- 3923-33 5 yards

Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3920-39 Large Stripe – Brown), cut:

- (1) 38 ½" x 40 ½" rectangle.

Fabric B (Lake-00 Peppered Cottons – Lake), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric C (3926-90 Marshmallows on Sticks – Gray), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (52) Template 2 triangles.

Fabric D (3924-33 Campsite Icons – Beige), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (52) Template 2 triangles.

Fabric E (Tobacco-85 Peppered Cottons – Tobacco), cut:

- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 54 ½" strips.
- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

Fabric F (Coffee Bean-50 Peppered Cottons – Coffee Bean), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (82) Template 4 triangles.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (82) Template 6 triangles.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (104) Template 1 triangles.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (104) Template 3 triangles.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 78 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 71 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 69 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric G (3924-39 Campsite Icons – Brown), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 69 ½" strips.

Fabric H (3925-30 Utility Knife – Beige), cut:

- (7) 5 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (78) Template 5 triangles.
- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) Template 4 triangles and (4) Template 6 triangles.

Fabric I (3927-38 Blanket Stripe – Rust), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 69 ½" strips.

Backing (3923-33 Map – Beige), cut:

- (2) 88" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 79" x 88" for the back.

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

- Place (1) Fabric F-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric D-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 1). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.
- Place (1) Fabric F-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric D-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 2). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim to measure 3 ½" square to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 3).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (52) Unit 1 blocks total.
- Repeat Steps 1-2 using (52) Fabric F-Template 1 triangles, (52) Fabric C-Template 2 triangles and (52) Fabric F-Template 3 triangles to make (52) 3 ½" Unit 2 blocks (Fig. 4).
- Repeat Steps 1-2 using (78) Fabric F-Template 4 triangles, (78) Fabric H-Template 5 triangles and (78) Fabric F-Template 6 triangles to make (78) 3 ½" x 5 ½" Unit 3 blocks (Fig. 5).

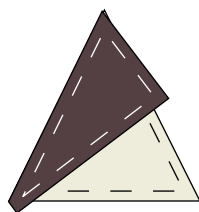

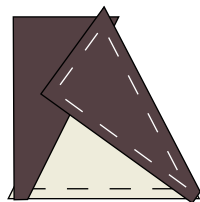

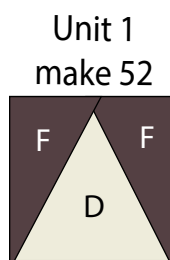

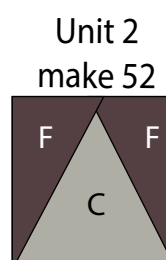

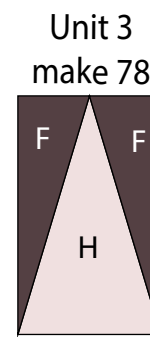

- Place (1) Fabric F-Template 6 triangle on top of (1) Fabric H-Template 6 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides. Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim to measure 2" x 5 ½" to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 blocks total.

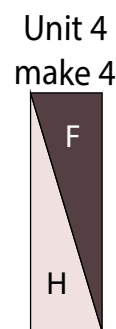

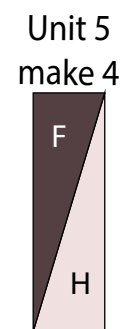

- Place (1) Fabric F-Template 4 triangle on top of (1) Fabric H-Template 4 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides. Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim to measure 2" x 5 ½" to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Unit 5 blocks total.

- Sew (1) Unit 1 block and (1) Unit 2 block together end to end to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (52) Unit 6 strips total.

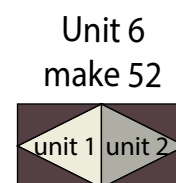

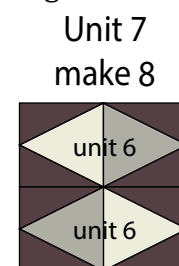

- Sew (2) Unit 6 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (8) Unit 7 blocks total.

10. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 7 block, (1) 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip, (2) Unit 7 blocks, (1) 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 7 block and (1) 4 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric E strip together lengthwise and in that order to make (1) Pieced Border 1 (Fig. 10). Repeat to make a second Pieced Border 1.

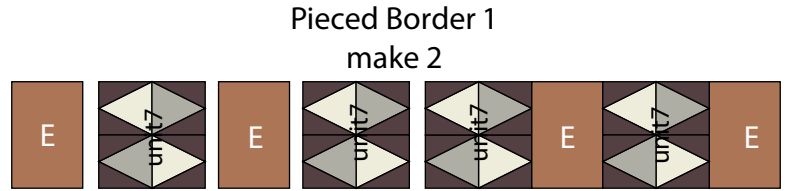

11. Sew (18) Unit 6 strips together lengthwise to make (1) Pieced Border 2 (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Pieced Border 2.

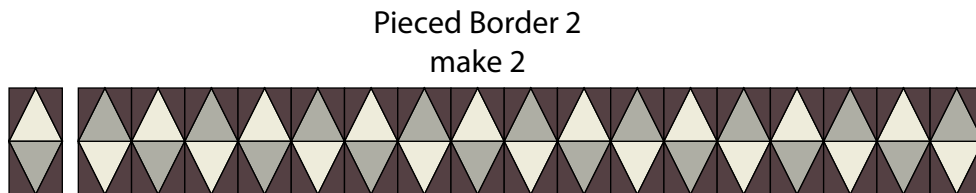

12. Sew (17) Unit 3 blocks together lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 4 block to the left end of the new strip and (1) Unit 5 block to the right end to make (1) Pieced Border 3 (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Pieced Border 3.

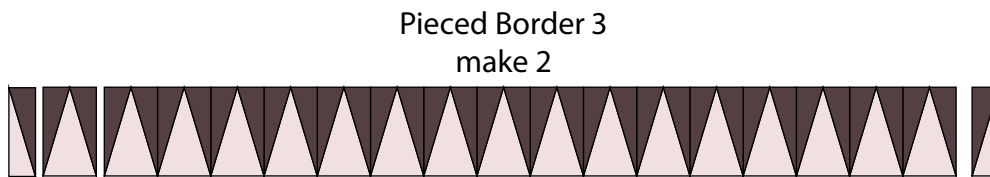

13. Sew (22) Unit 3 blocks together lengthwise. Sew (1) Unit 4 block to the left end of the new strip and (1) Unit 5 block to the right end to make (1) Pieced Border 4 (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a second Pieced Border 4.

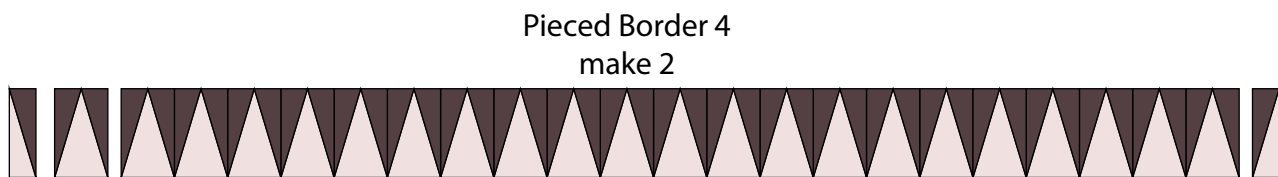

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 38 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) Pieced Border 1 to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block. Sew (1) Pieced Border 2 to each side of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 4" x 54 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) Pieced Border 3 to each side of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Sew (1) Pieced Border 4 to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
21. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 69 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
22. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 78 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 71 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

