Fabric Needed

3 Wishes® Whimsical West Collection

- 1 panel – 20278-PNL-CTN-D (Whimsical West Panel)
- 1 ¼ yds – 20274-ROY-CTN-D (Dreamcatcher Toss)
for Piecing and Binding
- 1 ¼ yds – 20276-MLT-CTN-D (Horse Stampede)
- ⅔ yd – 20273-WHT-CTN-D (Wild West Animals)
- ⅓ yd – 20275-MLT-CTN-D (Cactus Scenic)
- ¼ yd – 20277-TRQ-CTN-D (Longhorn Skulls)
- 3 ⅞ yds – 20273-WHT-CTN-D (Wild West Animals) for Backing

Not included in the 3 Wishes® Whimsical West Collection

- ½ yd – Solid White

Additional Supplies Needed:

- 69 in x 75 in (175.26 cm x 190.50 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. Label blocks as they are made. wof = width of fabric

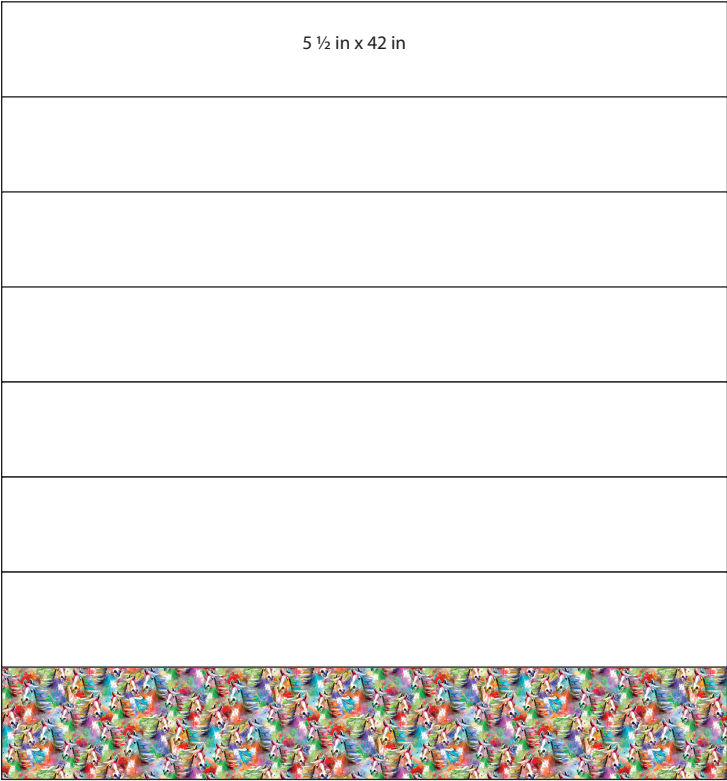
Note: A printed panel may become slightly skewed during the finishing process. Check if panel is square before cutting by folding the panel so selvages meet. If all edges do not meet, pull firmly from corner to corner until the edges meet. Continue until all corners are square.

Cutting

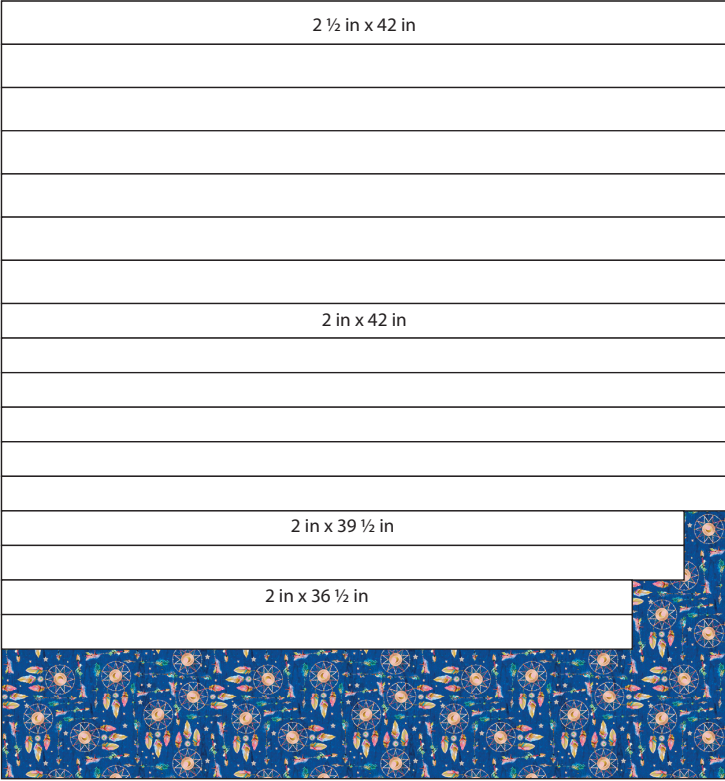
Use a rotary cutter and acrylic ruler to cut the number of pieces from each fabric listed below.



