Fabric Needed

3 Wishes Fabric® Woodland Wander – Pink Collection

- ⁷/₈ yd Rainbow Geo (20234-PNK-CTN -D) for Piecing and Binding
- 5/8 yd Framed Friends (20232-MLT-CTN-D)
- 5% yd Tumbling Foliage (20235-WHT-CTN-D)
- 3/4 yd Animal Toss (20236-MLT-CTN-D)
- 2 ½ yds Tumbling Foliage (20235-WHT-CTN-D) for Backing

Not included in the 3 Wishes Fabric[®] Woodland Wander – Pink Collection

• 1 1/8 yds – Solid White

Additional Supplies Needed:


- 59 in x 59 in (149.86 cm x 149.86 cm) Cotton batting
- Piecing and sewing thread
- Quilting and sewing supplies
- Even-feed foot (optional for quilting)

Before You Begin

Read all instructions before beginning project. Do not pre-wash fabrics. Press fabrics with a dry iron on cotton setting before cutting. Use a ¼ in (6.35mm) seam allowance and sew fabrics with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Press seams in the direction of the arrows. wof = width of fabric

Cutting

Use a rotary cutter and ruler to cut the size and number of squares and rectangles from each fabric listed below. Set aside remaining fabric for making the appliqués. *Note:* Check orientation of directional fabrics.




Animal Toss (20236-MLT-CTN-D) – $\frac{3}{4}$ yd (68.58 cm x 106.68 cm) Cut 4 – 4 ½ in x 42 ½ in (11.43 cm x 107.95 cm)


Cut 2 – 1 ½ in x 30 ½ in (3.81 cm x 77.47 cm)

Cut 1 – 22 ½ in x 22 ½ in (57.15 cm x 57.15 cm)

1. Use the templates provided to trace the number of appliqué shapes on the paper side of fusible web as shown. in Diagram A. Leave ¼ in (6.35 mm) between shapes an cut out ½ in (3.18 mm) outside the traced line.



2. Refer to Diagram B to place the fusible web appliqué pieces on the **wrong** side of each fabric, adhesive side down. Fuse according to the manufacturer's directions. Cut out on the traced lines. Remove paper backing.




Rainbow Geo (20234-PNK-CTN-D)

Cut 1 – 5 ¹/₂ in (13.97 cm) Circle Appliqué Template

- Cut 1 Lg. Trunk Appliqué
- Cut 1 Med. Trunk Appliqué

Cut 1 – Sm. Trunk Appliqué


3. Refer to Diagram C to position the appliqué pieces right side up on the right side of the Solid White square 22 ½ in x 22 ½ in (57.15 cm x 57.15 cm). Center the triangle tree shapes on top of each other as shown. *Note:* Check that appliqué pieces are at least ¾ in (1.91 mm) away from edges and check orientation of designs. Fuse to the right side of the fabric according to the manufacturer's directions. Use a coordinating thread and small buttonhole or zig-zag stitch to secure and finish the edges. The Center Appliqué Block should measure 22 ½ in x 22 ½ in (57.15 cm).



Sewing

Note: Check orientation of directional fabrics.

4. Place a Rainbow Geo square 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) on each side of a Tumbling Foliage rectangle 4 ½ in x 22 ½ in (11.43 cm x 57.15 cm) as shown in Diagram D. Pin RST, sew and press to make the First Border Top 4 ½ in x 30 ½ in (11.43 cm x 77.47 cm). Repeat to make the First Border Bottom.





5. Follow Step 4 and Diagram E using four Rainbow Geo squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) and two Framed Friends rectangles 4 ½ in x 32 ½ in (11.43 cm x 82.55 cm) to make the Third Border Top and Bottom 4 ½ in x 40 ½ in (11.43 cm x 102.87 cm).







