

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# **Cutting**

## **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

# Fabric A (6993G-93 24 Inch Block Repeat Glow in the Dark - Multi):

• Fussy cut (8) 10" x 10 1/2" rectangles, each centered on a block.

#### Fabric B (1351-Grass Just Color! - Grass), cut:

- (4) 2 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2 ¼" x 10 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2" x 13 ½" strips.

### Fabric C (6994G-99 Monotone Glow in the Dark Trees - Black), cut:

- (9) 1 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1 ¾" x 57 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 72 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (8) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

## Fabric D (1351-Pigment White Just Color! - Pigment White), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (64) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

# Fabric E (6995G-33 Black Cats Glow in the Dark - Orange), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

#### Fabric F (7001G-99 Skeleton Glow in the Dark – Black), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

# Fabric G (7002G-99 Skulls Glow in the Dark - Black), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

#### Fabric H (6997G-33 Ghosts Glow in the Dark - Orange), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

#### Fabric I (6998G-66 Bats Glow in the Dark - Green), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

#### Fabric J (6996G-99 Spiderweb Glow in the Dark - Black), cut:

• (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

#### Fabric K (6994G-66 Monotone Glow in the Dark Trees - Green), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (64) 2 ½" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric L (7003G-39 Novelty Stripe Glow in the Dark - Multi), cut:

• (3) 6" x 57 ½" LOF strips.

#### Fabric M (1351-Orange Just Color! - Orange), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 74 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 62 ½" strips.

#### Fabric N (7000G-93 Motifs in Circles Glow in the Dark - Black), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 77 ½" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 ½" x 72 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### Backing (6999G-33 Spiders Glow in the Dark - Orange), cut:

• (2) 95" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 80" x 95" back.




Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.


# **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Sew (1) 2 ¼" x 10 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10" x 10 ½" Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12** ½" x 12 ½". Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.



- 2. Place (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 3).
- 3. Place another  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (32) Unit 1 strips total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (32) Unit 2 strips.



6. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise along the Fabric K sides to make (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.



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- 7. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric E square, (1) Unit 3 square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric F square to make the top row (Fig. 8).
- 8. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric I square to make the middle row (Fig. 8).
- 9. Sew together (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square, (1) Unit 3 square and (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 8).
- 10. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 7-9 lengthwise to make (1)  $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 8).
- 11. Repeat Steps 7-10 to make (8) Block Two squares total.





12. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip lengthwise to make (1) 3  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) Block Three strips total.



13. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6" x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L strip lengthwise to make (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Four strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (3) Block Four strips total.



- 14. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 11). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 15. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left, to right to make Row Two (Fig. 11). Repeat to make Row Three.
- 16. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 14-15 in numerical order, and (3) Block Four strips, lengthwise and alternating them from the top to the bottom, to make the 57  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 11).



### **Quilt Top Assembly**

# (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)


- 17. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 59  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew (1) 2" x 74  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 62  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 19. Sew (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 77  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 72  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

# Layering, Quilting and Finishing

20. Press the quilt top and 90" x 96" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

### **Binding**

- 21. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric K binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 22. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