Whimsical West Panel (20278-PNL-CTN-D) – 1 yd x wof (91.44 cm x 106.68 cm)
Fussy Cut 1 – 33 ½ in x 39 ½ in (85.09 cm x 100.33 cm)



Horse Stampede (20276-MLT-CTN-D) – 1 ¼ yds x wof (114.3 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 7 – 5 ½ in x 42 in (13.97 cm x 106.68 cm)



Dreamcatcher Toss (20274-MLT-CTN-D) – 1 ¼ yds x wof (114.3 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 7 – 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) Binding
Cut 6 – 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 2 – 2 in x 39 ½ in (5.08 cm x 100.33 cm)
Cut 2 – 2 in x 36 ½ in (5.08 cm x 92.71 cm)



Wild West Animals (20273-WHIT-CTN-D) – ½ yd x wof (60.96 cm x 106.68 cm)
Cut 15 – 6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm)

White – ½ yd x wof (45.72 cm x 106.68 cm)

Cut 2 – 3 ½ in x 42 in (8.89 cm x 106.68 cm)

Cactus Scenic (20275-MLT-CTN-D) – ½ yd x wof (30.48 cm x 106.68 cm)

Cut 4 – 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm)

Longhorn Skulls (20277-TRQ-CTN-D) – ¼ yd x wof (22.86 cm x 106.68 cm)

Cut 2 – 3 ½ in x 42 in (8.89 cm x 106.68 cm)

Sewing

1. Refer to Diagram A to sew one Dreamcatcher Toss strip 2 in x 39 ½ in (5.08 cm x 100.33 cm) RST to each side of the Whimsical West Panel 33 ½ in x 39 ½ in (85.09 cm x 100.33 cm). Sew one Dreamcatcher Toss strip 2 in x 36 ½ in (5.08 cm x 92.71 cm) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Panel to make the Quilt Center. The Quilt Center should measure 36 ½ in x 42 ½ in (92.71 cm x 107.95 cm).

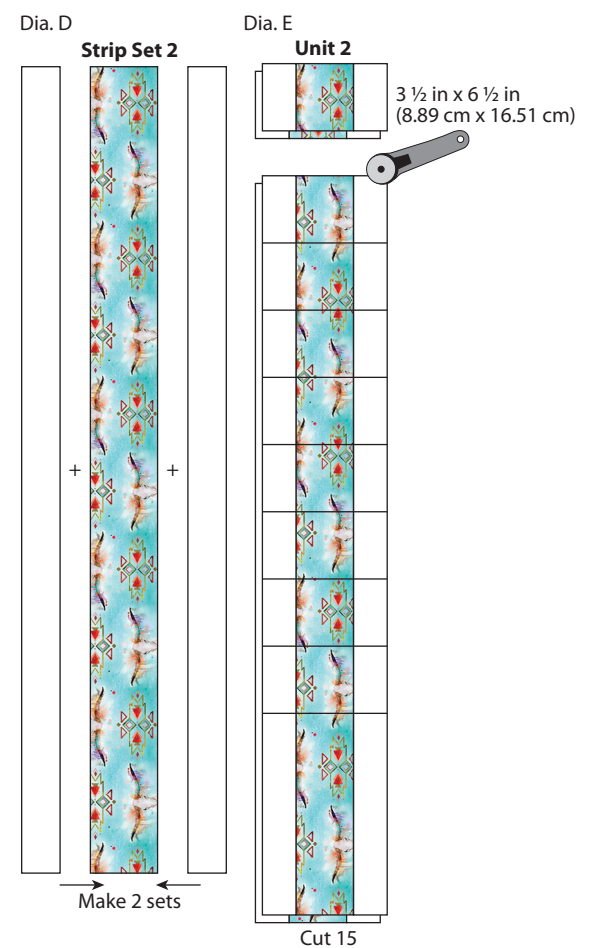

2. Refer to Diagram B to sew one Cactus Scenic strip 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm) RST to each side of one White strip 3 ½ in x 42 in (8.89 cm x 106.68 cm) to make one Strip Set 1.
Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.
3. Refer to Diagram C to cut thirty 2 in x 6 ½ in (5.08 cm x 16.51 cm) Unit 1 strips from the two Strip Set 1's.

