- $13 / 4$ yds - Wildflower Field (21494-MLT-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- 1 yd - Follow the Leader Panel (21500-PNL-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ - Bear Playtime (21497-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Spring Bunnies (21496-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 2$ yd - Spotted Deer (21493-MLT-CTN-D)
- 5 yds - Wildflower Field (21494-MLT-CTN-D) for Backing

Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\circledR}$ New Beginnings Collection

- 1 yd - Solid White Cotton


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 83 in x 89 in ( $210.82 \mathrm{~cm} \times 226.06 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric
Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finished process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.


Dogwood Flight (21498-BLU-CTN-D) - 2 yards ( $182.88 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut $2-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 691 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 176.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $6-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 29$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Wildflower Field ( $\mathbf{2 1 4 9 4 - M L T - C T N - D ) ~ - ~} 13 / 4$ yard ( $160.02 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut $2-5 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 571 / 2$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 4-5 $1 / 2$ in $\times 31$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $11-2 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 31$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Binding


Bear Playtime ( $21497-M L T-C T N-D)-1 / 2$ yard ( $45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut $10-61 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$


Follow the Leader Panel (21500-PNL-CTN-D) - 1 yard ( 91.44 cm x wof) Fussy Cut $1-34 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 40 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$


Spring Bunnies ( $21496-M L T-C T N-D$ ) $-1 / 2$ yard ( $45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut $10-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$


Solid White - 1 yard ( $91.44 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut 6-2 in $\times 42$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 8 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 42 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{11 / 2}{}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 36 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm})$


Spotted Deer ( $21493-M L T-C T N-D)-1 / 2$ yard ( $45.72 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ wof)
Cut $10-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 61 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Seming

Follow Steps 1-5 to piece the borders. The (4) Inner White Borders and the (2) Wildflower Side Borders are cut to use and will not need piecing. Follow step 6 as a guide to piecing the quilt top together. Either attach the borders to the Quilt Center as you go, or make all them all first and then attach.

1. Sew three Solid White 2 in $\times 42$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips end to end RST with diagonal seams and press as shown in Diagram A. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. Repeat to make 2. From one sewn strip, cut two Middle White Side Border strips measuring 2 in $\times 541 / 2$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm})$. From the other sewn strip, cut two Middle White Top and Bottom Border strips measuring 2 in $\times 511 / 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 130.81 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

2. Sew four Solid White $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 42$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips end to end RST with diagonal seams and presss as shown in Diagram D. Trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). Repeat to make 2. From one sewn strip, cut two Outer White Side Border strips measuring $11 / 2$ in $\times 671 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 171.45 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). From the other sewn strip, cut two Outer White Top and Bottom Border strips measuring $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 631 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 161.29 \mathrm{~cm})$.

3. Position seven $61 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ squares as follows below for each of the Left and Right Borders, listed from top to bottom. Position eight $61 / 2$ in ( 16.51 cm ) squares as follows below for each of the Top and Bottom Borders, listed from left to right. Note: Check orientation of designs. Pin each piece RST, sew and press as shown in Diagram B to make the Forest Animals Borders measuring $61 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Left Pieced Squares Border: Deer, Bunnies, Bears, Deer, Bunnies, Bears, Deer - $61 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 421 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Right Pieced Squares Border: Deer, Bears, Bunnies, Deer, Bears, Bunnies, Deer - $61 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 421 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$. Top Pieced Squares Border: Bears, Bunnies, Deer, Bears, Bunnies, Deer, Bears, Bunnies - 6112 in $\times 421 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$. Bottom Pieced Squares Border: Bunnies, Bears, Deer, Bunnies, Bears, Deer, Bunnies, Bear - $61 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$.

4. Sew four Wildflower Field $51 / 2$ in $\times 31$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 78.74 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips end to end RST and press as shown in Diagram C. From the sewn strip, cut two Wildflower Top and Bottom Border strips measuring $51 / 2$ in $\times 611 / 2$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 156.21 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

5. Sew six Dogwood Flight $61 / 2$ in $\times 29$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips end to end RST and press as shown in Diagram E. From the sewn strip, cut two Dogwood Top and Bottom Border strips $61 / 2$ in $\times 751 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 191.77 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Refer to Diagram F to sew each Border around the Panel rectangle $341 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $87.63 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), adding sides first and then the top and bottom of each border. Note: Check orientation of each border before sewing. Pin RST, matching centers, sew and press. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. Tip: If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing. Finished Quilt Top measures $751 / 2$ in $\times 811 / 2$ in ( $191.77 \mathrm{~cm} \times 207.01 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 1st Inner White Borders

Sides: 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top/Bottom: 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt Top measures $361 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $92.71 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 2nd Forest Animals Borders

Sides: $2-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) vertical rectangles
Top/Bottom: 2 - $6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) horizontal rectangles
Quilt Top measures 48 ½ in x $541 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 3rd Middle White Borders

Sides: 2 - 2 in $\times 541 / 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top/Bottom: $2-2$ in $\times 51 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 130.81 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt Top measures $51 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 541 / 2$ in ( $130.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 138.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 4th Wildflower Borders

Sides: 2 - $51 / 2$ in x $691 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 176.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Top/Bottom: 2 - $5 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $61 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $13.97 \mathrm{~cm} \times 156.21 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Quilt Top measures $61 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 671 / 2$ in ( $156.21 \mathrm{~cm} \times 171.45 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 5th Outer White Borders

Sides: 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $671 ⁄ 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 171.45 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top/Bottom: 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $631 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 161.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Quilt Top measures $631 / 2$ in x $691 / 2$ in ( $161.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 176.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## 6th Dogwood Borders

Sides: $2-61 / 2$ in $\times 691 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 176.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Top/Bottom: $2-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 751 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 191.77 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Quilt Top measures $751 / 2$ in $\times 81 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $191.77 \mathrm{~cm} \times 207.01 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


## Finishing

13. To make the Wildflower Field Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in $x 89$ in ( $106.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 226.06 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of the designs. Pin and sew the pieces RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram M. Trim the Back to measure 83 in $x 89$ in ( $210.82 \mathrm{~cm} \times 226.06 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
14. Press the finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
15. Once the quilting is complete, square up the corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
16. To make the Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the Wildflower Fields $21 / 2$ in $\times 31 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 80.01 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in ( 5.08 cm ) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. H). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
