



## **Cutting**

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### Fabric A (5814P-98 36-inch Panel - Black Multi):

• Fussy cut (1) 29 ½" x 35 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### Fabric B (5812-28 Polka Dots - Fuchsia), cut:

- (2) 2" x 35 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

#### Fabric C (5808-98 Small Hearts - Black Multi), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 45 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½ " x 41 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½ " x 37 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½ " x 33 ½" WOF strips.

#### Fabric D (5809-19 Tossed Alphabet - White Multi), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (7) 3 ½" squares.

#### Fabric E (5805-98 Large Circles - Black Multi), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.

#### Fabric F (5808-19 Small Hearts - White Multi), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (7) 3 ½" squares.

#### Fabric G (5810-89 Rainbow - Multi), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.

#### Fabric H (5813-77 Tonal Tossed Numbers - Royal), cut:

- (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (7) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 4 ¼" triangles. *Note: You will use (26) 4 ¼" triangles.*
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric I (5812-64 Polka Dots - Lime), cut:

• (1) 4 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (7) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (28) 4 ¼" triangles. *Note: You will use (26) 4 ¼" triangles.* 

#### Fabric J (1351-Iron Just Color! - Iron), cut:

• (2) 4 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (13) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (52) 4 ¼" triangles.

#### Fabric K (5807-98 Patterned Triangles - Black Multi), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 47 ½" strips.
- (2) 4 ½ " x 41 ½" WOF strips.

#### Fabric L (5806-09 Stadium Animals - White and Black), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

#### Backing (5805-98 Large Circles - Black Multi), cut:

• (2) 57" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 57" x 63" to make the back.



Sew using a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

- 1. Sew (1) 2" x 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 29  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 35  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 32 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 31 ½" x 37 ½".
- 2. Sew together (1) 4 ¼" Fabric J triangle and (1) 4 ¼" Fabric H triangle to make (1) JH triangle. Sew together (1) 4 ¼" Fabric I triangle and (1) 4 1/4" Fabric I triangle to make (1) II triangle. Sew together the JH and IJ triangles along their long sides to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). The unit should measure 3 ½" square. Repeat to make (26) Unit 1 squares total.



Right Side

- 3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (7) Unit 1 squares, (2) 3 ½" Fabric F squares, (2) 3 ½" Fabric G squares, (1) 3 ½" Fabric D square and (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square to make the Left Side Border.
- 4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side, Top Border and Bottom Border.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

#### (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)


- 5. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 37  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 33  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 6. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 7. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 8. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 9. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $47\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square to each end of (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $41\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

#### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

10. Press the quilt top and 57" x 63" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

#### **Binding**

- 11. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric H binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 12. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
