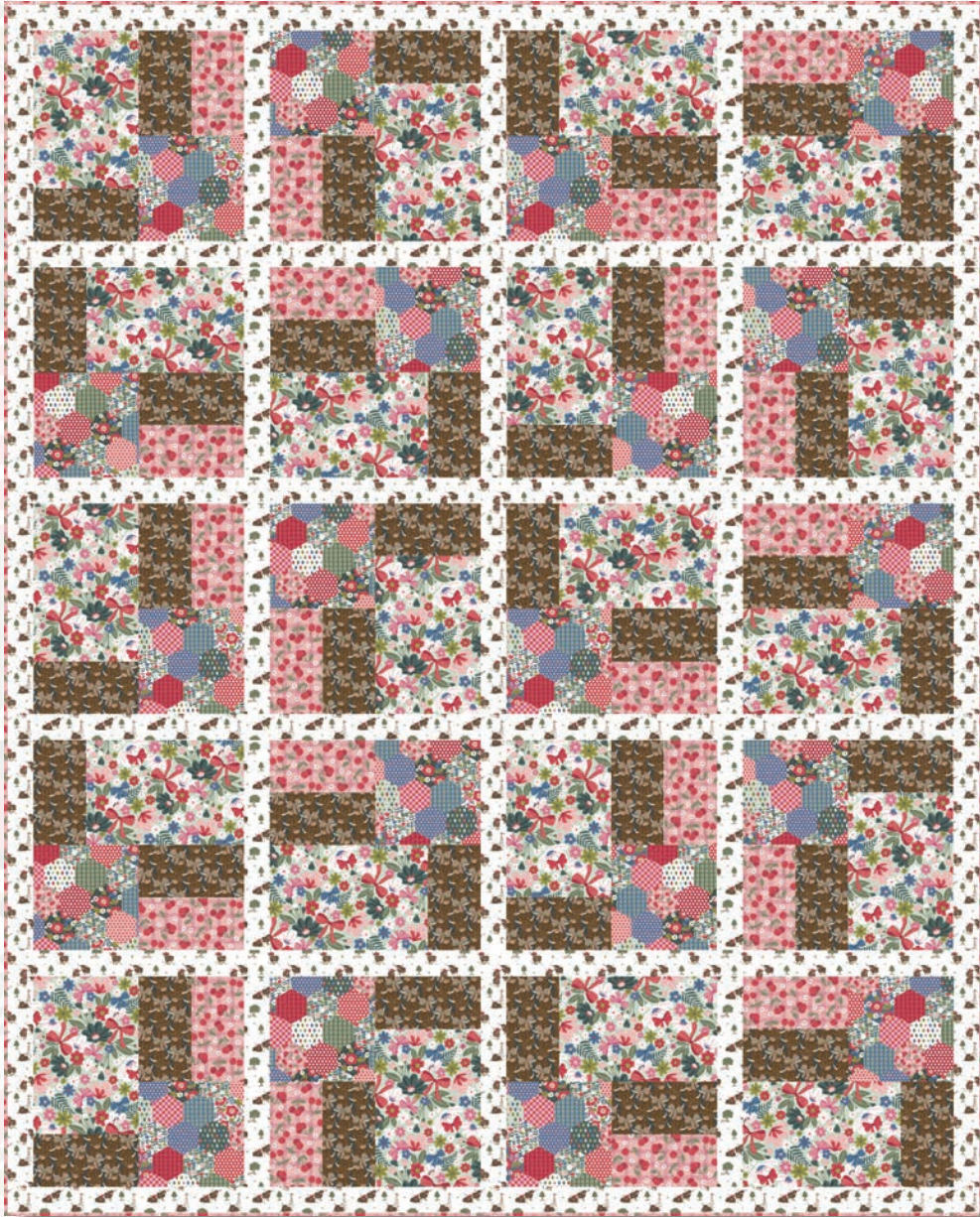

# LONG HAIRIED BEAUTY

### Materials

1 $\frac{7}{8}$ yards (1.72m)	Bows and Flowers (A) 22983-MNT-CTN-D
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.38m)	Packed Hazel (B) 22984-TEA-CTN-D
1 $\frac{1}{2}$ yards (1.38m)	Cherries Jubilee (C)* 22986-PNK-CTN-D
1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yards (1.15m)	Quilt Market (D) 22987-MLT-CTN-D
2 yards (1.83m)	Highland Farm (E) 22985-WHT-CTN-D
5 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards (5.26m)	Highland Farm (Backing) 22985-WHT-CTN-D

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Bows and Flowers (A), cut:

- (7) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

#### From the Packed Hazel (B), cut:

- (3) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (5) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

#### From the Cherries Jubilee (C), cut:

- (5) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (9) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Quilt Market (D), cut:

- (5) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

#### From the Highland Farm (E), cut:

- (2) 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (25) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (11) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 74  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

#### From the Highland Farm (Backing), cut:

- (2) 100" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 82" x 100" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to the top of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to make the left column. Sew (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the left side of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise. Sew the newly sewn square to the top of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the right column. Sew together the (2) columns lengthwise to make (1) 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

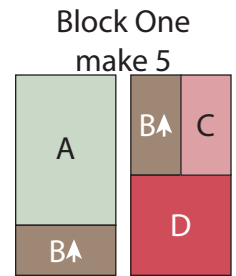

2. Sew (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the left side of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip lengthwise. Sew the newly sewn square to the bottom of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the left column. Sew (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to make the right column. Sew together the (2) columns lengthwise to make (1) 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block Two squares total.

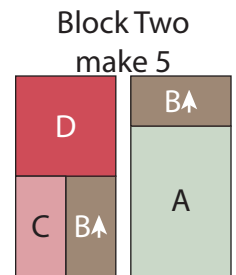

3. Sew (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the left side of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip to make the top row. Sew (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise. Sew the newly sewn square to the right side of (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 16  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (5) Block Three squares total.

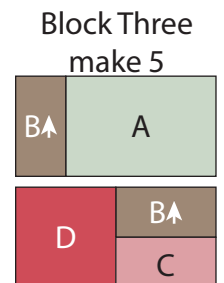
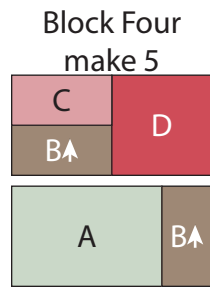

4. Sew (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) 8 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B strip lengthwise. Sew the newly sewn square to the left side of (1) 8 1/2" Fabric D square to make the top row. Sew (1) 8 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric A strip to the left side of (1) 4 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 16 1/2" Block Four square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (5) Block Four squares total.



square and (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip, in that order from left to right to make Row One.

6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to the Quilt Layout for fabric and unit identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two through Row Five.

7. Sew together (6) 2 1/2" x 74 1/2" Fabric E strips and the (5) pieced Rows in numerical order, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the quilt top.

8. Layer and quilt as desired.

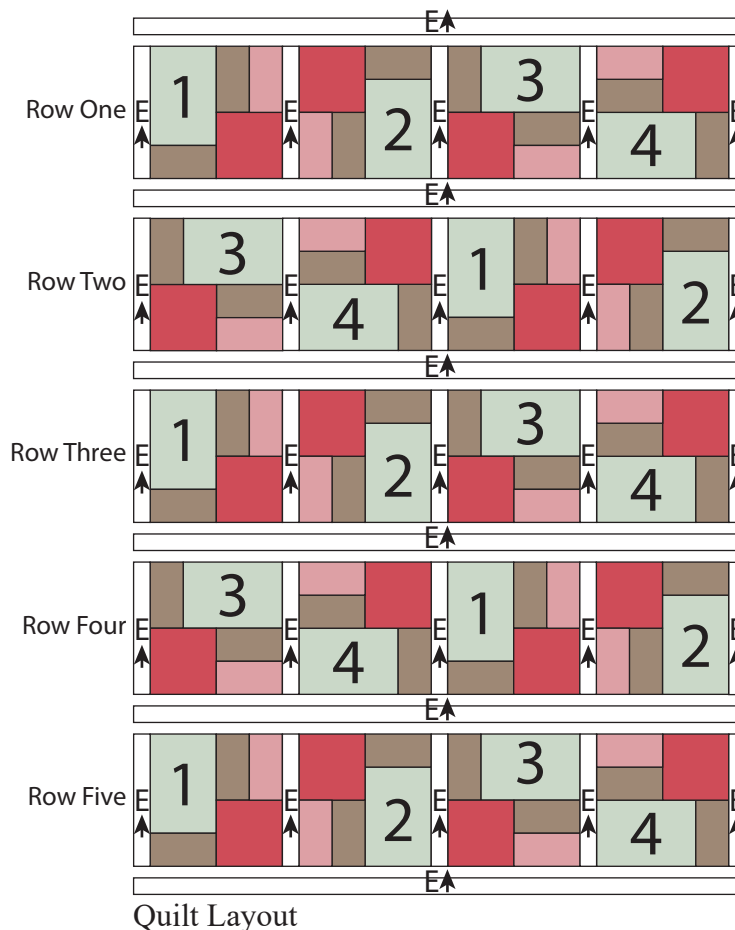
9. Sew the (9) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired.

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

5. Sew together (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Block Three square, (1) 2 1/2" x 16 1/2" Fabric E strip, (1) Block Four



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
