## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.
Note: Check orientation of directional fabrics.

Cut $4-41 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Cut 2 - $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 1 1⁄2 in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 32^{1 ⁄ 2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 22^{1 / 2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

## Note: Check orientation of directional fabrics.

1. Place a Tossed Whales square $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 4^{1 / 2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of a Crescent Moon rectangle $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 22 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram A. Pin RST, sew and press to make the Third Border Top $41 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the Third Border Bottom.

2. Follow Step 1 and Diagram $B$ using four Tossed Whales squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two Goodnight Dreams rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make the Fifth Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). 3. Follow Step 1 and Diagram C using four Tossed Whales squares $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 41 / 2 \mathrm{in}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Rainbows \& Clouds rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Seventh Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Refer to Diagram D to place the Borders around the Moon Child Patch square $181 / 2$ in $\times 181 / 2$ in $(46.99 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm})$. Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin, matching center and ends. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing.

The Stay Wild Moon Child Quilt Top should measure $501 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## First Border

Sides: 2 - Tossed Whales strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 181 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 46.99 \mathrm{~cm})$
Top and Bottom: 2 - Tossed Whales strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 20^{1 / 2}$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $20 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 201 / 2$ in ( $52.07 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Second Border

Sides: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 201 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 52.07 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $221 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Third Border
Sides: 2 - Crescent Moon rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 22 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Third Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $301 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in $(77.47 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Fourth Border

Sides: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $301 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $321 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in ( $82.55 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Fifth Border

Sides: 2 - Goodnight Dreams rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$ Top and Bottom: Fifth Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2 \mathrm{in}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$ Quilt $40 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Sixth Border

Sides: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: 2 - Solid White strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$
Quilt $421 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $107.95 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Seventh Border

Sides: 2 - Rainbows \& Clouds rectangles $41 / 2$ in x $421 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Seventh Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in x $501 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm})$
Quilt $501 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Finishing

5. Remove the selvages from the Moon Child Patch Backing fabric. Note: Fabric is directional. Cut one piece $40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 59$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 149.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two pieces $191 / 4$ in $\times 293 / 4$ in ( $48.9 \mathrm{~cm} \times 75.57 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin the two smaller pieces RST on the short edges and sew; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew the long edges as shown in Diagram E. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 59 in $\times 59$ in ( $149.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 149.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
6. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
7. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

8. Binding - Follow Diagram F to make the Tossed Whales Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a $2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
