- $3 / 8$ yd - Pieced Patchwork (20243-MLT-CTN-D)
- $3 / 8$ yd - Americana Toss (20246-WHT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 4 \mathrm{yd}$ - Ditzy Floral (20244-WHT-CTN-D)
- $2 ½$ yds - Freedom Blocks (20242-MLT-CTN-D) for Backing

Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\circledR}$

- $11 / 3 \mathrm{yds}$ - Solid White


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 56 in x 56 in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

## Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to make the Half-Square Triangle (HST) Units. Note: Two squares yield two HST Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Solid White square 5 in $\times 5$ in ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Place a Solid White square on top of a Allover Stars square 5 in $\times 5$ in ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with RST and sew $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) away from the line on both sides. Cut on the drawn line; press. Repeat to make a total of 32 Allover Stars Half-Square Triangle Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2 \mathrm{in}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$. Square up and trim if necessary.

2. Repeat Step 1 and follow Diagram B using four Solid White squares 5 in $\times 5$ in ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and four Ditzy Floral squares 5 in $\times 5$ in ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make eight Ditzy Floral Half-Square Triangle Units $4^{1 / 2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Triangle Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Repeat Step 1 and follow Diagram D using eight Solid White squares 5 in $\times 5$ in ( $12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and eight Pieced Patchwork squares 5 in $\times 5$ in $(12.7 \mathrm{~cm} \times 12.7 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make sixteen Pieced Patchwork Half-Square Triangle Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

5. Refer to Diagram E and place one Solid White square $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, one Allover Stars square $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, and two Allover Stars HST Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ in two rows of two as shown. Pin the squares in each row RST and sew; press. Pin the rows RST matching the seams, sew and press to make one Allover Stars Four-Patch Unit $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make 12.

6. Repeat Step 5 and follow Diagram F, using eight Solid White squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), eight Ditzy Floral squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), and sixteen Ditzy Floral HST Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make four Ditzy Floral Four-Patch Units $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Repeat Step 5 and follow Diagram G, using eight Solid White squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), eight Americana Toss squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), and sixteen Americana Toss HST Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make eight Americana Toss Four-Patch Units $8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

8. Repeat Step 5 and follow Diagram H, using eight Solid White squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), eight Pieced Patchwork squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$, and sixteen Pieced Patchwork HST Units $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make eight Pieced Patchwork Four-Patch Units $8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

9. Place two Allover Stars Four-Patch Units $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram K. Pin RST, sew and press seam open to make one Allover Stars Double Four-Patch Unit $81 / 2$ in $\times 161 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41.91 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make 4.

10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Diagram J, using the eight Americana Toss Four-Patch Units to make four Double Four-Patch Units $81 / 2$ in $\times 161 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41.91 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

11. Place two Allover Stars HST Units as shown in Diagram K. Pin RST, sew and press to make one Allover Stars Double HST Unit $41 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$. Make 4.

12. Place four Solid White squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), four Allover Stars Double HST Units $41 / 2$ in $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ and the fussy cut Freedom Blocks square $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ in three rows of three as shown in Diagram N. Pin the pieces in each row RST and sew; press. Pin the rows RST matching seams, sew and press to make the Center Star Unit $161 / 2$ in $\times 161 / 2$ in ( $41.91 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41.91 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

13. Place the pieces in each row as shown in Diagram M. Pin the pieces RST and sew; press. Each row should measure the width and length shown. Pin the rows RST matching seams, sew and press. The finished Quilt Top should measure $481 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

14. To make the Freedom Blocks Backing, remove the selvages and cut one piece $401 / 4 \mathrm{in} \times 56$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two pieces $16 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 281 / 4$ in $(41.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 71.76 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin and sew the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram N. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 56 in x 56 in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Freedom Blocks ( $\mathbf{2 0 2 4 2 - M L T - C T N - D ) ~ - ~} 21 / 2$ yards ( $\mathbf{2 2 8 . 6} \mathbf{~ c m ~} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Backing
Cut $1-40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 56$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2-16 $1 / 4$ in $\times 28 \frac{1}{4}$ in $(41.25 \mathrm{~cm} \times 71.76 \mathrm{~cm})$

15. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing wrong side up to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
16. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
17. To make the Allover Stars Binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in ( 6.35 cm ) x wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructians

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
