Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (2834-57 Purple Haze), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (8) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square and (5) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.

Fabric B (2834-77 Deep Water), cut:

- (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric C (2834-25 Sweetheart Pink), cut:

- (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric D (2834-09 Gravel), cut:

- (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric E (2834-67 Aquarium), cut:

- (1) 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

Fabric F (2835-57 Purple Haze), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric G (2835-77 Deep Water), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric H (2835-25 Sweetheart Pink), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric I (2835-03 Earth), cut:

- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric J (2835-67 Aquarium), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (13) 4 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares and (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip.

Fabric K (2836-57 Purple Haze), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 3" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric L (2836-77 Deep Water), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 3" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric M (2836-25 Sweetheart Pink), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 3" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric N (2836-03 Earth), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 3" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Cutting - Cont.

Fabric O (2836-09 Gravel), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 ½" strips and (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.

Fabric P (2836-67 Aquarium), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 4 ½" strips and (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.

Fabric Q (14 Charcoal), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" square.

Fabric R (22 Green Tea), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 4 ½" square and (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

Fabric S (28 Morning Glory), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 4 ½" square and (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.

Fabric T (31 Pepper), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" square.

Fabric U (34 Aubergine), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.

Fabric V (35 Oyster), cut:

- (4) 4 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (26) 4 ⅞" squares and (2) 4 ½" squares.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (20) 2 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end, and cut (5) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

Fabric W (40 Fuchsia), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" square.

Fabric X (42 Magenta), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (1) 4 ½" square and (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric Y (50 Coffee Bean), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut the strip into (2) 3" x 9 ½" strips.

Backing (2834-67 Aquarium), cut:

- (2) 64" x WOF strips.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Place (1) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric V square on top of (1) Fabric A square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 1). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 1). Cut the two squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2) to make two AV units. (Fig. 3). Trim the AV units to measure $4\frac{1}{2}$ " square. Repeat to make (26) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " AV units. **(Note: You will only use [25] of the units.)**

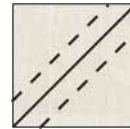

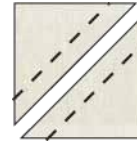

2. Repeat Step 1 using (13) $4\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric J squares and (13) Fabric V squares to make (26) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " JV units (Fig. 4). **(Note: You will only use [25] of the units.)**

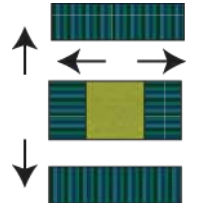

3. Follow Figure 5 and sew (2) $3" \times 4\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric P strips, (2) $3" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric P strips and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric R square together to make (1) PR block.

4. Repeat Step 5 to make (1) MW block, (1) NT block, (1) LS block, (1) KX block and (1) OQ block (Fig. 6).

5. Follow Figure 7 and sew (1) $3" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric S strip to each side of (1) $4\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$ Fabric G strip to make (1) SG block.

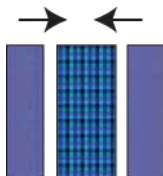

6. Repeat Step 5 to make (1) UF block, (1) XH block, (1) RJ block and (1) YI block (Fig. 8).

Quilt Top Assembly

7. Refer to Figure 9 to sew the assorted blocks, assorted 9 ½" squares and (20) 2 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric V strips and (5) 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric V strips together to make the quilt top.

