## Fabric Needed

### 3 Wishes® Into The Wild Collection

- 1 yard – Wild Animals Panel (20183-PNL-CTN-D)
- 1 yard – Skins (20179-GRY-CTN-D) for Piecing and Binding
- ⅞ yard – Baskets (20180-MLT-CTN-D)
- ¾ yard – Safari Animals (20177-WHT-CTN-D)
- ½ yard – World Map (20178-GRN-CTN-D)
- 2 ½ yards – Animal Trek (20182-MLT-CTN-D) Backing-Directional

### Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric® Into The Wild Collection

- ⅜ yard – Solid White Cotton

### Additional Supplies Needed:

- 57 in x 57 in (144.78 cm x 144.78 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

# Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.



### Into The Wild Panel (20183-PNL-CTN-D) 1 Panel

Fussy Cut 1 - 17 ½ in x 17 ½ in (44.45 cm x 44.45 cm)

Fussy Cut 1 - 9 in x 19 ½ in (22.86 cm x 49.53 cm)

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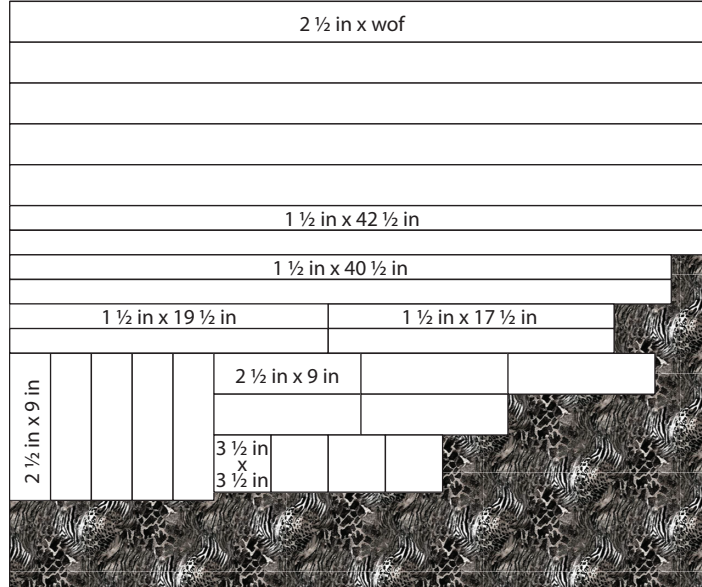
### Safari Animals (20177-WHT-CTN-D) ¾ yard

Fussy Cut 4 - 9 x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm)



### World Map (20178-GRN-CTN-D) ½ yard

Cut 4 - 9 x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm)



### Skins (20179-GRY-CTN-D) 1 yard

Cut 5 - 2 ½ in x 42 ½ in (6.35 cm x 107.95 cm) for binding

Cut 2 - 1 ½ in x 42 ½ in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm)

Cut 2 - 1 ½ in x 40 ½ in (3.81 cm x 102.87 cm)

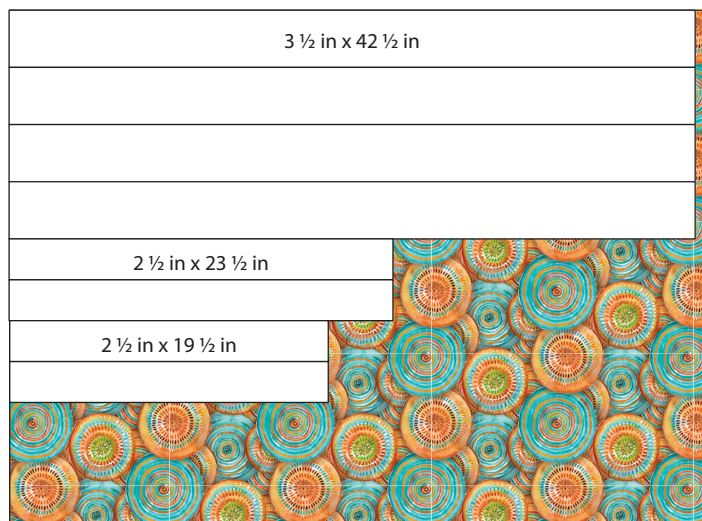
Cut 2 - 1 ½ in x 19 ½ in (3.81 cm x 49.53 cm)

