

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# Cutting

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### Fabric A (7312P-22 36 inch Panel – Pink):

• Fussy cut (1) 34 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 42 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" rectangle centered on the panel.

#### Fabric B (Cinnamon Pink-65 Peppered Cottons – Cinnamon Pink), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 37 ½" WOF strips.
- (7)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric C (1351-Powder Pink Just Color! - Powder Pink), cut:

• (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (80) 2 1/2" squares.

#### Fabric D (7310-22 Small Butterfly Toss – Pink), cut:

• (1) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" squares.

#### Fabric E (7311-11 Ribbon Toss – Light Blue), cut:

• (2) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips, (11) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### Fabric F (7307-02 Word Print – White), cut:

• (1) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strip, sub-cut (9) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### Fabric G (7308-22 Butterflies on Script – Pink), cut:

• (2) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips, sub-cut (11) 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### Fabric H (7309-22 Flower and Ribbon Toss - Pink), cut:

• (2) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips, (9) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 6 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.

#### Fabric I (1351-Carnation Just Color! - Carnation), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 ½" strips.

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

#### Fabric J (7306-22 Patchwork – Pink), cut:

- (2) 6" x 59 ½" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6" x 62 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### Backing (7309-22 Flower and Ribbon Toss – Pink), cut:

• (2) 70" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 70" x 78" to make the back.

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
# Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

#### **Block Assembly**

# Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Sew (1) 2" x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 37  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 36**  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".




2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square on the bottom left corner of (1) 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the small square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to the lower right corner of the 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 5).

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (11) Block One rectangles total.




5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-8 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (9) Block Two rectangles, (11) Block Three rectangles and (9) Block Four rectangles.



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
6. Follow Figure 9 and sew together (11) assorted Block rectangles along their long sides to make the Left Side Border.

7. Follow Figure 10 and sew together (11) assorted Block rectangles along their long sides to make the Right Side Border.



8. Follow Figure 11 and sew together (9) assorted Block rectangles along their long sides. Sew (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 11).

9. Follow Figure 12 and sew together (9) assorted Block rectangles along their long sides. Sew (1)  $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 12).



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

10. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

11. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 2" x 56  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 6" x 59  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6" x 62  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

### Layering, Quilting and Finishing


14. Press the quilt top and 70" x 78" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

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#### Binding

15. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

16. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