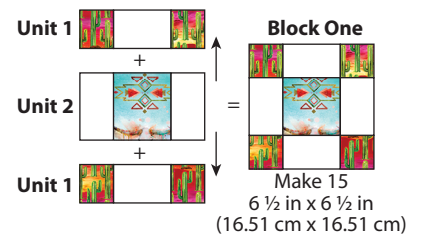


4. Refer to Diagram D to sew one White strip 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm) RST to each side of one Longhorn Skulls strip 3 ½ in x 42 in (8.89 cm x 106.68 cm) to make one Strip Set 2.
Repeat to make a second Strip Set 2.
5. Refer to Diagram E to cut fifteen 3 ½ in x 6 ½ in (8.89 cm x 16.51 cm) Unit 2 strips from the Strip Set 2's.



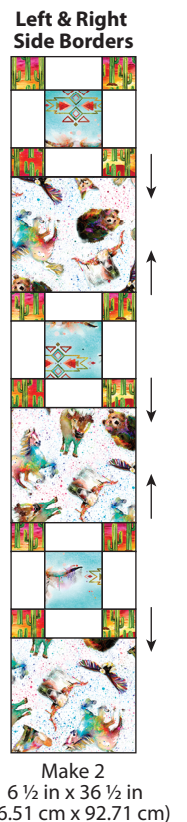
6. Refer to Diagram F to sew one Unit 1 strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 2 strip to make one 6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm) Block One square. **Note:** Check the orientation of the designs. Repeat to make fifteen Block One squares total.

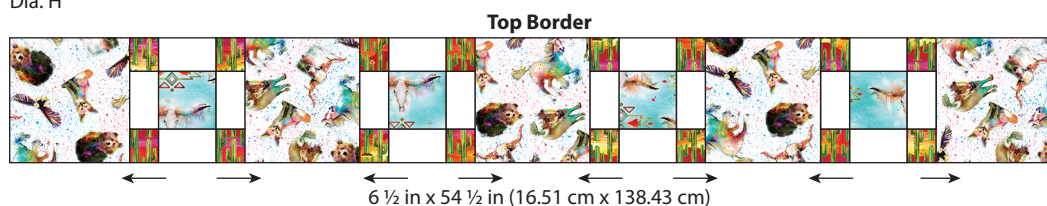
7. Refer to Diagram G to sew together three Block One squares and three Wild West Animals squares (6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm)), alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border. Repeat to make the Right Side Border. The Left and Right Side Borders should each measure 6 ½ in x 36 ½ in (16.51 cm x 92.71 cm).

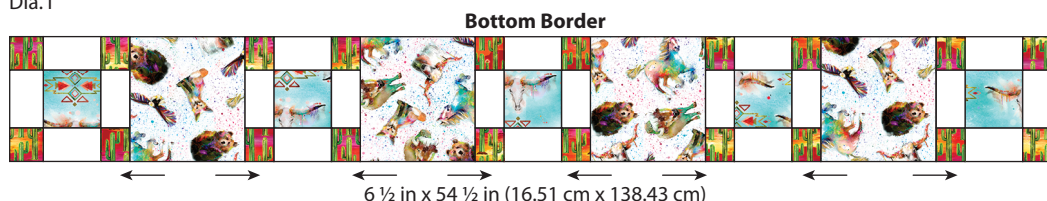
8. Refer to Diagram I to sew together five Wild West Animals squares 6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm) and four Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border. The Top Border should measure 6 ½ in x 54 ½ in (16.51 cm x 138.43 cm).