Cut 2 - 1 ½ in x 17 ½ in (3.81 cm x 44.45 cm)

Cut 5 - 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm) vertical

Cut 5 - 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm) horizontal

Cut 4 - 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm)

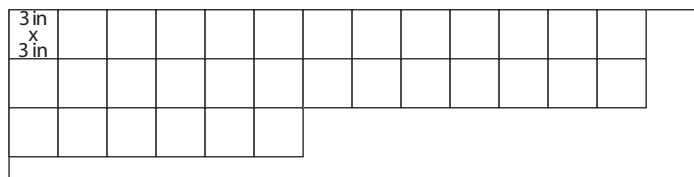


### Baskets (20180-MLT-CTN-D) 7/8 yard

Cut 4 - 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm)

Cut 2 - 2 ½ in x 23 ½ in (6.35 cm x 59.69 cm)

Cut 2 - 2 ½ in x 19 ½ in (6.35 cm x 49.53 cm)

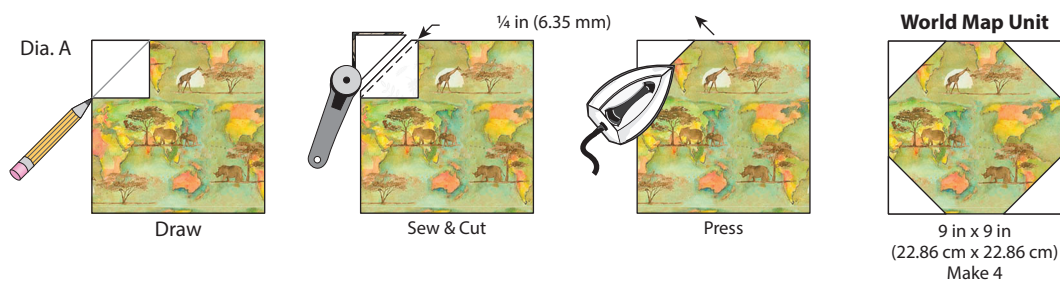


### Solid White ¾ yard

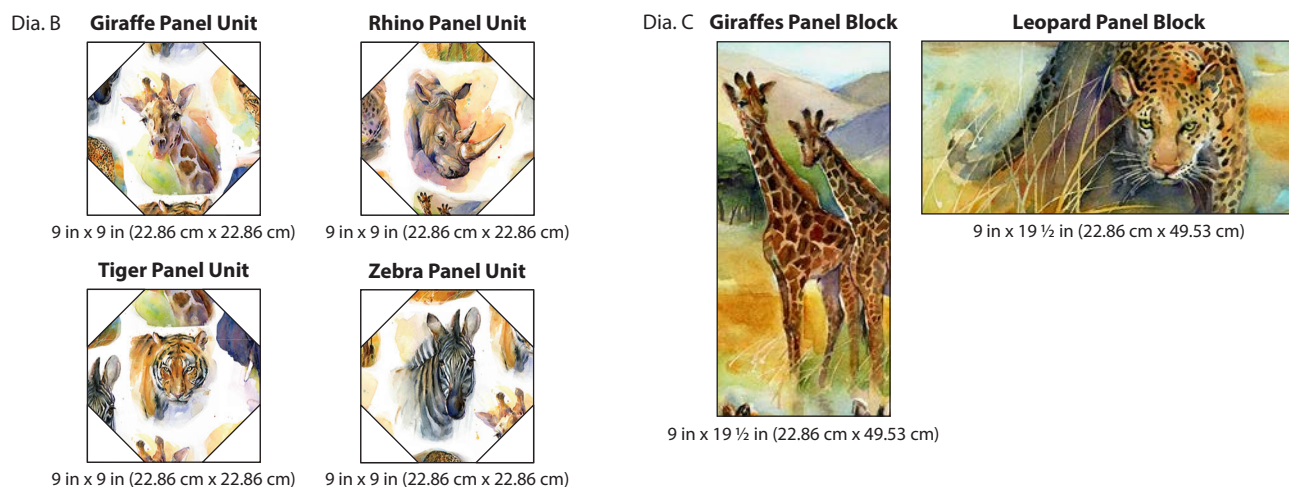
Cut 32 - 3 in x 3 in (7.62 cm x 7.62 cm)

