Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (4711-33 Zig Zag Tex - Cream), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric B (4711-99 Zig Zag Tex – Black), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric C (4712-32 Quatrefoil - Cream/Pink), cut:

• (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.

Fabric D (4712-37 Quatrefoil - Cream/Blue), cut:

• (2) 62 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together matching seams and trim to 48 ¹/₂" x 62 ¹/₂" for the background.

Fabric E (4714-25 Medallion – Fuchsia), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric F (4714-77 Medallion – Blue), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric G (4715-17 Mini Butterfly Toss – Blue), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric H (4715-33 Mini Butterfly Toss – Cream), cut:

- (2) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (18) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.
- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip for paper piecing.

Fabric I (4715-99 Mini Butterfly Toss – Black), cut:

• (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric J (4716-37 Butterfly Damask – Cream/Blue), cut:

• (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric K (4716-35 Butterfly Damask – Cream/Fuchsia), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric L (1351-Orange Just Color! - Orange), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles. *Note: Only (10) of the triangles will be used.*
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

Fabric M (1351-Lipstick Just Color! – Lipstick), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" x 5" strips.
- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles. *Note: Only (10) of the triangles will be used.*
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

Fabric N (1351-Red Delicious Just Color! - Red Delicious), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) triangles. *Note: Only (14) of the triangles will be used.*
- (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips.

Cutting - Continued

Fabric O (1351-Aegean Blue Just Color! - Aegean Blue), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) triangles.
- (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip for paper piecing.
- (9) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric P (1351-Mint Just Color! - Mint), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles. *Note: Only (10) of the triangles will be used.*
- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.
- (3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric Q (4710-33 Butterfly Dreams Patchwork - Cream), cut:

- (4) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, matching seams, and cut (2) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, matching seams, and cut (2) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ strips.

Fabric R (1351-Sea Glass Just Color! - Sea Glass), cut:

• (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles.

Fabric S (1351-Light Teal Just Color! - Light Teal), cut:

• (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles. *Note: Only (22) of the triangles will be used.*

Fabric T (1351-Teal Just Color! - Teal), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles. *Note: Only (22) of the triangles will be used.*
- (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 62 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.

Fabric U (1351-Chambray Just Color! - Chambray), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) triangles.
- (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" x 5" strips for paper piecing.
- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip for paper piecing.

Fabric V (1351-Orchid Just Color! - Orchid), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (20) triangles.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Fabric W (1351-Grape Just Color! - Grape), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles.
- (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strip for paper piecing.

Fabric X (1351-Plum Just Color! – Plum), cut:

• (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) triangles. *Note: Only (22) of the triangles will be used.*

Fabric Y (1351-Onyx Just Color! – Onyx), cut:

- (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles. *Note: Only (10) of the triangles will be used.*
- See instructions to cut (12) Butterfly Bodies.

Fabric Z (1351-Carnation Just Color! – Carnation), cut:

- (1) 3 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) triangles. *Note: Only (14) of the triangles will be used.*
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for paper piecing.

Cutting - Continued

Fabric AA (1351-Sunshine Just Color! – Sunshine), cut:

• (1) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (12) triangles. *Note: Only (10) of the triangles will be used.*

Fabric BB (1351-Cream Just Color! - Cream), cut:

- (5) 3 ¹/₄" x WOF strips, sub-cut (59) 3 ¹/₄" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (236) triangles.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" squares.

Backing (4710-33 Butterfly Dreams Patchwork – Cream), cut:

• (3) $88^{"}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 88" x 102" to make the back.


Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.


Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) Fabric R triangle, (2) Fabric BB triangles and (1) Fabric S triangle together to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim unit to measure 2 ½" square. Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-18 for fabric identification and placement to make the designated number of units for Units 2 through Unit 18.



3. Sew (26) assorted units together. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric BB square to each end of the sewn strip to make (1) Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border. (Fig. 19).



4. Sew (33) assorted units together to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border (Fig. 20).

5. Using your favorite paper piecing method, construct the (3) of each of the (16) different wing sections, following the letters on each template for fabric placement.

6. Refer to the quilt layout and using your favorite method, applique (1) set of Wing 1 sections and (1) Fabric J Butterfly body onto the $48 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $62 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D background. Repeat to applique the remaining wings and butterfly bodies to the background to make the quilt top. *Note: If using the fusible applique technique, trim off the seam allowance on all pieces before pressing the sections to the quilt top.*

7. Using your favorite method, embroider on the butterfly antennae.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric T strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric T strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) Side Border strip to each side of the Center Block.

10. Sew the Top and Bottom Borders to the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 80 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


Layering, Quilting and Finishing

12. Press the quilt top and 88" x 102" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

13. Cut the ends of the (9) Fabric O binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.





Quilt Layout

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
