



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Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (7605-426 Garden Party Blocks - Cream/Multi):

• Fussy cut (6) 13 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" rectangles, each centered on a block.

Fabric B (1351-Slate Just Color! – Slate), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2" x 16 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 4 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.

Fabric C (7603-42 Lady Bugs – Cream/Dark Pink), cut:

- (4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 19 1/2" strips.

Fabric D (7602-22 Butterflies – Dark Pink), cut:

- (2) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.
- (8) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric E (7597-04 Grid – Cream), cut:

- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.
- (4) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric F (7594-22 Strawberries – Dark Pink), cut:

• (3) 4 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 4" x 4 ½" rectangles.

Fabric G (7596-77 Sprigs – Navy), cut:

• (3) 4 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 4" x 4 ½" rectangles.

Fabric H (7592-66 Daisies - Sage), cut:

• (2) 4 ¹/₂ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 4 ¹/₂" x 5 ¹/₂" rectangles.

Fabric I (7598-26 Humming Berries – Cream/Multi), cut:

• (3) 4 " x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 4" x 4 ¹/₂" rectangles.

Fabric J (7600-62 Playing Cards – Cream/ Dark Pink), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 66 ¹/₂" LOF strips.

• From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 63 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.

Fabric K (7599-77 Roses – Navy), cut:

- (4) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 70 ½" strips.
- (4) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 72 1/2" strips.

Backing (7604-427 Grandma's Garden Cheater – Cream/Multi), cut:

• (2) 87" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 80" x 87" to make the back.

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Sewing


Sew using a ¹/₄" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 13 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 16 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 15 ½" x 12 ½"**. Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 rectangles total.

2. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) 19 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 16 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One rectangles total.




3. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D strip to make (1) Unit 2 rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 rectangles total.

4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 rectangle to make (1) Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 rectangles total.

5. Sew (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric I strip to the top of (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 5).

6. Sew (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip to the top of (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric I strip. Sew the newly sewn strip to the right side of the Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 5).

7. Sew together (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip, (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) 4 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric I strip and (1) 4" x 4 ½" Fabric F strip in that order from left to right. Sew the newly sewn strip to the top of the Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 5).



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10. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to each side of (1) Block Two rectangle to make Row One (Fig. 6). Repeat to make Row Three.

11. Sew (1) Block Two rectangle to each side of (1) Block One rectangle to make Row Two (Fig. 6). Repeat to make Row Four.

12. Sew together the (4) Pieced Rows, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ x 64 $\frac{1}{2}$ Center Block (Fig. 6).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 66 $\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 5" x 70 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5" x 72 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


Layering, Quilting and Finishing

16. Press the quilt top and 80" x 87" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

17. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric D binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

18. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