6. Follow Step 4 and Diagram F using four Rainbow Geo squares 4 ½ in x 4 ½ in (11.43 cm x 11.43 cm) and two Animal Toss rectangles 4 ½ in x 42 ½ in x 42 ½ in (11.43 cm x 107.95 cm) to make the Fifth Border Top and Bottom 4 ½ in x 50 ½ in (11.43 cm x 128.27 cm).

7. Refer to Diagram G to place the Borders around the Center Appliqué Block 22 ½ in x 22 ½ in (57.15 cm x 57.15 cm). Sew each Border RST in the order listed. Pin, matching center and ends. Press seams as shown. Measure at each step to ensure the next border will fit. If one border is a little larger than the border it is being sewn to, pin well to ease the fullness and place the fullness on the bottom while sewing.

The Woodland Wander Quilt Top should measure 50 ½ in x 50 ½ in (128.27 cm x 128.27 cm).

First Border

Sides: 2 – Tumbling Foliage rectangles 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 57.15 cm) Top and Bottom: First Border Top and Bottom 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 77.47 cm) Quilt 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 30 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (77.47 cm x 77.47 cm)

Second Border

Sides: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 30 ½ in (3.81 cm x 77.47 cm) Top and Bottom: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 32 ½ in (3.81 cm x 82.55 cm) Quilt 32 ½ in x 32 ½ in (82.55 cm x 82.55 cm)

Third Border


Sides: 2 – Framed Friends rectangles 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 82.55 cm) Top and Bottom: Third Border Top and Bottom 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (11.43 cm x 102.87 cm) Quilt 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ in x 40 $\frac{1}{2}$ in (102.87 cm x 102.87 cm)

Fourth Border

Sides: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 40 ½ in (3.81 cm x 102.87 cm) Top and Bottom: 2 – Solid White strips 1 ½ in x 42 ½ in (3.81 cm x 107.95 cm) Quilt 42 ½ in x 42 ½ in (107.95 cm x 107.95 cm)

Fifth Border


Sides: 2 – Animal Toss rectangles 4 ½ in x 42 ½ in (11.43 cm x 107.95 cm) Top and Bottom: Fifth Border Top and Bottom 4 ½ in x 50 ½ in (11.43 cm x 128.27 cm) Quilt 50 ½ in x 50 ½ in (128.27 cm x 128.27 cm)


Finishing

- 5. Remove the selvages from the Tumbling Foliage Backing fabric. *Note:* Check orientation of designs. Cut one piece 40 ¼ in x 56 in (102.24 cm x 142.24 cm) and two pieces 16 ¼ in x 28 ¼ in (41.28 cm x 71.76 cm). Pin RST and sew the two smaller pieces on the short edges; press. Pin the two sections RST and sew along the long edges as shown in Diagram H. Press the seam open or to one side. The Backing should measure 56 in x 56 in (142.24 cm x 142.24 cm).
- 6. Press finished Quilt Top and Backing. Tape the Backing, **wrong** side up, to a firm surface. Layer Batting and Quilt Top (right side up). Baste the layers together with safety pins. Quilt as desired.
- 7. Once quilting is complete, square up corners and edges, trimming excess Backing and Batting even with the Quilt Top.

8. **Binding** – Follow Diagram I to make the Rainbow Geo Binding. Remove selvages and sew the short ends of the six 2 ½ in (6.35 cm) x wof strips RST end to end at a 45° angle to make one continuous strip; press seams open. Press one short end ¼ in (6.35 mm) to the **wrong** side. Fold in half lengthwise with **wrong** sides together; press. Leaving a 2 in (5.08 cm) tail on the folded end, place cut edges of folded Binding even with the edge of the Quilt Top and sew, mitering the corners. Overlap ends, trim any excess and finish sewing the Binding. Fold Binding over to back and hand stitch.



Finished Care Instructions

Machine wash in cold water; gentle cycle. Do not bleach. **Tip:** Before drying, check for fabric dyes that may have run. If fabric dyes run, rewash and rinse using a color catcher to absorb loose dye. Lay flat to dry or tumble dry low.
