- 1 yd - Village Panel (20883-PNL-CTN-D)
- $11 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$ - Farm Fresh Trucks (20879-CHR-CTN-D)
- 1 yd - Trailing Lemons (20878-WHT-CTN-D)
- 1 yd - Vintage Tile (20881-CHR-CTN-D) includes Binding
- $1 / 2 \mathrm{yd}$ - Solid White Cotton
- $31 / 3 y d s$ - Trailing Lemons (20878-WHT-CTN-D) for Backing


## ADDITIONAL SUPPLIES NEEDED:

- 66 in x 66 in ( $167.64 \mathrm{~cm} \times 167.64 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before you begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric.

## Cutting

1. Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.

Cut $4-4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 29$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $4-4 \frac{112}{2}$ in $\times 25$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 63.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


Trailing Lemons (20878-WHT-CTN-D) - 1 yd ( $91.44 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $18-2$ in $\times 101 / 2$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $18-2$ in $\times 131 / 2$ in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 4-4 $1 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 29$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Sewing

2. Refer to Diagram A to add borders to a Village Panel square (10 $1 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 10 \operatorname{1⁄2} \mathrm{in} / 26.67 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Place a Trailing Lemons rectangle ( 2 in $\times 10 \frac{1}{2}$ in $/ 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 26.67 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the top and bottom of the Village Panel square as shown. Pin RST, sew, and press. Place a Trailing Lemons rectangle ( 2 in $\times 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 5.08 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) on the each side as shown. Pin RST, sew, and press to make one Panel Block ( $131 / 2$ in $\times 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make 9 Panel Blocks.

3. Place Panel Block 6, Panel Block 8, Panel Block 1, and two Vintage Tile rectangles ( $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram B. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 1 ( $131 / 2$ in $\times 471 / 2$ in $/ 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

4. Place three Vintage Tile rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two Trailing Lemons squares ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2 \mathrm{in}$ / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram C. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row $2(41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 471 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm})$. Repeat to make Row 4.

5. Place Panel Block 5, Panel Block 9, Panel Block 7, and two Vintage Tile rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in $x 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 3 ( $131 / 2$ in $\times 471 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

6. Place Panel Block 4, Panel Block 2, Panel Block 3, and two Vintage Tile rectangles ( $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 131 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 34.29 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram E. Pin RST, sew and press to make Row 5 ( $131 / 2$ in $\times 471 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 34.29 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Place Rows $1-5$ as shown in Diagram F. Pin RST, matching the seams, sew, and press. The Quilt Center should measure $471 / 2$ in $\times 471 / 2$ in $(120.65 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm})$.

8. Place two White rectangles ( $11 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 24 \mathrm{in} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 60.96 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with short ends RST as shown in Diagram G. Pin, sew and press seam open to make an Inner Side Border ( $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in x $471 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make two.

9. Place two White rectangles ( $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 25 \mathrm{in} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 63.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) with short ends RST as shown in Diagram H. Pin, sew and press seam open to make an Inner Top Border ( $11 / 2$ in x $491 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 125.73 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.

10. Place two Farm Fresh Trucks rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 25 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 63.5 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram I. Pin short ends RST, sew, and press seam open to make an Outer Side Border ( $41 / 2 \mathrm{in} \times 491 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 125.73 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make two. Note: Place so fabric print runs in the same direction.

11. Place two Farm Fresh Trucks rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 29 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 73.66 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram J. Pin short ends RST, sew, and press seam open to make the Outer Top Border ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 571 / 2$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border. Note: Place so fabric print runs in the same direction.

12. Add borders to the Quilt Center to complete the Quilt Top ( $571 / 2$ in $\times 571 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 146.05 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) as shown in Diagram K.

Inner Border Sides - Place the two White rectangles $\left(1 \frac{1}{2}\right.$ in $\times 471 / 2$ in / $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 120.65 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) made in Step 8 on each side of the Quilt Center. Pin, sew, and press.
Inner Border Top \& Bottom - Place the two white rectangles ( $11 / 2$ in $\times 491 / 2$ in $/ 3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 125.73 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) made in Step 9 on the top and bottom of the Quilt Center. Pin, sew, and press.
Outer Border Sides - Place the two Farm Fresh Trucks rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in $\times 491 / 2 \mathrm{in} / 11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 125.73 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) made in step 10 on each side of the new Quilt Center. Note fabric direction. Pin, sew, and press.
Outer Border Top \& Bottom - Place the two Farm Fresh Trucks rectangles ( $41 / 2$ in x $571 / 2$ in / $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times$ 146.05 cm ) made in Step 11 on the top and bottom of the new Quilt Center. Note fabric direction. Pin, sew, and press.

Match ends and middles of each border. Press seams to the outside. The finished Quilt Top should measure $571 / 2$ in $\times 571 / 2$ in ( $146.05 \mathrm{~cm} \times 146.05 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

13. To make the Trailing Lemons backing, remove the selvages and cut one piece $401 / 4$ in $\times 66$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 164.64 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), one piece $26 \frac{1}{4}$ in x $401 / 4$ in ( $66.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ), and one piece $26 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 26 \frac{1}{4}$ in ( $66.68 \mathrm{~cm} \times 66.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short sides; press, then pin RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram L. Press seams open or to one side. The Backing should measure 66 in x 66 in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

14. Press finished quilt top and backing. Tape the backing wrong side up to a firm surface. Layer batting and quilt top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
15. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess backing and batting even with the quilt top.
16. To make the Vintage Tile binding, remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in $\times$ wof ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in ( 6.35 mm ) to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in $(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded binding even with the edge of the quilt top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the binding. Fold binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