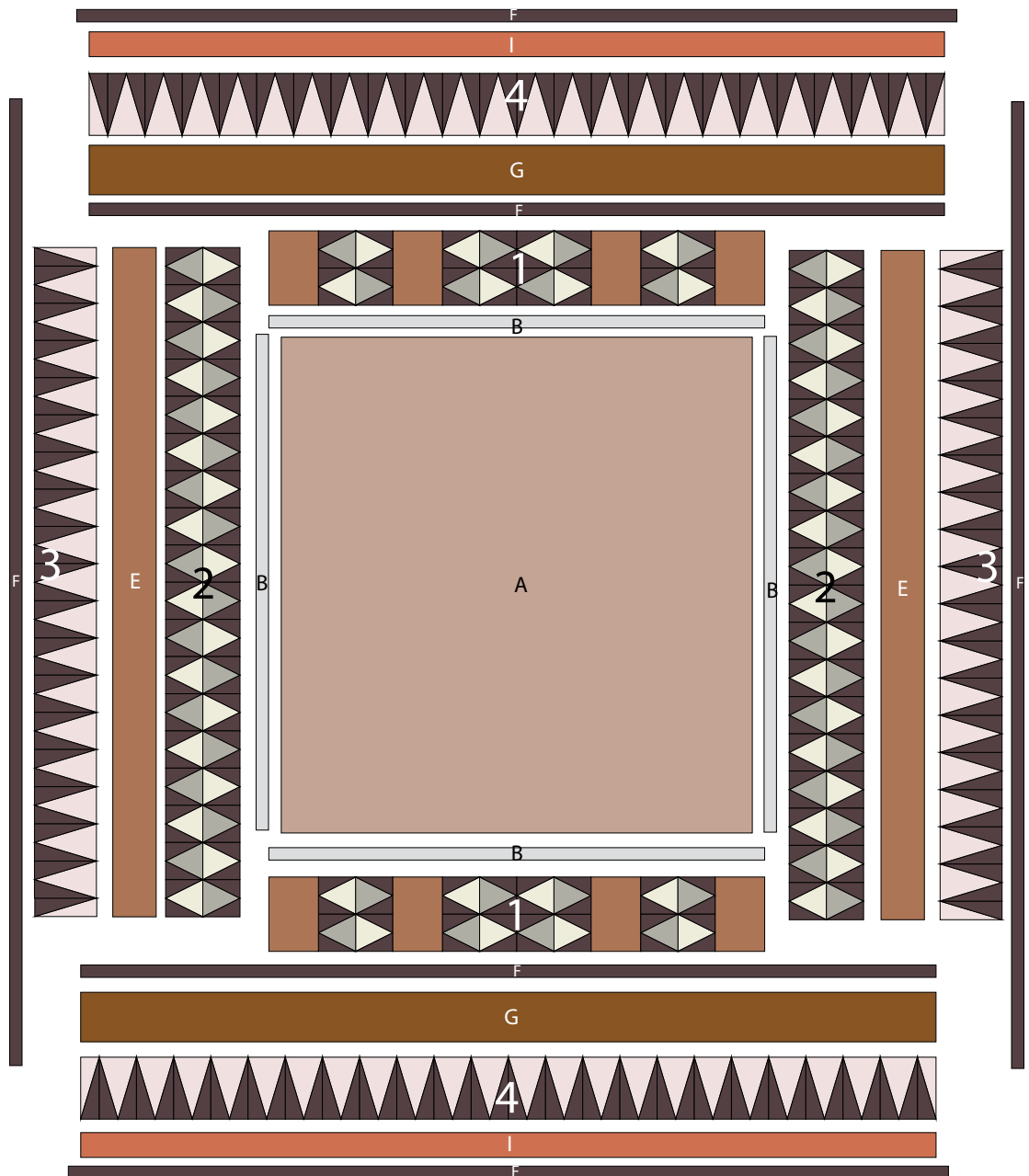
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

