



Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (5422P-89 Poppy Panel – Multi):

- Fussy cut (1) 21" x 30 ½" strip, centered on the panel.

Fabric B (5415-4 Bees on Honeycomb – Multi/White), cut:

- (2) 3" x 30 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 66 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 59 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 39 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric C (5421-11 Linear Poppy Allover – Blue), cut:

- (3) 4 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (19) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (76) 4 ¼" triangles.

Fabric D (5418-88 Damask Tonal – Red), cut:

- (3) 4 ¼" x WOF strips, sub-cut (19) 4 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (76) 4 ¼" triangles.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 10 ¼" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 14 ¼" strips.

Fabric E (5415-99 Bees on Honeycomb – Black), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ½" squares.

Fabric F (Lagoon-78 Peppered Cottons – Lagoon), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x 32 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric G (5420-89 Poppy Novelty Stripe – Multi), cut:

- (2) 9 ¼" x 32 ½" LOF strips.

Fabric H (5417-89 Block Panel – Multi):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 ¼" squares, each centered on a poppy block.

Fabric I (5416-8 Poppies and Butterflies – Multi/White):

- Fussy cut (4) 9 ¼" x 15 ½" strips centered so words will run horizontally on quilt.

Fabric J (1351-Iron Just Color! – Iron), cut:

- (4) 1 ⅛" x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) 1 ⅛" x 15 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ⅛" x 32 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 69 ½" strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 60 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric K (5419-8 Small Packed Poppy Allover – Red/White), cut:

- (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ½" x 70 ½" strips.
- (4) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ½" x 72 ½" strips.

Backing (5414-11 Butterflies Tossed – Blue), cut:

- (2) 90" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 80" x 90" to make the back.


Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.


Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.


1. Sew (1) $3'' \times 30\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $21'' \times 30\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric A panel. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 26''$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. **Trim the block to measure $24\frac{1}{2}'' \times 33\frac{1}{2}''$** to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).




2. Sew together (1) $4\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric D triangle and (1) $4\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric C triangle along short sides to make (1) DC triangle. Sew together (1) $4\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric C triangle and (1) $4\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric D triangle along short sides to make (1) CD triangle. Sew the DC and CD triangles together along the long sides to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). The square should measure $3\frac{1}{2}''$. Repeat to make (38) Unit 1 squares total.




3. Sew together (11) Unit 1 squares to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.





4. Sew together (8) Unit 1 squares. Sew (1) $3\frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric E square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 4). Repeat to make the Inner Bottom Border.



5. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 10\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $10\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric H square. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}'' \times 14\frac{1}{4}''$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric H square. **Trim the block to measure $12\frac{1}{2}''$ square** to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total; (3) using the Fabric H Teal squares and (3) using the Fabric H White squares.






6. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x 15 1/2" Fabric J strip to each side of (1) 9 1/4" x 15 1/2" Fabric I strips lengthwise. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 strips total.



8. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 White square to make the Outer Left Side Border (Fig. 8).

9. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 2 Teal square to make the Outer Right Border (Fig. 9).

10. Sew (1) Unit 2 Teal square to the left end of (1) Unit 4 strip. Sew (1) Unit 2 White square to the right end of the Unit 4 strip to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 10). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 39 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 32 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew the Outer Left Side Border and Outer Right Side border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) 2" x 66 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 59 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
15. Sew (1) 1" x 69 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 60 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
16. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 70 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 72 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


Layering, Quilting and Finishing

17. Press the quilt top and 80" x 90" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

18. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric J binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

19. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