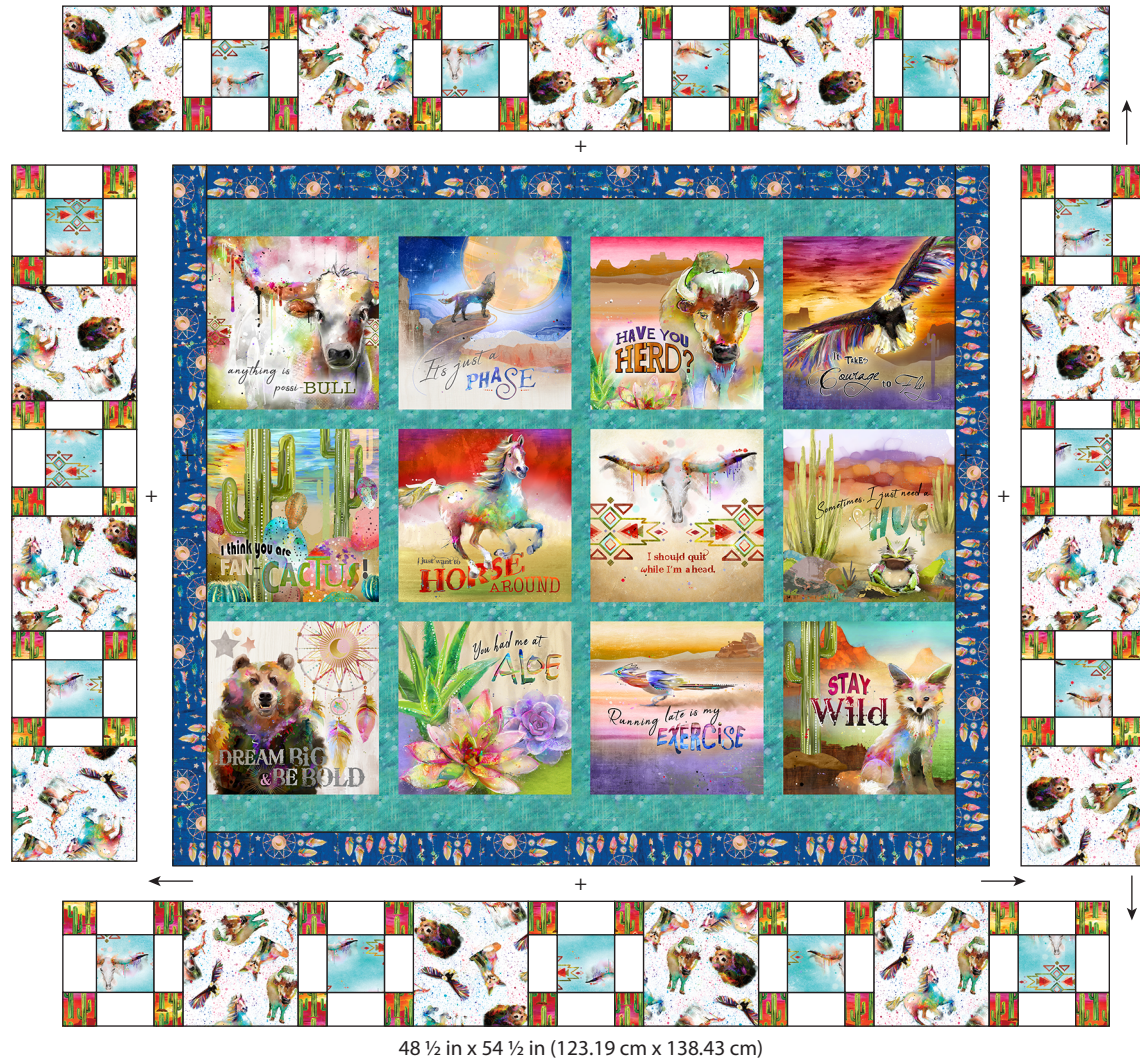
9. Refer to Diagram I to sew together five Block One squares and four Wild West Animals squares 6 ½ in x 6 ½ in (16.51 cm x 16.51 cm), alternating them from left to right, to make the Bottom Border. The Bottom Border should measure 6 ½ in x 54 ½ in (16.51 cm x 138.43 cm).

10. Refer to Diagram J to sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the right and to the left of the Quilt Center. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 48 ½ in x 54 ½ in (123.19 cm x 138.43 cm).

11. Sew three Dreamcatcher Toss strips 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip cut two Dreamcatcher Toss strips 2 in x 54 ½ in (5.08 cm x 138.43 cm). Refer to Diagram K to sew one Dreamcatcher Toss strip 2 in x 54 ½ in (5.08 cm x 138.43 cm) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Sew three Dreamcatcher Toss strips 2 in x 42 in (5.08 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip cut two Dreamcatcher Toss strips 2 in x 51 ½ in (5.08 cm x 130.81 cm). Refer to Diagram K to sew one Dreamcatcher Toss strip 2 in x 51 ½ in (5.08 cm x 130.81 cm) RST to each side of the Quilt Center. Quilt Center should measure 51 ½ in x 57 ½ in (130.81 cm x 146.65 cm).

