- $21 / 2$ yards - Animal Trek (20182-MLT-CTN-D) Backing-Directional

- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

## Befare Yau Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.

Cut 5-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ for binding
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 42 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 19 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 171 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 44.45 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut 5-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ vertical
Cut 5-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ horizontal
Cut 4-3 $1 / 2$ in x $31 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$

Cut 2-2 $1 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm})$

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## Solid White $3 / 8$ yard

Cut $32-3$ in $\times 3$ in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Seming

1. Draw a diagonal line on the wrong side of a Solid White square 3 in $\times 3 \mathrm{in}(7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm})$. Place the square on one corner of a World Map square 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), sew on the drawn line and trim $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ from the sewn line; press. Repeat with the remaining three corners to make a World Map Unit finishing at 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Make four.

2. Repeat the technique in Step 1 to make the animal blocks cut from the Panel. Follow Diagram B using the Panel Unit shown with four Solid White squares 3 in x 3 in ( $7.62 \mathrm{~cm} \times 7.62 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for each one. Note: The Leopard and Giraffes blocks do not have White sewn to the corners (Dia. C).

3. Refer to Diagram D to add Borders 1 and 2:

Border 1: Place a Skins strip $11 / 2$ in $\times 171 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 44.45 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of the Fussy Cut Wild Animals Panel square $171 / 2$ in $\times 17 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $44.45 \mathrm{~cm} \times 44.45 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Skins strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Panel with Border 1 should measure $191 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in ( $49.53 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Border 2: Place a Baskets strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 191 / 2$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Baskets strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Panel Unit should measure $231 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $59.69 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Place two vertical Skins rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), the Leopard Panel Unit 9 in $\times 191 / 2$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one World Map Unit 9 in x 9 in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Giraffe Panel Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border 3 finishing at 9 in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

5. Place three vertical Skins rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one World Map Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Zebra Panel Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Bottom Border 3 finishing at 9 in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Place three horizontal Skins rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one Rhino Panel Unit 9 in x 9 in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), the World Map Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Tiger Panel Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Left Side Border 3 finishing at 9 in $\times 32$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 81.28 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Place two horizontal Skins rectangles $21 / 2$ in $\times 9$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one World Map Unit 9 in $\times 9$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 22.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and the Giraffes Block 9 in $\times 191 / 2$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 49.53 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram H. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Right Side Border 3 finishing at 9 in $\times 32$ in ( $22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 81.28 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

8. Place the Bottom Border 3, 9 in $\times 231 / 2$ in $(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm})$ and the Center Panel Unit $231 / 2$ in $\times 231 / 2$ in ( $59.69 \mathrm{~cm} \times 59.69 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Left and Right Side Borders 3, 9 in $\times 32 \mathrm{in}(22.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 81.28 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Top Border 3 as shown. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Quilt Center finishing at $401 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$.

9. Place a Skins square $3 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 31 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 8.89 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of a Baskets rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border 5, $31 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2 \mathrm{in}(8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make the Bottom Border 5.

10. Refer to Diagram $K$ to add Borders 4 and 5:

Border 4: Place a Skins strip $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side of the Quilt Center $401 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Skins strips $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 421 / 2 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Quilt Center with Border 4 should measure $421 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $107.95 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
Border 5: Place a Baskets rectangle $31 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Top and Bottom Borders 5, $31 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $8.89 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Into The Wild Quilt Top should measure $481 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).


## Finishing

11. Remove the selvages from the Animals Trek Backing fabric. Note: Fabric is directional. Cut one piece $401 / 4$ in $\times 57$ in $(102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two pieces $17 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 283 / 4 \mathrm{in}(43.82 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.03 \mathrm{~cm})$. Pin the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges and sew; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram L. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure $57 \mathrm{in} \times 57$ in ( $144.78 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

Cut $1-40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 57$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 144.78 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut 2-17 $1 / 4$ in $\times 283 / 4$ in $(43.82 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.03 \mathrm{~cm})$

12. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
13. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
14. Follow Diagram $M$ to make the Skins Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five $21 / 2 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \mathrm{x}$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not Bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
