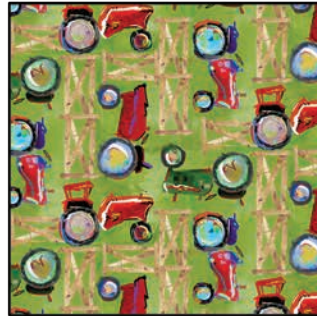

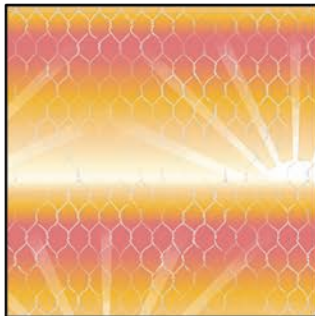

3/8 yard (0.35m)	Tossed Animals (C) 23043-BLU-CTN-D
1 1/8 yards (1.03m)	Solid White (D) 23044-GRN-CTN-D
3/8 yard (0.35m)	Farm Tractors (E) 23044-GRN-CTN-D
7/8 yard (0.80m)	Black Sheep (F) 23048-GRY-CTN-D
5/8 yard (0.58m)	Chirpy Chicks (G) 23045-WHT-CTN-D
1 1/8 yards (1.03m)	Floral Farm (H)* 23049-TRQ-CTN-D
5/8 yard (0.58m)	Packed Barns (I) 23046-RED-CTN-D
4 yards (3.66m)	Chirpy Chicks (Backing) 23045-WHT-CTN-D

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Barnyard Friends 36in Panel (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 34 1/2" x 40 1/2" rectangle centered on the panel.

From the Farm Sunrise (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 37 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Tossed Animals (C), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" squares.

From the Solid White (D), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 17 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/4" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (124) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Farm Tractors (E), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9 1/2" squares.

From the Black Sheep (F), cut:

- (1) 17 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 17 1/2" strips.
- (2) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the Chirpy Chicks (G), cut:

- (4) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/4" x 17 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/4" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the Floral Farm (H), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4 1/2" squares.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Packed Barns (I), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4 1/2" squares.

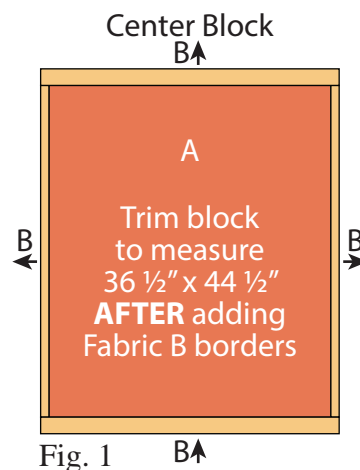
From the Chirpy Chicks (Backing), cut:

- (2) 72" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 80" back.

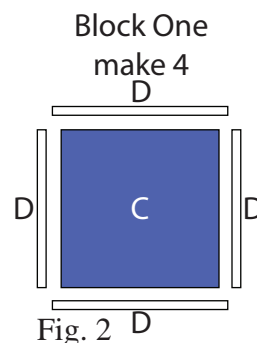
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

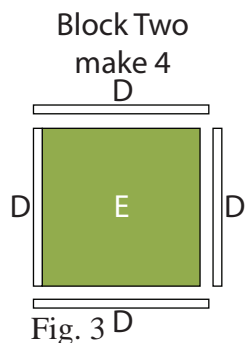
- Sew (1) 2" x 40 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 34 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 3" x 37 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 36 1/2" x 44 1/2".**



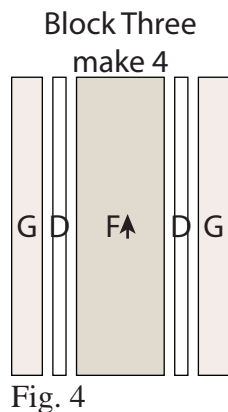
- Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) 10 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



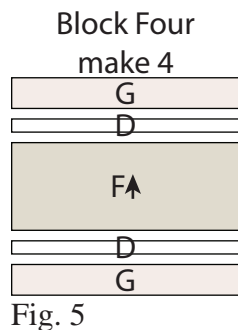
3. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) 10 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.



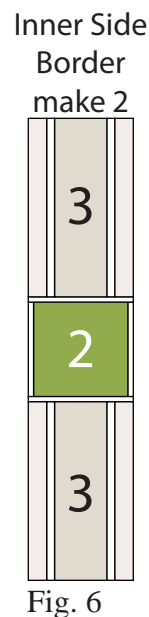
4. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 17 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 5 1/2" x 17 1/2" Fabric F strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 17 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 10 1/2" x 17 1/2" Block Three strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (4) Block Three strips total.



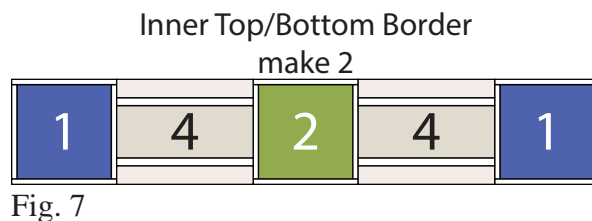
5. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 13 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and bottom of (1) 5 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric F strip lengthwise. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 13 1/2" Fabric G strip to the top and bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 13 1/2" x 10 1/2" Block Four strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (3) Block Four strips total.



6. Sew (1) Block Three strip to the top and bottom of (1) Block Two square to make (1) 10 1/2" x 44 1/2" Inner Side Border (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.