# Sewing

1. Draw a diagonal line on the **wrong** side of a Solid White square 3 in x 3 in (7.62 cm x 7.62 cm). Place the square on one corner of a World Map square 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm), sew on the drawn line and trim  $\frac{1}{4}$  in (6.35 mm) from the sewn line; press. Repeat with the remaining three corners to make a World Map Unit finishing at 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm). Make four.



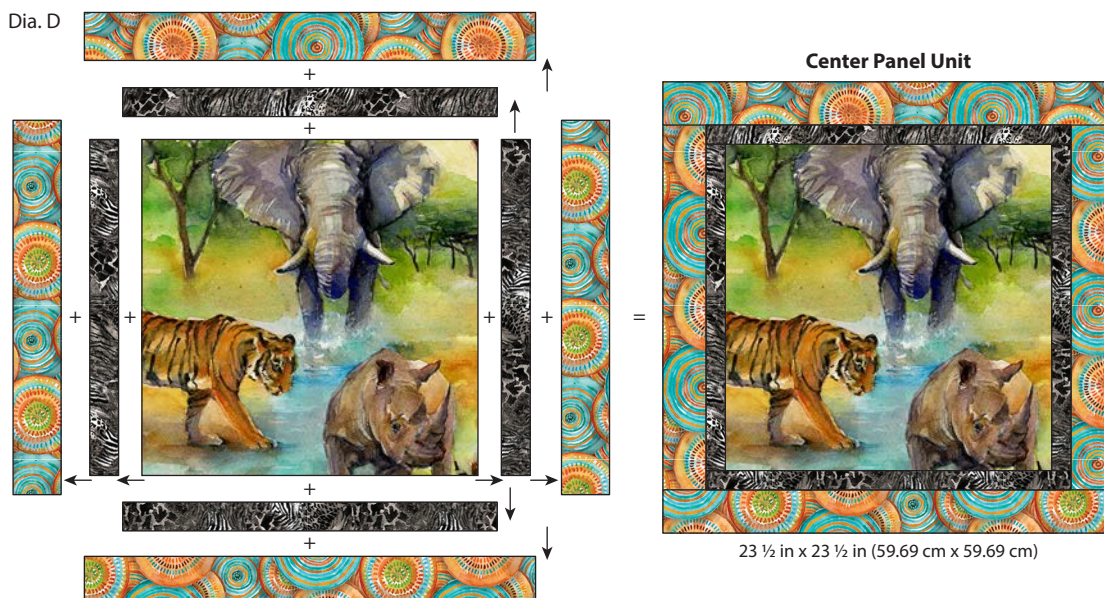
2. Repeat the technique in Step 1 to make the animal blocks cut from the Panel. Follow Diagram B using the Panel Unit shown with four Solid White squares 3 in x 3 in (7.62 cm x 7.62 cm) for each one. **Note:** *The Leopard and Giraffes blocks do not have White sewn to the corners (Dia. C).*



