Fabric Needed

3 Wishes® Oh My Safari Collection

- 1 ½ yds Safari Friends Patch (19195-GRY-FLN-D)
- 1 ½ yds Hanging Sloths (19196-GRY-FLN-D) for piecing and Binding
- ¾ yd White
- ½ yd Safari Skins (19197-WHT-FLN-D)
- ¼ yd Smiling Lions (19198-TRQ-FLN-D)
- 1/4 yd Tossed Safari Animals (19199-WHT-FLN-D)
- 3 yds Safari Skins (19197-WHT-FLN-D) for Backing

Additional Supplies Needed:


- 54 in x 66 in (137.16 cm x 167.64 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.





Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to place one Hanging Sloths 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST with one White 3 ½ in x 6 ½ in (8.89 cm x 16.51 cm) aligning the square with the left side of the rectangle. Mark a diagonal line across the square from the upper right to the lower left corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance. Flip up the triangle formed and press to make Unit 1 that should measure 3 ½ in x 6 ½ in (8.89 cm x 16.51 cm). Repeat to make twenty-four of Unit 1.



Refer to Diagram B to place one Hanging Sloths 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST with one Unit 1, aligning the square with the right side of the rectangle. Mark a diagonal line across the square from the upper left to the lower right corner. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance. Flip up the triangle formed and press to make Unit 2 that should measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ in x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (8.89 cm x 16.51 cm). Repeat to make twenty-four of Unit 2.




3. Refer to Diagram C and repeat Steps 1-2 with twenty-four Hanging Sloths 3 ½ in x 6 ½ in (8.89 cm x 16.51 cm) rectangles and forty-eight Safari Skins 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) squares to make twenty-four of Unit 3.




Refer to Diagram D to sew one White 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST to the left side of one Unit 2. Sew one White 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST to the right side of the Unit 2 to make one Unit 4 that should measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ in (8.89 cm x 31.75 cm). Repeat to make twelve of Unit 4.





Make 12

5. Refer to Diagram E to sew one Unit 2 RST to each side of one Tossed Safari Animals 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm) to make one Unit 5 that should measure 6 ½ in x 12 ½ in (16.51 cm x 31.75 cm). Repeat to make six of Unit 5.









Refer to Diagram F to sew one Unit 4 RST to the top and bottom of Unit 5 to make one Block One square. Block One should measure 12 ½ in x 12 ½ in (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm). Repeat to make six of Block One total.




7. Refer to Diagram G to sew one Hanging Sloth 3 ½ in x 3 ½ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST to the left side of one Unit 3. Sew one Hanging Sloth 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (8.89 cm x 8.89 cm) RST to the right side of the Unit 3 to make Unit 6 that should measure $3 \frac{1}{2}$ in x 12 in (8.89 cm x 31.75 cm). Repeat to make twelve of Unit 6.




www.3wishesfabric.com page 3 8. Refer to Diagram H to sew one Unit 3 RST to each side of one Smiling Lions 6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm) to make one Unit 7 that should measure 6 ½ in x 12 ½ in (16.51 cm x 31.75 cm). *Note:* Check orientation of the design. Repeat to make six of Unit 7.




9. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Unit 6 RST to the top and bottom of one Unit 7 to make one Block Two. Block Two should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ in (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm). Repeat to make six of Block Two total.




10. Refer to Diagram J to sew one Block One to each side of one Block Two to make Row 1 which should measure 12 ½ in x 36 ½ in (31.75 cm x 92.71 cm). Repeat to make Row 3.






11. Refer to Diagram K to sew one Block Two to each side of one Block One to make Row 2 which should measure $12 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $36 \frac{1}{2}$ in (31.75 cm x 92.71 cm). Repeat to make Row 4.




12. Refer to Diagram L to sew the Rows RST to make the Quilt Center; press. The Quilt Center should measure $36 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $48 \frac{1}{2}$ in (92.71 cm x 123.19 cm).



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
- 13. Refer to Diagram M to sew one Safari Friends Patch 5 ½ in x 48 ½ in (13.97 cm x 123.19 cm) RST to each side of the Quilt Center. **Note:** Check orientation of the design.
- 14. Sew four Safari Friends Patch strips 5 ½ in x 30 ½ in (13.97 cm x 77.47 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two Safari Friends Patch strips 5 ½ in x 46 ½ in (13.97 cm x 118.11 cm). Refer to Diagram M to sew one Safari Friends Patch strip 5 ½ in x 46 ½ in (13.97 cm x 118.11 cm) RST to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. The completed Quilt Top should measure 46 ½ in x 58 ½ in (118.11 cm x 148.59 cm).


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15. To make the Safari Skins Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in x 54 in (106.68 cm x 137.16 cm). Pin and sew RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram N. Trim the Back to measure 54 in x 66 in (137.16 cm x 167.64 cm).

- 16. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing **wrong** side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 17. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
- 18. To make the Hanging Sloths Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. O). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