23. Press the quilt top and 79" x 88" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

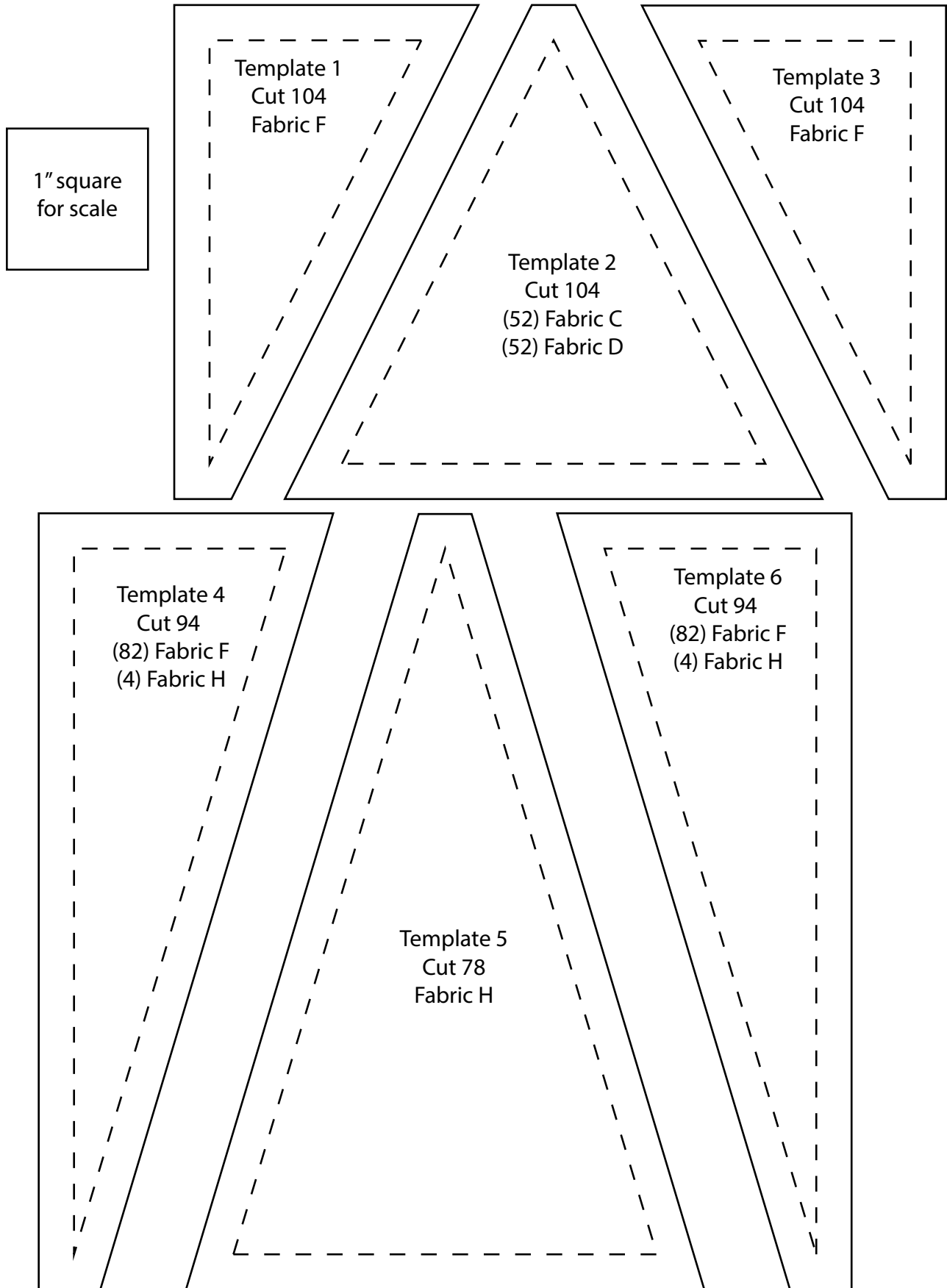
Binding

24. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric F binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

25. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