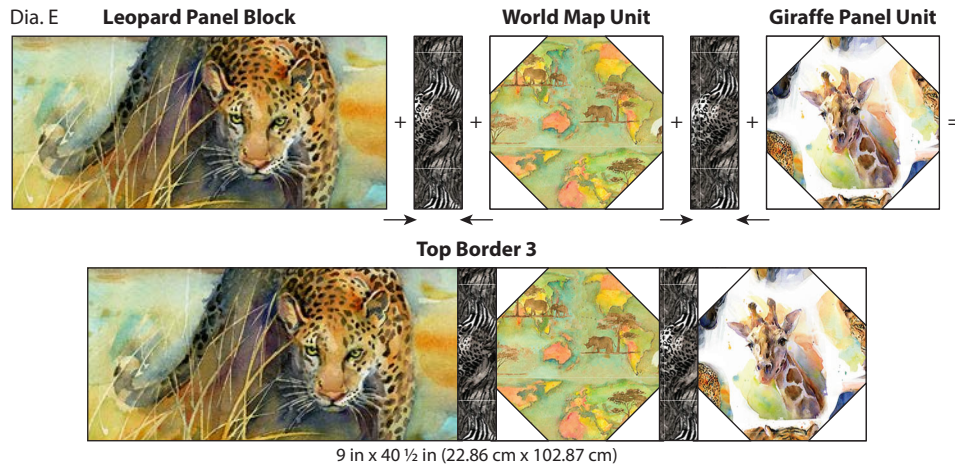
3. Refer to Diagram D to add Borders 1 and 2:

**Border 1:** Place a Skins strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $17\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 44.45 cm) on each side of the Fussy Cut Wild Animals Panel square  $17\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $17\frac{1}{2}$  in (44.45 cm x 44.45 cm). Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Skins strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $19\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 49.53 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Panel with Border 1 should measure  $19\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $19\frac{1}{2}$  in (49.53 cm x 49.53 cm).

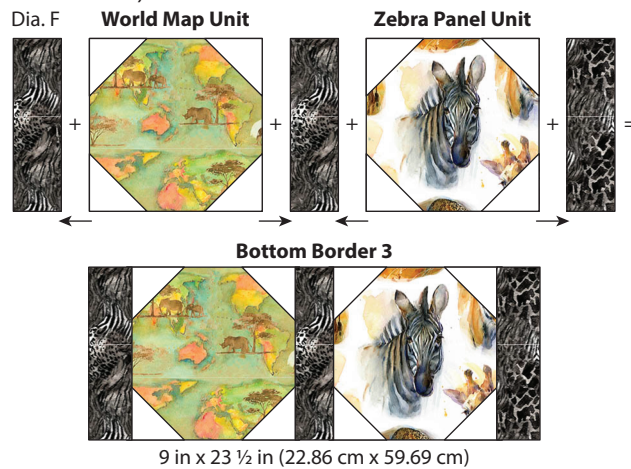
**Border 2:** Place a Baskets strip  $2\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $19\frac{1}{2}$  in (6.35 cm x 49.53 cm) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Baskets strips  $2\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $23\frac{1}{2}$  in (6.35 cm x 59.69 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Center Panel Unit should measure  $23\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $23\frac{1}{2}$  in (59.69 cm x 59.69 cm).



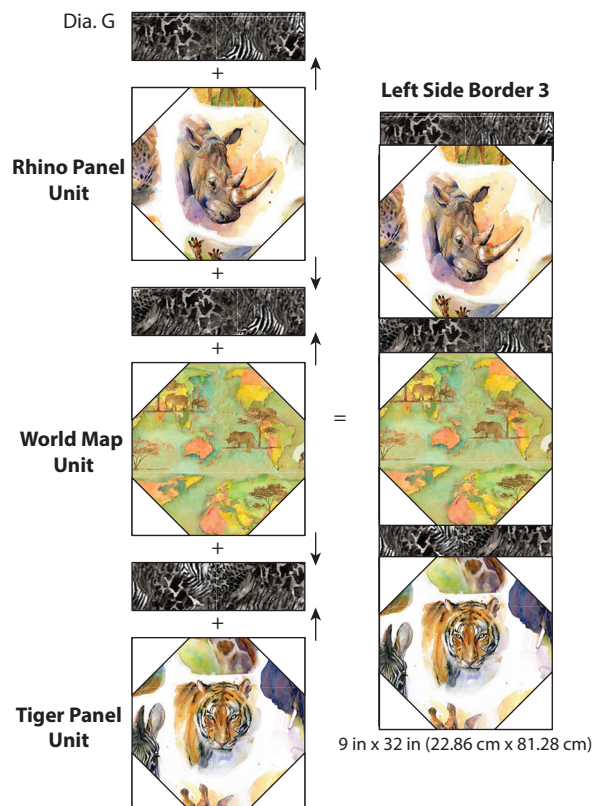
4. Place two vertical Skins rectangles 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm), the Leopard Panel Unit 9 in x 19 ½ in (22.86 cm x 49.53 cm), one World Map Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) and the Giraffe Panel Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border 3 finishing at 9 in x 40 ½ in (22.86 cm x 102.87 cm).



