## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
WOF = Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric
Fabric A (6613-97 Large Blocks 24in x 44in - Multi):

- Fussy cut (6) 10" squares, each centered on a block.

Fabric B (6612-33 Weave Texture - Mustard), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 " x 10 " strips.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 " x 13" strips.

Fabric C (6608-90 Set Small Dots - Black), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 \prime$ " W WOF strips, sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric D (6606-66 Tossed Leaves - Green), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric E (6600-79 Tossed Zoo Animals - Multi), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{112 "}{2 \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric F (6607-69 Tossed Zebra - Green), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric G (6602-79 Tossed Panda Bear - Multi), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 71 / 4 "$ strips.

Fabric H (6605-31 Tossed Giraffe - Multi), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{112 "}{2 \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric I (6603-72 Tossed Flamingos - Multi), cut:

- (1) $71 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (2) $7 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric J (6604-73 Tossed Blue Birds - Multi), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (3) $31 / 2$ " x $491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric K (6601-96 Tossed Bamboo Leaves - Multi), cut:

- (4) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4$ " x $671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (3) $13 / 4$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4$ " x 52 " strips.
- (8) $11 / 2$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $491 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric L (6609-83 Tossed Colorful Birds - Multi), cut:

- (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 70" strips.
- (3) 4 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 " x 59" strips.

Fabric M (6611-66 Diamond Texture - Green), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric N (Fog-47 Peppered Cottons - Fog), cut:

- (1) 5 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5 " x $7 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) 5 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 5 " x $61 / 2 "$ " strips.
- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $4 \frac{3}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ strips and (4) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 " x 7 1/4" strips.
- (1) 3 " x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 " x $61 / 2$ " strips.
- (7) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 "$ x 6 " strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) $11 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times 12$ " strips.

Backing (6606-66 Leaves - Green), cut:

- (2) 85 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 67 " x 85 " to make the back.

Sew using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Block Assembly

## Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. <br> Unit 1

1. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6$ " Fabric $N$ strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square to make 24 make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.

2. Sew (1) 2 " x 10 " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 13$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Trim the unit to measure 12" x 12". Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.
3. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " $\times 12^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $N$ strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 16 " x $131 / 2$ " Block One rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block One rectangles total.

4. Sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{3}{4 \prime \prime}$ Fabric N strip to the top of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Sew (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric N strip to the bottom of the Fabric D strip to make (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2 "$ Block Two strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.
5. Sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 43 / 4 "$ Fabric N strip to the top of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 41 / 4$ " Fabric N strip to the bottom of the Fabric F strip to make (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Block Three strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Three strip.

6. Sew (1) 3 " x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric N strip, (1) $61 / 2 "$ Fabric E square and (1) 5" x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric $N$ strip together lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the newly sewn block lengthwise to make (1) $10 \frac{1}{2}{ }^{\prime} \times 131 / 2$ " Block Four rectangle (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.
7. Sew (1) 5 " x $7 \frac{1}{4} 4^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric N strip, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $71 / 4$ " Fabric G strip and (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4$ " Fabric $N$ strip together lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the newly sewn block lengthwise to make (1) $11 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $131 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Block Five rectangle (Fig. 7).

8. Sew (1) 3 " x $61 / 2 "$ Fabric N strip, (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric H square and (1) $5^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric $N$ strip together in that order from the top to the bottom to make (1) $61 / 2 "$ x $131 / 2 "$ Block Six strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (5) Block Six strips total.
9. Sew (1) $3^{\prime \prime} \times 71 / 4 "$ Fabric N strip, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 1 / 4 "$ Fabric I strip and (1) 5" x $71 / 4$ " Fabric N strip together in that order from top to bottom. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of the newly sewn block lengthwise to make (1) $11 \frac{1}{4}$ " x $131 / 2$ " Block Seven strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second

10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 49 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip lengthwise to make (1) Block Eight strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (3) Block Eight strips total.

11. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block One rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 11).
12. Repeat Step 11 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
13. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 11-12 and the (3) Block Eight strips, lengthwise alternating them from top to bottom, to make the $491 / 2 " \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Center Block (Fig. 11).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
14. Sew $13 / 4 "$ x $671 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4$ " x 52 " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) 4" x 70 " Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" x 59 " Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

16. Press the quilt top and 67 " $\times 85$ " backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

17. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric $M$ binding strips at a 45 -degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
18. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

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
