## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
WOF = Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric
Fabric A (7008-99 Tossed Cats - Black), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric B (7010-99 Kitten with Gift Sack - Black), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric C (7012-99 Ginger Cat Cookie - Black), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric D (7009-01 Kitten in a Cup - White), cut:

- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (6) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2 "$ strips.

Fabric E (1351-Pigment White Just Color! - Pigment White), cut:

- (6) $21 / 21$ x X WOF strips.

Fabric F (1351-Red Delicious Just Color! - Red Delicious), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips.
- (7) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 481 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.

Fabric G (7011-88 Starlight Mint - Red), cut:

- (3) $21 / 21$ x X WOF strips.

Fabric H (7016-99 Border Stripe - Black), cut:

- (3) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2$ " LOF strips.

Fabric I (1351-Pewter Just Color! - Pewter), cut:

- (7) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2$ " strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 651 / 2$ " strips.
- (3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 501 / 2$ " strips.

Fabric J (7015-01 Tossed Characters - White), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 671 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $60 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.

Fabric K (1351-Onyx Just Color! - Onyx), cut:

- (7) $2 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} x$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric L (7013-88 Packed Cats - Red), cut:

- (2) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) $41 / 2$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " strips.

Backing (7007-01 Mice with Red Boots - White), cut:

- (2) 85 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 68 " x 85 " to make the back.

Sew using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Block Assembly

## Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric E strip to the left side of (1)
$21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric F strip lengthwise to make (1) Stripe Set 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 1's total.
2. Cut the (3) Strip Set 1's into (48) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).
3. Sew $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF Fabric G strip lengthwise to make (1) Stripe Set 2 (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (3) Strip Set 2's total.
4. Cut the (3) Strip Set 2's into (48) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Unit 2 strips (Fig. 4).

7. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each end (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2$ " Fabric D strip to make the bottom row (Fig. 6).
8. Sew together the (2) rows from Steps 6-7 lengthwise to make (1) $8 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2}$ " Block One rectangle (Fig. 6).
9. Repeat Steps 6-8 to make a second Block One rectangle.

10. Repeat Steps 6-8 and refer to Figures 7-13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Two rectangles, (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Five rectangle, (2) Block Six rectangles, (2) Block Seven rectangles and (1) Block Eight rectangle.

11. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 48 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 48 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip lengthwise. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $48 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) $11 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 481 / 2 "$ Block Nine strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (3) Block Nine strips total.

12. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 15).
13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figure 15 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two, Row Three and Row Four.
14. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 12-13 in numerical order and (3) Block Nine strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the $48 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $651 / 2$ " Center Block (Fig. 15).

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

15. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 65 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 501 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 671 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 601 / 2$ " Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

17. Press the quilt top and 68 " x 85 " backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

18. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric K binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
19. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
