

SNOWFALL Barn Quilt



Featuring the Snowfall on the Range Collection by John Keeling Shipping to stores July 2022

Finished Size: 66 in x 72 in (167.64 cm x 182.88 cm)

Fabric Needed

3 Wishes® Snowfall on the Range Collection

- 2 1/8 yds Watercolor Sunset (19284-MLT-CTN-D) for piecing and Binding
- 1 yd Large Barn Panel (19290-PNL-CTN-D)
- 1 ½ yds Vintage Trucks (19286-BLU-CTN-D)
- 1 ½ yds Birch Tree Forest (19285-BLU-CTN-D)
- 1 1/4 yds Midnight Horses (19283-BLU-CTN-D)
- % yd Scenic Barn (19282-MLT-CTN-D)
- 4 ½ yds Galloping Horses (19288-WHT-CTN-D) for Backing

Additional Supplies Needed:

- 74 in x 80 in (187.96 cm x 203.2 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35 mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric


Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.






Watercolor Sunset - 19284-MLT-CTN-D 2 1/8 yds x wof (194.31cm x 106.68 cm) Fussy Cut 2 – 2 in x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (5.08 cm x 95.25 cm) Fussy Cut 2 – 2 in x 40 ½ in (5.08 cm x 102.87 cm)


Cut 7 – 2 ½ in x 42 in (3.81 cm x 60.96 cm) Cut 7 – 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) for Rinding




Vintage Trucks – 19286-BLU-CTN-D 1 ½ yds x wof (137.16 cm x 106.68 cm) Cut 2 – 6 ½ in x 48 ½ in (16.51 cm x 123.19 cm) Cut 4 – 6 ½ in x 25 in (16.51 cm x 63.50 cm)



Midnight Horses – 19283-BLU-CTN-D 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ yds x wof (114.30 cm x 106.68 cm) Cut 2 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (6.35 cm x 107.95 cm) Fussy Cut 4 – 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 24 in (6.35 cm x 60.96 cm)



Birch Tree Forest – 19285-BLU-CTN-D 1 ½ yds x wof (137.16 cm x 106.68 cm) Cut 4 – 3 ½ in x 48 ½ in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm) Cut 8 – 3 ½ in x 25 in (8.89 cm x 63.50 cm)






Sewing


1. Refer to Diagram A to sew one Watercolor Sunset strip 2 in x 40 ½ in (5.08 cm x 102.87 cm) RST to each side of the Large Barn Panel 34 ½ in x 40 ½ in (87.63 cm x 102.87cm). Sew one Watercolor Sunset strip 2 in x 37 ½ in (5.08 cm x 95.25 cm) to the top and bottom of the Large Barn Panel. Refer to Diagram B to trim the Unit to measure 36 ½ in x 42 ½ in (92.71 cm x 107.95 cm) to make Unit 1.






Trim to measure 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (167.64 cm x 107.95 cm) after the borders are added.


2. Refer to Diagram C to sew one Midnight Horses strip 2 ½ in x 42 ½ in (6.35 cm x 107.95 cm) to each side of Unit 1. *Note:* Check the orientation of the design. Sew four Midnight Horses strips 2 ½ in x 24 in (6.35 cm x 60.96 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams (Dia. D); trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip, cut two Midnight Horses strips 2 ½ in x 40 ½ in (6.35 cm x 102.87 cm). Sew one Midnight Horse strip 2 ½ in x 40 ½ in (6.35 cm x 102.87 cm) to the top and bottom of Unit 1 to make Unit 2. The Unit should measure 40 ½ in x 46 ½ in (102.87 cm x 118.11 cm).

3. Sew eight Watercolor Sunset strips 1 ½ in x 24 in (3.81 cm x 60.96 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). Note: Check the orientation of the design. From the sewn strip, cut two Watercolor Sunset strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ in x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (3.81 cm x 118.11 cm) and two Watercolor Sunset strips $1\frac{1}{2}$ in x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm). Refer to Diagram E to sew one Watercolor Sunset strip 1 ½ in x 46 ½ in (3.81 cm x 118.11 cm) RST to each side of Unit 2. Sew one Watercolor Sunset strip 1 ½ in x 42 ½ in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm) RST to the top and bottom of Unit 2 to make the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure 42 ½ in x 48 ½ in (107.95 cm x 123.19 cm).


4. Refer to Diagram F to sew one Birch Tree Forest strip 3 ½ in x 48 ½ in (8.89 cm x 123.19 cm) RST to each side of one Vintage Trucks strip 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (16.51cm x 123.19 cm) to make one 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (31.75cm x 123.19 cm) Side Border. Note: Check the orientation of the design. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

- 5. Sew eight Birch Tree Forest strips 3 ½ in x 25 in (8.89 cm x 63.5 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). *Note:* Check the orientation of the design. From the sewn strip cut four Birch Tree Forest strips 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm).
- 6. Sew four Vintage Trucks strips 6 ½ in x 25 in (16.51 cm x 63.5 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip cut two Vintage Trucks strips 6 ½ in x 42 ½ (16.51 cm x 107.95 cm).
- 7. Refer to Diagram G to sew one Birch Tree Forest strip 3 ½ in x 42 ½ in (8.89 cm x 107.95 cm) to the top and to the bottom of one Vintage Trucks strip 6 ½ in x 42 ½ in (16.61 cm x 107.95 cm) to make one Unit 3. The Unit should measure 12 ½ in x 42 ½ in (31.75 cm x 107.95 cm). Repeat to make a second Unit 3.



8. Refer to Diagram H to sew one Scenic Barn square 12 ½ in x 12 ½ in (31.75 cm x 31.75 cm) to each end of one Unit 3 strip RST to make Top Border. The Border should measure 12 ½ in x 66 ½ in (31.75 cm x 168.91 cm). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

9. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Side Border RST to each side of the Quilt Center. *Note:* Check the orientation of the design. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Quilt Center to make the Quilt Top. The Quilt Top should measure 66 ½ in x 72 ½ in (168.91 cm x 184.15 cm).



10. To make the Galloping Horses Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in x 80 in (106.68 cm x 203.2 cm). **Note:** Check the orientation of the design. Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram J. Trim the Back to measure 74 in x 80 in (187.96 cm x 203.2 cm).



- 11. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing **wrong** side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 12. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
- 13. To make the Watercolor Binding, sew the short ends of the seven 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. K). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. *Tip:* Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
