$3 / 8$ yard Paw Print Allover - White (D)
$1 / 4$ yard Paw Print Allover - Black (E)
$3 / 8$ yard Tossed Dogs - Red (F)
$1 / 4$ yard Hearts and Bones - Yellow G)
$3 / 8$ yard Word Print - Blue (H)
$1 / 2$ yard Folio - Black (I)
$1 / 2$ yard Word Print - Red (J)
3 yards Tossed Dogs - Blue (Backing)

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Dog Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) $221 / 2 " \times 26 "$ strip centered on the saying.
-(6) $71 / 4$ " squares each centered a dog.
From the Folio - Sepia Brown (B), cut:
- (2) $21 / 2$ " $\times 26^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $2 " \times 71 / 4 "$ strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x $101 / 4 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 7 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $11 / 4 " \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Dogs - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 7 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 " squares.

From the Paw Print Allover - White (D), cut:

- (4) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 " x $81 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x $91 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Paw Print Allover - Black (E), cut:

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 5 " x $41 / 2 "$ strips,
(2) $5 " \times 41 / 4 "$ strips, (2) $5 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $41 / 4 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Dogs - Red (F), cut:

- (1) $53 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $53 / 4 " \times 53 / 4 "$ squares,
(2) $5 \frac{3 / 4 "}{} \times 5$ " strips and (2) $5 " \times 5 "$ squares.
- (1) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 4 " \times 6 "$ strips.

From the Hearts and Bones - Yellow (G), cut:

- (1) $53 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $53 / 4 " \times 41 / 4 "$ strips,
(2) $5 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips, (2) $5 " \times 31 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $41 / 4 " \times 4 "$ strips.

From the Word Print - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $5 " \times 53 / 4 "$ strips and
(2) $5 " \times 5 "$ squares.
- (1) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $41 / 4 " \times 6 "$ strips.

From the Folio - Black (I), cut:
-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ strips.

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 451 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Word Print - Red (J), cut:
-(5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Tossed Dogs - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) $53 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53 " x 57 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $221 / 2 " \times 26^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric A strip. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 261 / 2 "$
Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip. Trim the block to measure $241 / 2 " \times 281 / 2 "$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) $2 " \times 7 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $71 / 4 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $101 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the unit to measure $81 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

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3. Sew (1) $1 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1" $\times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.
4. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 7 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 " Fabric C square. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to


Fig. 3 the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.
5. Sew (1) $1 " \times 81 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1 " x $91 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.

6. Sew (1) $5 " \times 5 \frac{3}{4} "$ Fabric F strip to the top of (1) 5 " $\times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to make the left column. Sew (1) $5 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top of (1) 5 " $\times 53 / 4$ " Fabric H strip to make the right column. Sew the (2) columns together lengthwise to make (1) $91 / 2 " \times 93 / 4$ " Block Three rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.

8. Sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 5 "$ Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) 5" Fabric H square to make the top row. Sew (1) 5" Fabric F square to the left side of (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times 5$ " Fabric G strip to make the bottom row. Sew the (2) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 8 " x $91 / 2 "$ Block Five rectangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Block Five rectangle.
9. Sew (1) $41 / 4 " \times 6 "$ Fabric H strip to the top of (1) $41 / 4 " \times 4 "$ Fabric E strip to make the left column. Sew (1) $41 / 4 " \times 4$ " Fabric G strip to the top of (1) $41 / 4 " \times 6$ " Fabric F strip to make the right column. Sew the (2) columns together lengthwise to make (1) 8 " x $91 / 2 "$ Block Six rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Block Six rectangle.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew together (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Two Square and (1) Block Four rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make Left Side Border. Sew the Left Side Border to the left side of the Center Block.
11. Sew together (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Two square and (1) Block Three rectangle, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border. Sew the Right Side Border to the right side of the Center Block.
12. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six rectangle and (1) Block One square, in that order, to make the Top Border. Sew the Top Border to the top of the Center Block.
13. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Six rectangle, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five rectangle and (1) Block One square, in that order, to make the Bottom Border. Sew the Bottom Border to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $451 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (5) $21 / 2$ " $x$ WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.

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