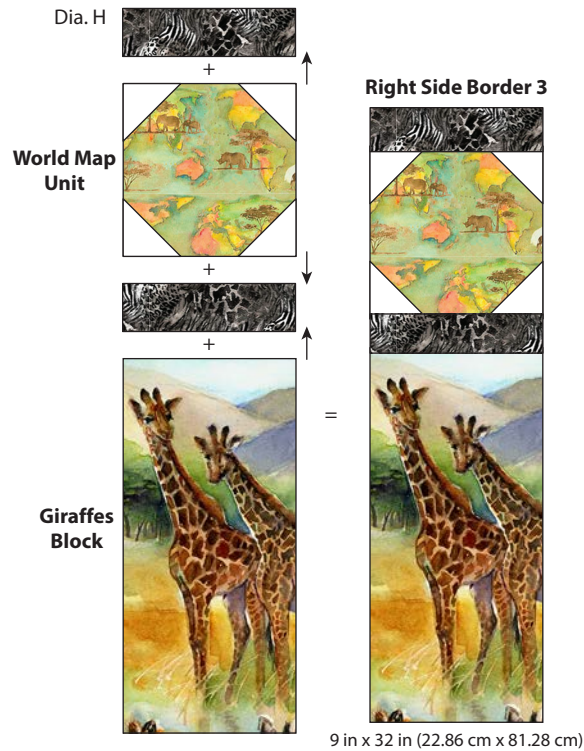
5. Place three vertical Skins rectangles 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm), one World Map Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) and the Zebra Panel Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Bottom Border 3 finishing at 9 in x 23 ½ in (22.86 cm x 59.69 cm).



