## 3 Wishes ${ }^{\circledR}$ Through the Forest Light Collection

-2/3yd - Country Whitetails Panel (20731-PNL-CTN-D)

- 1 yd - Morning Run (20727-MLT-CTN-D)
- $13 / 8$ yd - Rustling Foliage (20726-MLT-CTN-D) includes Binding
-2/3 yd - Hanging Out (20724-MLT-CTN-D)
- $13 / 8$ yd - Solid Black Cotton
- 3 ¼ yds - Morning Run (20727-MLT-CTN-D) for Backing


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 56 in $\times 72$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not prewash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wot = width of fabric

Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below.

Cut $2-31 / 4$ in $\times 23$ in $(8.26 \mathrm{~cm} \times 58.42 \mathrm{~cm})$

Cut 6-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 21$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 53.34 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $48-41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$


Hanging Out ( $20724-M L T-C T N-D)-2 / 3$ yd x wof ( $60.96 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $3-61 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

Morning Run - 1 yd x wof ( 91.44 cm x 106.68 cm)
Fussy Cut $12-81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to sew three Solid Black strips $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 42 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip, cut two strips $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 43 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm})$.

2. Refer to Diagram B to sew one Solid Black strip $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 21 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 53.34 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of the Country Whitetails Panel 41 in x 21 in ( $104.14 \mathrm{~cm} \times 53.34 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one Solid Black strip $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 43 \mathrm{in}(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to the top and bottom of the Country Whitetails Panel to make Unit 1 which should measure 43 in $\times 23$ in (109.22 cm $\times 58.42 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.

3. Refer to Diagram C to sew one Rustling Foliage strip $31 / 4 \mathrm{in} \times 23 \mathrm{in}(8.26 \mathrm{~cm} \times 58.42 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each side of Unit 1 . Sew three Rustling Foliage strips 4 in $\times 42$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip, cut two strips 4 in $\times 43$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Sew one Rustling Foliage strip $4 \mathrm{in} \times 43$ in ( $10.16 \mathrm{~cm} \times 109.22 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and bottom of Unit 1 to make Unit 2 which should measure $481 / 2$ in $\times 30$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 76.2 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.

4. Refer to Diagram D and place one Solid Black square $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST on the top left corner of one Morning square $81 / 2$ in $\times 81 / 2$ in ( $21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Note: Check the orientation of design. Sew across the diagonal of the Solid Black square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner. Refer to Diagram E to flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. Refer to Diagram $F$ for seam direction to add a Solid Black square $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to each of the remaining corners of the Morning Run square; press to make Unit 3 . Unit 3 should measure $8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(21.59 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make twelve of Unit 3 (Diagram G).

5. Refer to Diagram H to sew six Unit 3's RST; press to make Unit 4. Unit 4 should measure $481 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 81 / 2$ in $(123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 21.59 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make two.
6. Refer to Diagram I to sew one Unit 4 to the top and bottom of Unit 2 to make Unit 5 which should measure $481 / 2$ in $x 46$ in

( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 116.84 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.
Unit 5

7. Sew three Rustling Foliage Palms strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 42^{48} \mathrm{in}\left(\frac{1 / 2}{}\right.$ in $35 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ in $(123.18 \mathrm{~cm} \times 116.84 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$. From the sewn strip, cut two strips $21 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2 \mathrm{in}(6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$. Refer to Diagram J to sew one Rustling Foliage strip $21 / 2$ in $\times 48 \frac{1}{2}$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and bottom of Unit 5 to make Unit 6 which should measure $481 / 2$ in x 50 in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 127 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.
8. Sew three Solid Black strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm})$ end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to Unit 6

$1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip, cut two strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram $K$ to sew one Solid Black strip $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) RST to the top and bottom of Unit 6 to make Unit 7 which should measure $481 / 2$ in $\times 521 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 133.35 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.
9. Sew three Hanging Out strips $61 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to

$481 / 2$ in $\times 52$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 132.08 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
$1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ). From the sewn strip, cut two strips $61 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in ( $16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Refer to Diagram $L$ to sew one Hanging Out strip $61 / 2$ in $\times 481 / 2$ in $(16.51 \mathrm{~cm} \times 123.19 \mathrm{~cm})$ RST to the top and bottom of Unit 7 to make the Quilt Top which should measure 48 $1 / 2$ in x $641 / 2$ in ( $123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 163.83 \mathrm{~cm}$ ); press.
10. To make the Morning Run Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in $\times 56$ in ( $106.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin and sew the

Quilt Top

$481 / 2$ in $\times 641 / 2$ in $(123.19 \mathrm{~cm} \times 163.83 \mathrm{~cm})$
rectangles RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram M. Trim the Back to measure 56 in $\times 72$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
13. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing fabric. Tape the Backing wrong side up on a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right


Trim to measure 56 in $\times 72$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 182.88 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
14. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
15. To make the Rustling Foliage Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in $\times 42$ in ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Wall Hanging and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. N). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.

## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