7. Sew (1) Block Four strip to each side of (1) Block Two square. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the 56 1/2" x 10 1/2" Inner Top Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.



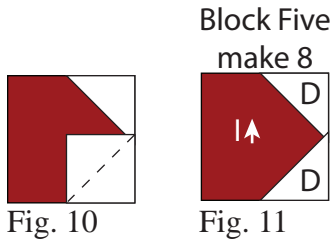
8. Place (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square on the top right corner of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 9).



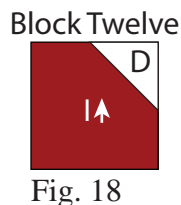
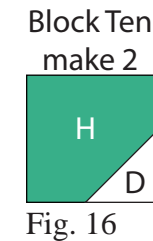
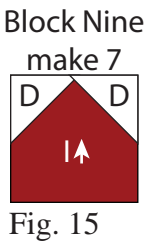
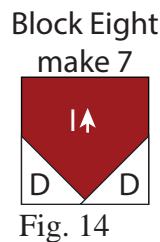
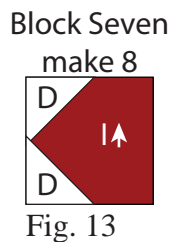
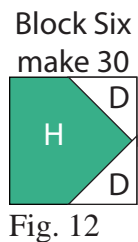

9. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric D square to the bottom right corner of the Fabric I square to make (1) 4 ½" Block Five square (Fig. 11).

10. Repeat Steps 8-9 to make (8) Block Five squares total.

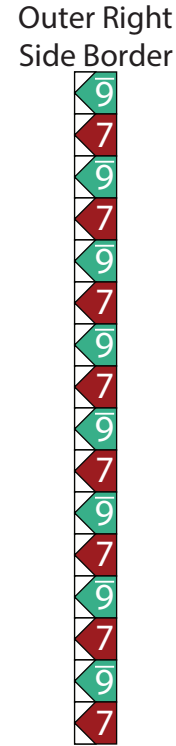
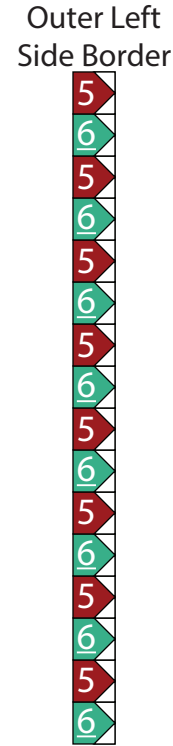


11. Repeat Steps 8-9 and refer to Figures 12-18 for fabric identification, placement orientation and seam direction to make the indicated number of 4 ½" block squares for Block Six through Block Twelve.



12. Sew together (8) Block Five squares and (8) Block Six squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the 4 ½" x 64 ½" Outer Left Side Border (Fig. 19).

13. Sew together (8) Block Six squares and (8) Block Seven squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the 4 ½" x 64 ½" Outer Right Side Border (Fig. 20).



14. Sew together (7) Block Eight squares and (7) Block Six squares alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) Block Ten square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Block Eleven square to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make the 4 ½" x 64 ½" Outer Top Border (Fig. 21).



15. Sew together (7) Block Six squares and (7) Block Nine squares alternating them from left to right. Sew (1) Block Twelve square to the left end of the newly sewn strip and (1) Block Ten square to the right end of the newly sewn strip to make the 4 ½" x 64 ½" Outer Bottom Border (Fig. 22).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

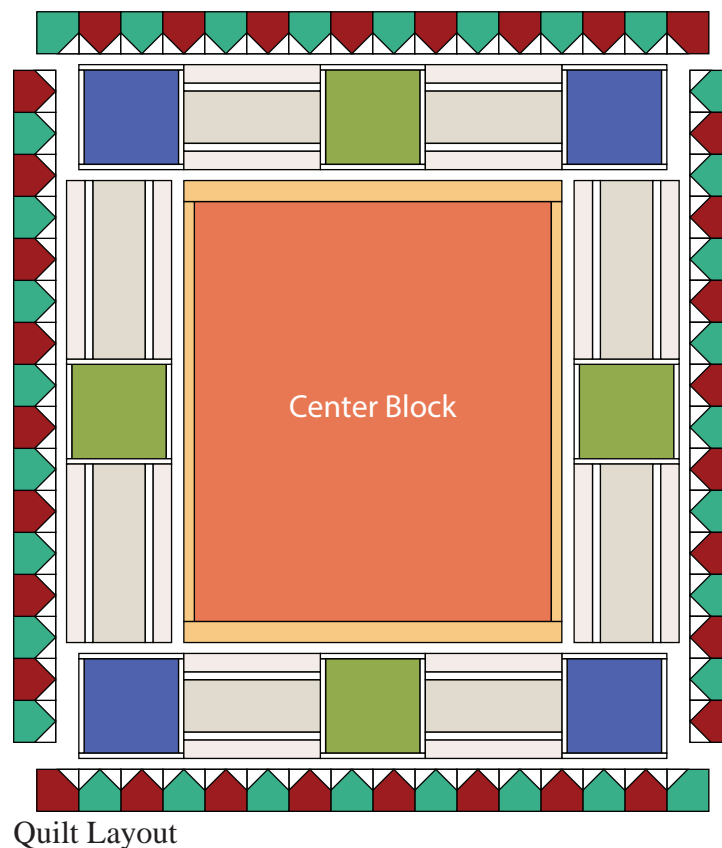
16. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.



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
