

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# Cutting

## **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (7333-92 Crochet Thread – Black Multi), cut:

• (1) 27 ½" x 20 ½" WOF strip.

Fabric B (7329-42 Craft Room Pegboard – Ecru/Pink), cut: • (1) 6 16" x WOE strip, sub-cut (2) 6 16" x 18 16" strips

• (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 6 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

Fabric C (7340-82 Bobbins – Red/Pink), cut:

• (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 5" x 18 1/2" strips.

Fabric D (7332-49 Overlock Plaid – Ecru/Multi), cut:

• (1) 5" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 5" x 18 ½" strips.

**Fabric E (7339-55 Rotary Cutters – Amethyst), cut:** • (1) 6" x WOF strip.

**Back (7334-92 Embroidery Floss – Black Multi), cut:** • (1) 27 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 20 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strip.

Fusible Fleece, cut:

• (1) 20 ½" x 27 ½" WOF strip.

# Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.


## **Organizer Assembly**

### Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (2)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x 18 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips right sides together. Sew the strips together on all four sides, leaving a 3" opening at the bottom for turning. Turn the newly sewn strip right side out through the opening and press to make Pocket One (Fig. 1).

2. Repeat Step 1 with (2) 5" x 18 ½" Fabric C strips to make Pocket Two (Fig. 2).

3. Repeat Step 1 with (2) 5" x 18 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric D strips to make Pocket Three (Fig. 3).



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4. Press the 20 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric A rectangle to the piece of the 20 ½" x 27 ½" fusible fleece. Quilt as desired to make Unit 1 strip.

5. Fold the Unit 1 strip in half lengthwise and press to make the centerline to use as a guide to center the Pockets (Fig. 4).

6. Refer to Figure 5 to position Pocket One 4" down from the top edge of the Unit 1 strip. Pin the pocket in place. Topstitch down each short side and across the bottom to attach the pocket to the Unit 1 strip. *Note: This should also close the opening at the bottom of the pocket by catching it in the sewn seam.* 


7. Position Pocket Two 3" down from the bottom edge of the Pocket One. Pin the pocket in place. Topstitch down each short side and across the bottom to attach the pocket to the Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).

8. Position Pocket Three 3" down from the bottom edge of the Pocket Two. Pin the pocket in place. Topstitch down each short side and across the bottom to attach the pocket to the Unit 1 strip to make the Organizer Front (Fig. 5).


9. You can leave the pockets as is or you can divide the pockets up into smaller pockets by stitching vertical lines through both the pocket F and the Unit 1 strip.


10. To make the Hanging Strap, fold the 6" x WOF Fabric E strip in half lengthwise and press (Fig. 6). Open the folded fabric and fold each long edge to the creased centerline and press (Fig. 7).

11. Fold the pressed fabric in half again and press to make (1)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip (Fig. 8). Top stitch down both long sides 1/8" in from the edge to complete the Hanging Strap (Fig. 9).









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12. Pin the Hanging Strap to the Organizer Front at the upper right corner about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the side edge, measure how long you would like the strap and trim as desired. Pin the other end of the strap to the upper left corner, about  $\frac{1}{2}$ " from the side edge with the strap hanging down the front of the Organizer Front (Fig. 10).




Fig. 11

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

13. Place the 20 ½" x 27 ½" Backing strip on top of the organizer with the strap in between the layers right sides together (Fig. 11). Stitch the layered pieces together on all four sides, leaving a small opening for turning. Turn the organizer right side out, press and topstitch around the organizer to complete.


