



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

Distinguished Gentleman (Backing)

22968-MLT-CTN-D

From the Purrfectly Playful 36in Panel (A):

• Fussy cut (9) 10 ½" squares each centered on a block.

From the Bold Butterflies (B), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 2" x 13 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 ½" strips.

From the Solid White (C), cut:

- (8) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 3 ½" squares.
- (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Purr-ty Texture (D), cut:

- (7) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares.

From the Kaleidoscope Knit (E), cut:

• (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 3 ½" squares.

From the Purrfect Purr-ito (F), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 57 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (2) 5 ½" x 67 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Solid Black (G), cut:

• (7) 2 ½"x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Distinguished Gentleman (Backing), cut:

• (2) 75" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 75" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure** 12 ½" x 12 ½". Repeat to make (9) Unit 1 squares total.



2. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric C square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 3).






- 3. Place another 3 ½" Fabric C square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (40) Unit 2 strips total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (32) Unit 3 strips.








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
6. Sew together (2) Unit 2 strips end to end to make (1) 12 ½" x 3 ½" Unit 4 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (20) Unit 4 strips total.




7. Sew together (2) Unit 3 strips end to end to make (1) 12 ½" x 3 ½" Unit 5 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (16) Unit 5 strips total.




8. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 18 ½" Block One square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.



9. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 18 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.



- 10. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three (Fig. 11).
- 11. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 11).
- 12. Sew together the (3) Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $54 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $54 \frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block.




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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 13. Sew (1) 2" x 54 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 57 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 57 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and bottom of Center Block to make the quilt top.

- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.
