- $7 / 8$ yd - Plaid Paws (20238-AQU-CTN -D) for Piecing and Binding
- $5 / 8 \mathrm{yd}$ - Forest Wander (20237-GRY-CTN-D)
- $5 / 8$ yd - Allover Woodland (20239-TAN-CTN-D)
- $5 / 8$ yd - Woodland Patch (20241-WHT-CTN-D)
- $2 ½$ yds - Allover Woodland (20239-TAN-CTN-D) for Backing


## Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric ${ }^{\text {® }}$ Woodland Wander - Blue Collection

- $11 / 8 \mathrm{yds}$ - Solid White


## Additional Supplies Needed:

- 59 in $x 59$ in ( $149.86 \mathrm{~cm} \times 149.86 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)


## Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

## Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Set aside remaining fabric for making the appliques. Note: Check orientation of directional fabrics.


Plaid Paws (20238-AQU-CTN-D) - 7/8 yd ( $80.01 \mathbf{c m} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Cut $6-21 / 2$ in x wof ( $6.35 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) for Binding
Cut $8-4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$


Solid White - $11 / 8$ gds ( $102.87 \mathbf{c m} \times 106.68 \mathbf{c m}$ )
Cut 2 - $11 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut 2-1 $1 / 2$ in $\times 32 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $2-1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$
Cut $1-22^{1 / 2}$ in $\times 22 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$


Forest Wander (20237-GRY-CTN-D) - 5/8 yd ( $\mathbf{5 7 . 1 5} \mathbf{~ c m ~ x ~} 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $4-41 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$


Allover Woodland (20239-TAN-CTN-D) - 5/8 yd ( $57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $4-41 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$


Woodland Patch ( 20241 -WHT-CTN-D) - 5/8 yd ( $\mathbf{5 7 . 1 5} \mathbf{c m} \times 106.68 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Cut $4-41 / 2$ in $\times 42 \frac{1122}{}$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

1. Use the templates provided to trace the number of appliqué shapes on the paper side of fusible web as shown. in Diagram $A$. Leave $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ between shapes an cut out $1 / 8$ in $(3.18 \mathrm{~mm})$ outside the traced line.

2. Refer to Diagram B to place the fusible web appliqué pieces on the wrong side of each fabric, adhesive side down. Fuse according to the manufacturer's directions. Cut out on the traced lines. Remove paper backing.

Cut 1 - $5 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(13.97 \mathrm{~cm})$ Circle Appliqué Template
3. Refer to Diagram $C$ to position the appliqué pieces right side up on the right side of the Solid White square $22 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Center the triangle tree shapes on top of each other as shown. Note: Check that appliqué pieces are at least $3 / 4$ in ( 1.91 mm ) away from edges and check orientation of designs. Fuse to the right side of the fabric according to the manufacturer's directions. Use a coordinating thread and small buttonhole or zig-zag stitch to secure and finish the edges. The Center Appliqué Block should measure $221 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## Sewing

## Note: Check orientation of directional fabrics.

4. Place a Plaid Paws square $4 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ on each side of a Allover Woodland rectangle $41 / 2$ in $\times 22 \frac{1}{2}$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$ as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the First Border Top $41 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Repeat to make the First Border Bottom.

5. Follow Step 4 and Diagram E using four Plaid Paws squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two Forest Wander rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$ to make the Third Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 401 / 2 \mathrm{in}(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$.

6. Follow Step 4 and Diagram F using four Plaid Paws squares $41 / 2$ in $\times 41 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 11.43 \mathrm{~cm})$ and two Woodland Patch rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) to make the Fifth Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

7. Refer to Diagram G to place the Borders around the Center Appliqué Block $221 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in $(57.15 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm})$. Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin, matching center and ends. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing.

The Woodland Wander Quilt Top should measure $501 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).

## First Border

Sides: 2 - Allover Woodland rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 221 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 57.15 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: First Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $301 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in $(77.47 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm})$

## Second Border

Sides: 2 - Solid White strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 301 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 77.47 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm})$
Quilt $321 / 2$ in $\times 321 / 2$ in ( $82.55 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ )

## Third Border

Sides: 2 - Forest Wander rectangles $41 / 2$ in x $321 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 82.55 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Third Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in x $401 / 2$ in $(11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$ Quilt $40 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in ( $102.87 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Fourth Border
Sides: 2 - Solid White strips $1 \frac{1}{2}$ in $\times 401 / 2$ in $(3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 102.87 \mathrm{~cm})$
Top and Bottom: 2 - Solid White strips $11 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $3.81 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Quilt $421 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $107.95 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Fifth Border
Sides: 2 - Woodland Patch rectangles $41 / 2$ in $\times 421 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 107.95 \mathrm{~cm}$ )
Top and Bottom: Fifth Border Top and Bottom $41 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $11.43 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) Quilt $501 / 2$ in $\times 501 / 2$ in ( $128.27 \mathrm{~cm} \times 128.27 \mathrm{~cm}$ )


## Finishing

5. Remove the selvages from the Allover Woodland Backing fabric. Note: Check orientation of designs. Cut one piece $40 \frac{1}{4}$ in $\times 56$ in ( $102.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ) and two pieces $161 / 4$ in $\times 28 \frac{1}{4}$ in ( $41.28 \mathrm{~cm} \times 71.76 \mathrm{~cm}$ ). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram H. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 56 in $\times 56$ in ( $142.24 \mathrm{~cm} \times 142.24 \mathrm{~cm}$ ).
6. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, wrong side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
7. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

8. Binding - Follow Diagram I to make the Plaid Paws Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six $21 / 2$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~cm}) \times$ wof strips RST end to end at a $45^{\circ}$ angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end $1 / 4$ in $(6.35 \mathrm{~mm})$ to the wrong side. Fold in half lengthwise with wrong sides together; press. Leaving a $2 \mathrm{in}(5.08 \mathrm{~cm})$ tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.


## Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. Tip: Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
