## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 56 in x 56 in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Befare You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

## Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to make Flying Geese Units. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of an Old Glory square 4 in $x 4$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10.16 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Place RST on the left side of a White rectangle $4 \mathrm{in} \times 71 / 2$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 19.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew on the diagonal line. Trim seam to $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ); press open. Repeat with a second Old Glory square $4 \mathrm{in} \times 4 \mathrm{in}(10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 10.16 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the right side of the rectangle to make a Flying Geese Unit 4 in $x 71 / 2$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 19.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make 4.

2. Place four White squares 4 in $x 4$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 19.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), four Flying Geese Units 4 in $\times 71 / 2$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 19.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), and one Patriotic Stars square $71 / 2$ in $\times 71 / 2$ in ( $19.05 \mathrm{~cm} \times 19.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) in three rows as shown in Diagram B. Pin the pieces in each row RST; sew and press. Pin the rows RST, matching seams, sew and press to make the Center Star $141 / 2$ in $\times 141 / 2$ in ( $36.83 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

3. Place a Stars \& Stripes rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 141 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 36.83 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the Center Star as shown in Diagram C. Pin RST and sew; press. Place a Stars \& Stripes rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 201 / 2 \mathrm{in}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST and sew; press. The Center Star Block should measure $20 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 201 / 2$ in ( $52.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Repeat Steps 1 and 2 to make a smaller version of the Center Star Block $61 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 61 / 2 \mathrm{in}(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$. These blocks surround the outside of the quilt.
5. Make 8 of the Rose Bloom Stripe Star Block (Dia. D).

- (8) Rose Bloom Stripe squares $31 / 2$ in $\times 31 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$
- (64) Rose Bloom Stripe squares 2 in $\times 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 5.08 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
- (32) White rectangles 2 in $\times 3 \frac{1 ⁄ 2}{2}$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$
- (32) White squares 2 in $\times 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 5.08 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

- (16) White rectangles 2 in $\times 31 / 2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$
- (16) White squares 2 in $\times 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

9. Make 4 of the Old Glory Star Block (Dia. H)

- (4) Old Glory squares $31 / 2$ in $x 31 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$
- (32) Old Glory squares 2 in x 2 in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 5.08 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
- (16) White rectangles 2 in $\times 31 / 2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$
- (16) White squares 2 in $x 2$ in ( $5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

10. Place two Rose Bloom Stripe, two Stars \& Stripes, one Heart of America and one Old Glory Star Blocks $6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $x 61 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST and sew; press open to reduce bulk. The Star Border should measure $6^{1 ⁄ 2}$ in x 36 1/2 in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make 4. Tip: To make perfect points, put a pin through the star seam intersections and sew slightly to the right.

11. Place a Patriotic Stars Star Block $61 / 2$ in $\times 61 / 2(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 16.51 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each end of a Star Border $61 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST, sew and press open, to make the Top Star Border $61 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the Bottom Star Border.

12. Place a Heart of America and a Rose Bloom Stripe square $81 / 2$ in $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom of a Patriotic Stars rectangle $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram K. Note: Check orientation of design. Pin RST and sew; press to make the Left Side Inner Border $81 / 2$ in $\times 20^{1 / 2}$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Diagram $L$ to make the Right Side Inner Border $81 / 2$ in $\times 20 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

14. Place two Old Glory squares, a Heart of America and a Patriotic Stars square $81 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram M to make the Top Inner Border $81 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check orientation of design..

15. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Diagram $N$ to make the Bottom Inner Border $81 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Dia. N

16. Refer to Diagram O to place the Borders around the Center Star Block $201 / 2$ in $\times 201 / 2 \mathrm{in}(52.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin and sew the side borders first then the top and bottom borders. Match ends, seams and middles. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing. Note: Check orientation and fabric direction of each border.

## Inner Border -

Left Side: Made in Step $11-81 / 2$ in $\times 201 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Right Side: Made in Step $12-81 / 2$ in $\times 201 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm})$.
Top: Made in Step $13-81 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm})$.
Bottom: Made in Step $14-81 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Quilt Center $361 / 2$ in $\times 361 / 2$ in $(92.71 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm})$.

## Star Border -

Sides: Two made in Step $9-61 / 2$ in x $361 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 92.71 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Top and Bottom: Two made in Step $10-6 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
The finished Quilt Top should measure $481 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in $(123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$.

17. To make the Heart of America Backing, remove the selvages and cut one piece $40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 56$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one piece $16 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 40 \frac{1}{4}$ in ( $41.28 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), and one piece $161 / 4$ in $\times 161 / 4$ in ( $41.28 \mathrm{~cm} \times 41.28 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin and sew the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram P. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 56 in $\times 56$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

18. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing wrong side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
19. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and batting even with the Quilt Top.
20. To make the Patriotic Stars Binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in $\times$ wof ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a $2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
