- $11 / 8$ yds - Tossed Butterflies (20829-GRN-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- 3/4 yd - Folk Geo (20830-MLT-CTN-D)
- $5 / 8$ yd - Bountiful Patch (20826-MLT-CTN-D)
- $1 / 3$ yd - Floral Bouquet (20828-TRQ-CTN-D)
- $1 / 3$ yd - Mirrored Butterfly (20827-GRN-CTN-D)
- $21 / 2 \mathrm{yds}$ - Bountiful Patch (20826-MLT-CTN-D) Backing

Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\circledR}$ Folk Flora Collection

- $1 / 2$ yd - Solid White Cotton


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 57 in $\times 57$ in ( $144.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.

Cut $5-21 / 2$ in x wof ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Binding
Cut $2-21 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-21 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $12-21 / 2$ in $x 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-11 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $4-31 / 2$ in $\times 31 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Solid White square 3 in $\times 3$ in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Place the square on one corner of a Floral Bouquet square 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), sew on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ from the sewn line; press. Repeat with the remaining three corners to make a Floral Bouquet Unit finishing at 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make four.

2. Follow Diagram B using a Mirrored Butterfly square 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with four Solid White squares 3 in $\times 3$ in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make for Mirrored Butterfly Units. Repeat to make four Folk Geo Units as shown.

3. Refer to Diagram C to add Borders to Center Unit. Place a Tossed Butterflies strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Bountiful Patchwork $191 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in $(48.26 \mathrm{~cm} \times 48.26 \mathrm{~cm})$ square. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Tossed Butterflies strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Unit should measure $231 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $59.69 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Place three vertical Tossed Butterflies rectangles $2 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Floral Bouquet Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$, one Folk Geo Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$, one Mirrored Butterfly Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ and one Floral Bouquet Unit 9 in $\times 9 \mathrm{in}(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Inner Border finishing at 9 in x $401 / 2$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

5. Place three vertical Tossed Butterflies rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Floral Bouquet Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$, one Mirrored Butterfly Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$, one Folk Geo Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ and one Floral Bouquet Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Bottom Inner Border finishing at 9 in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Place three horizontal Tossed Butterflies rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$, one Folk Geo Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and one Mirrored Butterfly Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Left Side Inner Border finishing at 9 in $\times 231 / 2 \mathrm{in}(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm})$.

7. Place three horizontal Tossed Butterflies rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Mirrored Butterfly Unit 9 in x 9 in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and one Folk Geo Unit 9 in x 9 in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Right Side Inner Border finishing at 9 in $\times 231 / 2 \mathrm{in}(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm})$.

8. Place the Top and Bottom Inner Borders, 9 in $\times 23 \frac{1122}{}$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Center Unit $231 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $59.69 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram H. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Left and Right Side Inner Borders, 9 in $\times 32$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 81.28 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Quilt Center finishing at $401 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

9. Place a Tossed Butterflies square $3^{1 / 2}$ in $\times 3 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of a Folk Geo rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram K. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Outer Border, $31 / 2$ in $\times 48 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make the Bottom Outer Border.

10. Refer to Diagram J to complete the Quilt Top. Place a Tossed Butterflies strip $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the Quilt Center $401 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Tossed Butterflies strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Quilt Center should measure $421 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $107.95 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Place a Folk Geo rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Top and Bottom Outer Borders, $31 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Quilt Top should measure $48 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 48 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## Finishing

11. Remove the selvages from the Bountiful Patchwork Backing fabric. Note: Fabric is directional. Cut one piece $401 / 4$ in $\times 57$ in $(102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two pieces $171 / 4$ in $\times 283 / 4$ in $(43.82 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.03 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges and sew; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram K. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure $57 \mathrm{in} \times 57$ in ( $144.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

12. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
13. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
14. Follow Diagram L to make the Tossed Butterflies Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a $2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not Bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