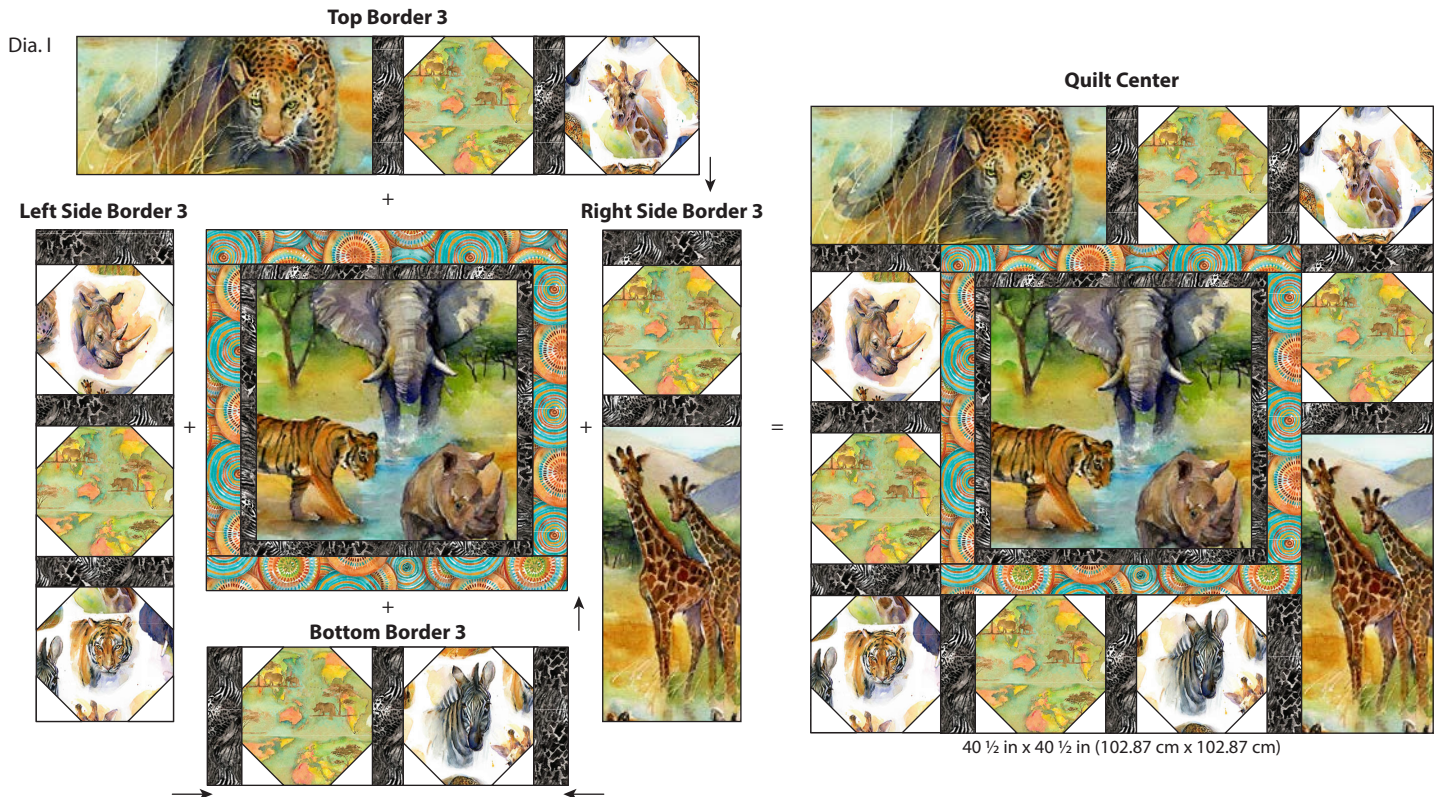
6. Place three horizontal Skins rectangles 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm), one Rhino Panel Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm), the World Map Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) and the Tiger Panel Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) as shown in Diagram G. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Left Side Border 3 finishing at 9 in x 32 in (22.86 cm x 81.28 cm).



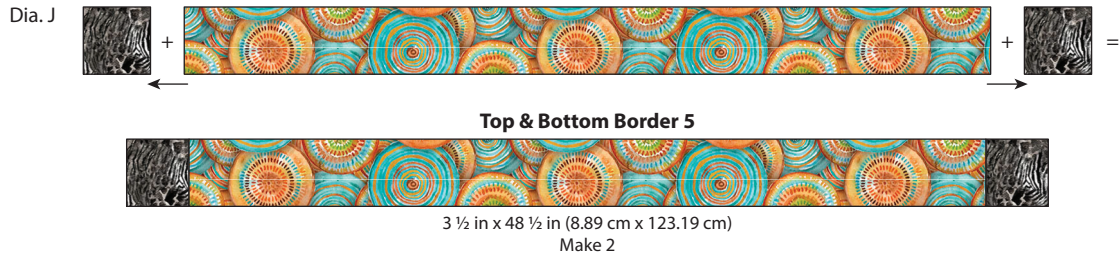
7. Place two horizontal Skins rectangles 2 ½ in x 9 in (6.35 cm x 22.86 cm), one World Map Unit 9 in x 9 in (22.86 cm x 22.86 cm) and the Giraffes Block 9 in x 19 ½ in (22.86 cm x 49.53 cm) as shown in Diagram H. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Right Side Border 3 finishing at 9 in x 32 in (22.86 cm x 81.28 cm).