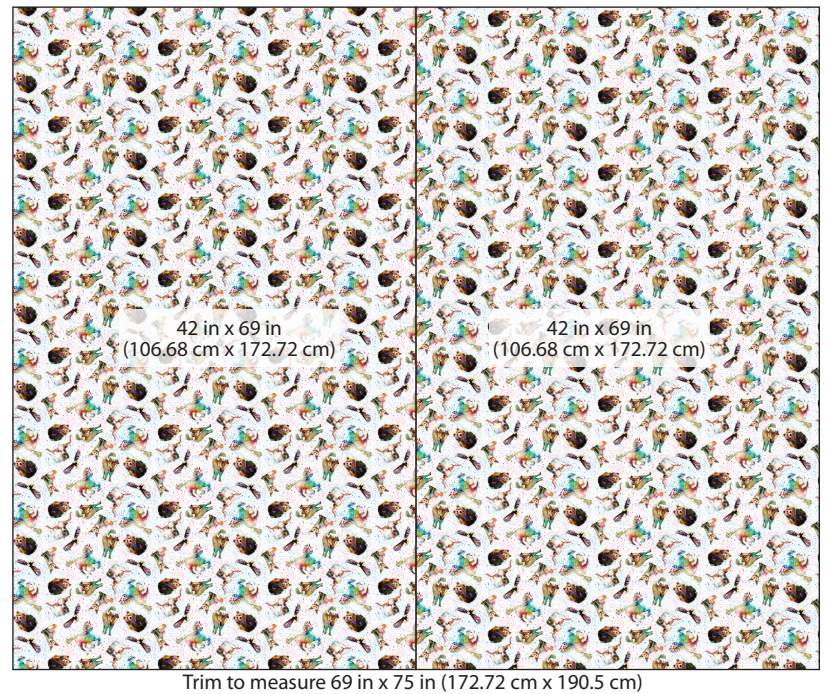
12. Sew three Horse Stampede strips 5 ½ in x 42 in (13.97 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip cut two Horse Stampede strips 5 ½ in x 57 ½ in (13.97 cm x 146.05 cm). Refer to Diagram L to sew one Horse Stampede Border strip 5 ½ in x 57 ½ in (13.97 cm x 146.05 cm) RST to the top and to the bottom of the Quilt Center. Sew four Horse Stampede strips 5 ½ in x 42 in (13.97 cm x 106.68 cm) end to end RST with diagonal seams; trim seam allowance to ¼ in (6.35 mm). From the sewn strip cut two Horse Stampede strips 5 ½ in x 61 ½ in (13.97 cm x 156.21 cm). Sew one Horse Stampede Border strip 5 ½ in x 61 ½ in (13.97 cm x 156.21 cm) RST to each side of the Quilt Center to make the completed Quilt Top. The Quilt Top should measure 61 ½ in x 67 ½ in (156.21 cm x 171.45 cm).

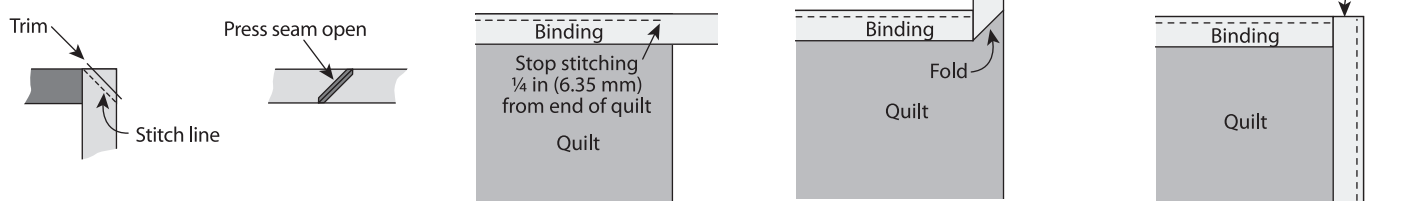
14. To make the Wild West Animals Backing, remove the selvages and cut two pieces 42 in x 69 in (106.68 cm x 172.72 cm). Pin and sew the strips RST along the long edges as shown in Diagram M. Trim the Back to measure 69 in x 75 in (175.26 cm x 190.5 cm).

15. Once the quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.
16. To make the Dreamcatcher Toss Binding, remove the selvages and sew the short ends of the seven 2 ½ in x 42 in (6.35 cm x 106.68 cm) strips RST end to end at a 45 degree angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt and sew, mitering the corners (Dia. N). Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold the Binding over to the back and hand stitch.

Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