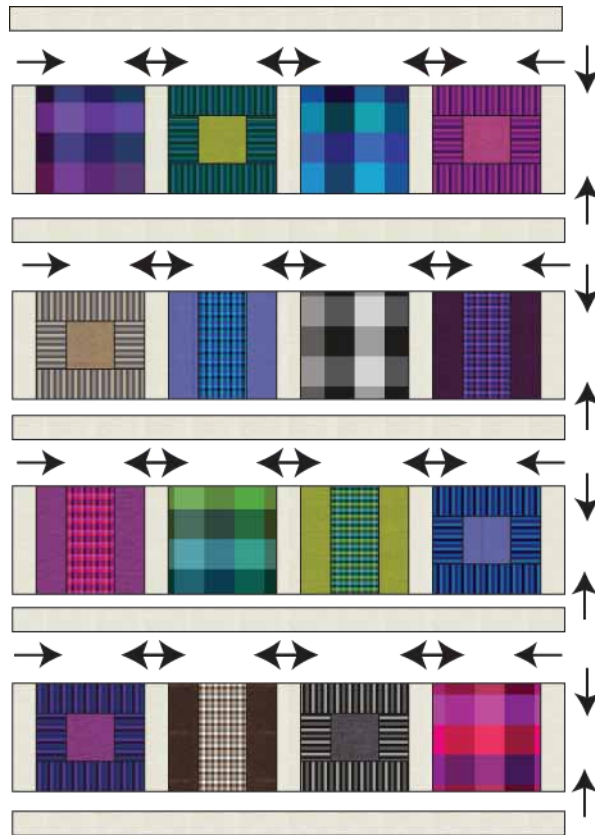

8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric R strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric R strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top (Fig. 10).

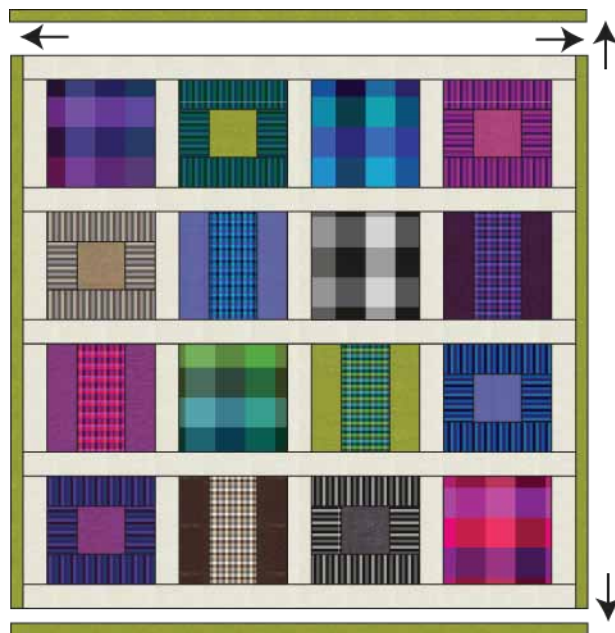

9. Sew (6) AV units and (6) JV units together, alternating them, to make (1) side border. Repeat to make a second side border. Sew the borders to each side of the quilt top (Fig. 11).

10. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric V square, (7) AV units and (6) JV units together to make the top border. Sew (7) JV units, (6) AV units and (1) 4 ½" Fabric V square to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the bottom of the quilt top (Fig. 12).

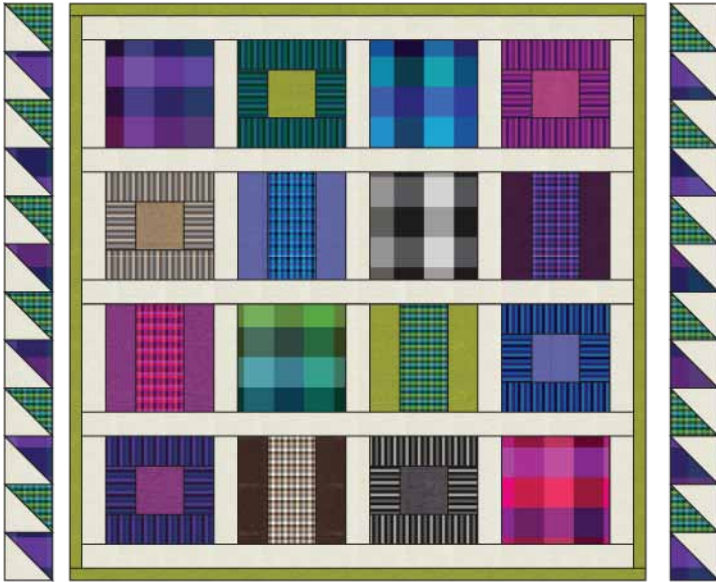

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

11. Sew the (2) 64" x WOF strips together and trim to make (1) 64" x 64" backing piece.

12. Press the quilt top and backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

13. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric X binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make one continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