8. Place the Bottom Border 3, 9 in x 23 ½ in (22.86 cm x 59.69 cm) and the Center Panel Unit 23 ½ in x 23 ½ in (59.69 cm x 59.69 cm) as shown in Diagram I. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Left and Right Side Borders 3, 9 in x 32 in (22.86 cm x 81.28 cm) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Top Border 3 as shown. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Quilt Center finishing at 40 ½ in x 40 ½ in (102.87 cm x 102.87 cm).



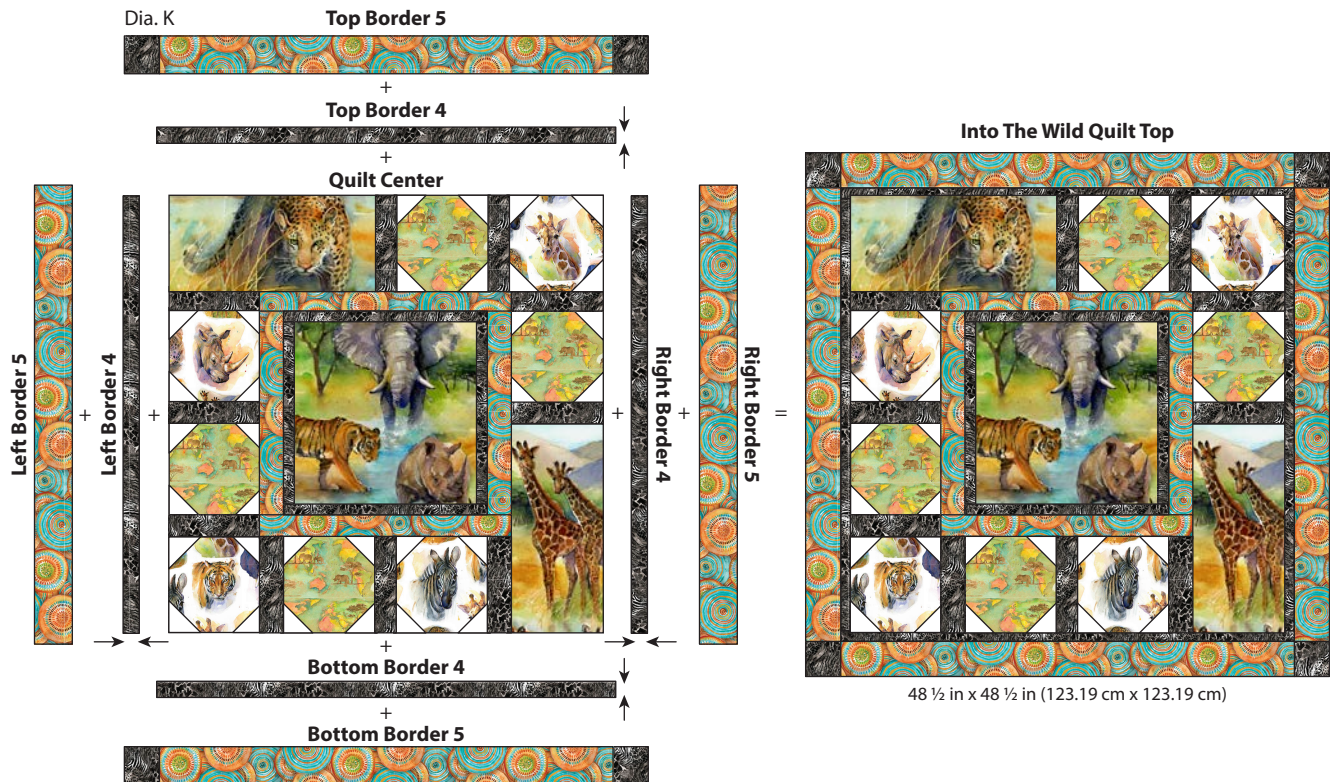
9. Place a Skins square  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) on each side of a Baskets rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm) as shown in Diagram J. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Top Border 5,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $48\frac{1}{2}$  in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm). Repeat to make the Bottom Border 5.



