

5. Place two Unit 1 squares and two Unit 2 squares together in two rows as shown in Diagram E. Pin the top two Unit squares RST and sew, then the same with the bottom two Unit squares. Pin the rows RST and sew to make a Block Three measuring $101 / 2$ in $\times 101 / 2$ in ( $26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of Units before sewing. Repeat to make 21 Block 3 squares.

6. Place all the Blocks into rows as follows. Pin the blocks in each row RST, sew and press to make Rows 1-7. Note: Check orientation of Blocks before sewing. Each row should measure $601 / 2$ in $\times 10^{1 / 2}$ in $(153.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$.
Refer to Diagram F for Rows 1 \& 5: Block 1, Block 3, Block 2, Block 3, Block 1, Block 3.
Refer to Diagram G for Rows 2 \& 6: Block 3, Block 2, Block 3, Block 1, Block 3, Block 2.
Refer to Diagram H for Rows 3 \& 7: Block 2, Block 3, Block 1, Block 3, Block 2, Block 3.
Refer to Diagram I for Row 4: Block 3, Block 1, Block 3, Block 2, Block 3, Block 1.

7. Place the Rows in order 1 to 7 as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Quilt Center. Note: Check orientation of Rows before sewing. The Quilt Center should measure $60 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 701 / 2$ in $(153.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 179.07 \mathrm{~cm})$.

8. Sew four Snowshoes and Sleds strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip, cut two Snowshoes and Sleds strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 701 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 179.07 \mathrm{~cm})$. Refer to Diagram K to sew one Snowshoes and Sleds strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 701 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 179.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of the Quilt Center.
9. Sew four Snowshoes and Sleds strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip, cut two Snowshoes and Sleds strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 641 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 163.83 \mathrm{~cm})$. Refer to Diagram K to sew one Snowshoes and Sleds strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 641 / 2 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 163.83 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top. The completed Quilt Top measures $641 / 2$ in $\times 741 / 2$ in $(163.83 \mathrm{~cm} \times 179.07 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## Finishing

10. To make the Woodgrain Stars Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in $\times 72$ in ( $106.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin and sew the pieces RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram L. Note: Check orientation of designs. Trim the Back to measure $72 \mathrm{in} x 72$ in ( $182.88 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

11. Press the finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
12. Once the quilting is complete, square up the corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
13. To make the Snowflake Lodge Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the Christmas Damask strips
$21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. M). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
