(E) 1351-Royal*	1 yard ⁺⁺
(F) 7287-33	4 yards
Backing 7281-77	3 yards

Sewing and Quilting thread




7287-33 Static Border Stripe 24"



Cutting and Sewing

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted. (WOF = Width of Fabric, LOF = Length of Fabric).

Fabric A (7289P-77 Fractal Forest Panel 24" - Cream):

*Trim panel to 23" x 43".

Fabric B (7282-77 Beads - Indigo), cut:

*(4) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

Fabric C (7283-77 Mini Floral - Indigo), cut:

*(4) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for border 4.

Fabric D (1351-Just Color! Pigment White), cut:

*(9) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for borders 3 and 5.

Fabric E (1351-Just Color! Royal), cut:

*(6) 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 7.

*(4) 1-3/4" x WOF strips for border 1.

*(6) 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

Fabric F (7287-33 Static Border Stripe 24" - Cream), fussy-cut:

*(6) 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 6.

Quilt Top Assembly

Follow the quilt diagram and photograph while assembling the quilt top.

1. For border 1, trim two 1-3/4" Fabric E strips to 43" and sew one strip to each side of the Fabric A panel. Press the seams toward the border. Trim two more 1-3/4" Fabric E strips to 25-1/2" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the panel. Press as before.
2. For border 2, sew the four 1-1/2" Fabric B strips together end to end using diagonal seams. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Cut two border strips that length and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams toward the borders.
3. Repeat Step 2 with four 1-1/2" Fabric D strips to make and add border 3.
4. Repeat Step 2 with the four 2-1/2" Fabric C strips to make and add border 4.
5. Repeat Step 2 with five 1-1/2" Fabric D strips to make and add border 5.
6. For border 6, measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center. Working with the first 4-1/2" Fabric F strip, trim the ends about 1" after the small square (*figure 1*). Trim two segments from another Fabric F strip and, using straight seams, add one segment to each end of the first strip. Trim the resulting strip to match the vertical length measurement of the quilt top and sew it to one side of the

quilt center. Repeat to make another border strip and sew it to the other side. Press the seams toward the borders. Measure the width of the quilt top through the center. Trim two more Fabric F strips that length (centering the strip motif) and sew one to the top and one to the bottom. Press the seams as before.




7. Repeat Step 2 with the six 1-1/2" Fabric E strips to make and add border 7.

Layering, Quilting, and Finishing

8. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.

Binding

9. Join the six 2-1/2" Fabric E binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. Fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt top, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
