Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (5865P-126 36" Book Panel – Multi):

- Fussy cut (12) 8 ½" squares, each centered on a panel.

Fabric B (1351-Pewter Just Color! – Pewter), cut:

- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 2" x 8 ½" strips.
- (8) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) 2" x 11 ½" strips.

Fabric C (5863-12 Sun Shaped Dots – Multi), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (34) 2 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

Fabric D (5857-11 Zebra Allover – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

Fabric E (5856-77 Alligator Allover – Blue), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 6 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

Fabric F (5860-22 Elephant Allover – Pink), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (5) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

Fabric G (5861-66 Giraffe Allover – Lime), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

Fabric H (5855-90 Cheetah Allover – Gray), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 3 ½" squares.

Fabric I (5862-12 Dash Stripe – Multi), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 49 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric J (1351-Robin's Egg Just Color! – Robins Egg), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 41 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric K (5854-12 Animal Faces – Multi), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 49 ½" strips.

Fabric L (Atomic Tangerine-69 Peppered Cottons – Atomic Tangerine), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing (5859-9 Outline Animals – Cream), cut:

- (2) 57" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 57" x 70" to make the back.

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½"**. Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total.

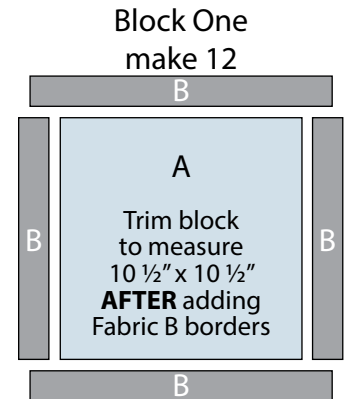

2. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric D strip to make (1) Block Two strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block Two strips total.

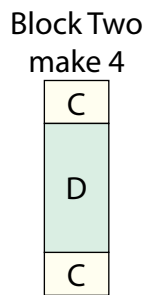

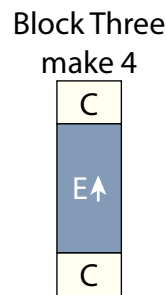

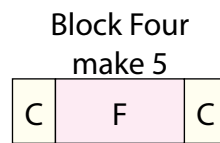

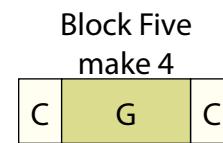

4. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 6).

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.

6. Sew together (1) Block Four strip, (1) 3 ½" Fabric H square, (1) Block Five strip, (1) 3 ½" Fabric H square and (1) Block Four strip, end to end and in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Four and Row Six.

8. Sew together the (7) Rows, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Fig. 6).

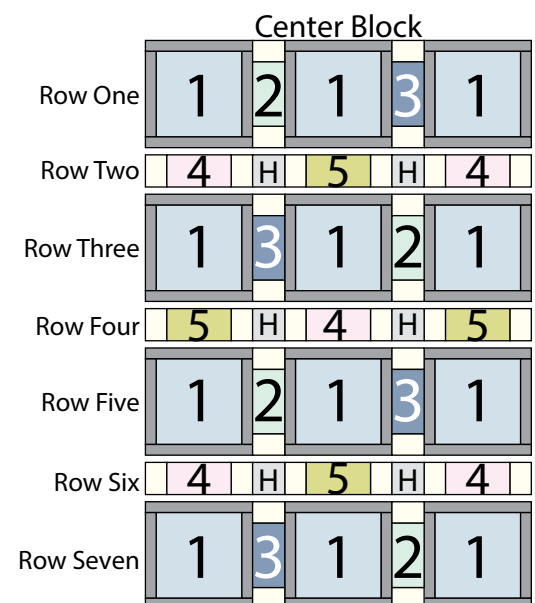

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

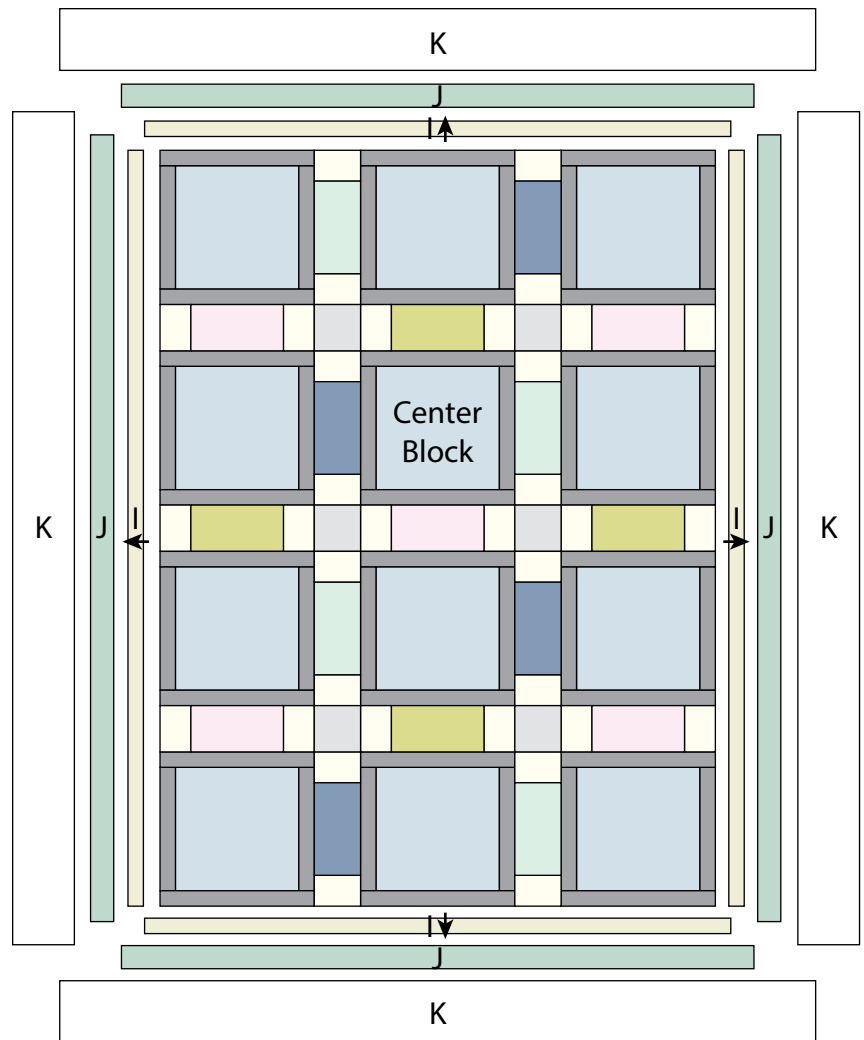
9. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" x Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 41 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

12. Press the quilt top and 57" x 70" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

13. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric L binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