10. Refer to Diagram K to add Borders 4 and 5:

**Border 4:** Place a Skins strip  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $40\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 102.87 cm) on each side of the Quilt Center  $40\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $40\frac{1}{2}$  in (102.87 cm x 102.87 cm). Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Skins strips  $1\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Quilt Center with Border 4 should measure  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (107.95 cm x 107.95 cm).

**Border 5:** Place a Baskets rectangle  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $42\frac{1}{2}$  in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm) on each side. Pin RST, sew and press. Place the Top and Bottom Borders 5,  $3\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $48\frac{1}{2}$  in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm) on the top and bottom. Pin RST, sew and press. The Into The Wild Quilt Top should measure  $48\frac{1}{2}$  in x  $48\frac{1}{2}$  in (123.19 cm x 123.19 cm).

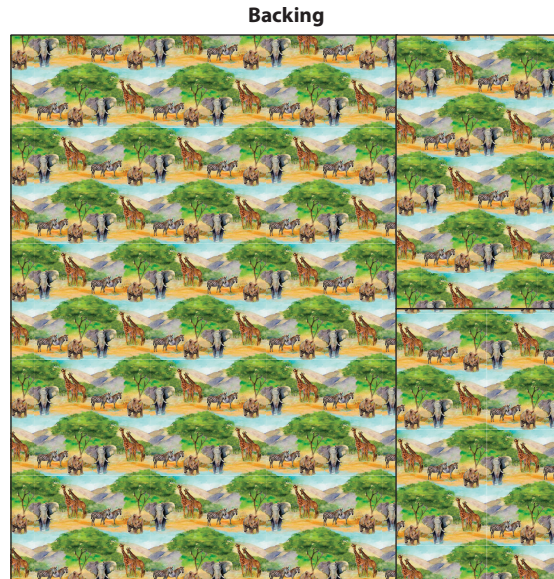


# Finishing

11. Remove the selvages from the Animals Trek Backing fabric. **Note:** *Fabric is directional.* Cut one piece 40 ¼ in x 57 in (102.87 cm x 144.78 cm) and two pieces 17 ¼ in x 28 ¾ in (43.82 cm x 73.03 cm). Pin the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges and sew; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram L. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 57 in x 57 in (144.78 cm x 144.78 cm).

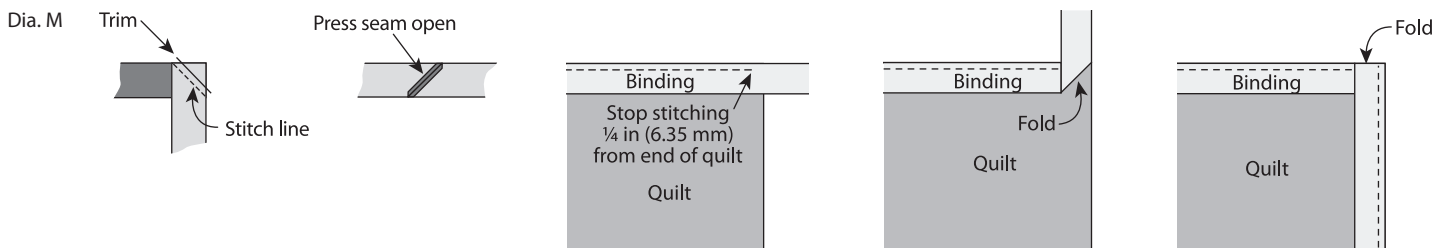


**Animal Trek (20182-MLT-CTN-D) 2 ½ yards**  
 Cut 1 - 40 ¼ in x 57 in (102.24 cm x 144.78 cm)  
 Cut 2 - 17 ¼ in x 28 ¾ in (43.82 cm x 73.03 cm)

12. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, **wrong** side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
13. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
14. Follow Diagram M to make the Skins Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the five 2 ½ in (6.35 cm) x wof strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.



## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not Bleach. **Tip:** *Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye.* Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
