## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric
Fabric A (6853-86 Abstract Floral - Multi), cut:

- (2) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end and cut (1) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $531 / 2$ " strip.

Fabric B (6854-28 Linear Circles - Dark Pink), cut:

- (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) $211 / 2 "$ x $6 \frac{112 "}{2}$ strips.

Fabric C (6855-64 Small Wavy Grid - Lime Green), cut:

- (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (19) $21 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric D (6857-93 Abstract Geometric - Black/Off-White), cut:

- (1) $9 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 16 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " rectangle.

Fabric E (6859-39 Newsprint - Off-White), cut:

- (7) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (37) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric F (6860-98 Big Dot Yo Yo's - Black/Multi), cut:

- (1) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strip.
- (1) $16 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $41 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strip.
- (1) $16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " $201 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strip.

Fabric G (6861-28 Paint Dabs - Pink), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 "$ x $81 / 22^{\prime \prime}$ WOF strip.

Fabric H (6861-67 Paint Dabs - Green), cut:

- (1) $91 / 2$ " $\times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ rectangle.

Fabric I (6862-78 Wavy Chevron - Blue/Multi), cut:

- (1) $30 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) $30 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x 10 " strip, (1) $221 / 2 "$ x 11 " strip, and (1) $14 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ "strip.

Fabric J (Deep Space-98 Peppered Cottons - Deep Space), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Backing (6858-93 Script - Black/Off-White), cut:

- (2) 80 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 60 " x 80 " to make the back.

Sew using a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew together (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$

Fabric E strip, (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " x $6 \frac{1}{2}$ "
Fabric E strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip and (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $61 / 2$ "
Fabric E strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " $91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).
2. Sew together (1) $81 / 2 " \times 91 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip, (1) Unit 1 rectangle and (1) $91 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 16 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip in that order from left to right. Sew (1) $10^{\prime \prime} \times 301 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 19" x $301 / 2$ " Block One strip (Fig. 2).

3. Refer to Figure 3 and sew together (7) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric C strips, (13) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strips and (7) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strips lengthwise to make (1) Unit 2 strip. Repeat to make a second Unit 2 strip.
4. Sews (1) $81 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 411 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4).

5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 4 rectangle (Fig. 5).
6. Sew (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to the left side of the Unit 4 rectangle. Sew (1) $81 / 2$ " $\times 141 / 2$ " Fabric I strip to the top of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 6).

7. Sew the Unit 3 strip to the top of the Unit 5 strip. Sew (1) $16 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 531 / 2 "$ Fabric A strip to the right side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) $301 / 2 " \times 531 / 2 "$ Block Two strip (Fig. 7).

8. Sew (1) $16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 8).

9. Sew together (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strips, (6) $1 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 61 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E strips and (3) $21 / 2 " \times 6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strips lengthwise. Sew (1) $16 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 20 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric F strip to the right side of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 7 rectangle.

10. Sew the Unit 6 strip to the top of (1) $11^{\prime \prime} \times 221 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip. Sew the Unit 7 rectangle to the bottom of the Fabric I strip to make (1) $22 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 72^{\prime \prime}$ Block Three strip (Fig. 10 below).

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
11. Sew the Block One strip to the top of the Block Two strip. Sew the Block Three strip to the right side of the newly sewn block lengthwise to make the quilt top.

## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

12. Press the quilt top and $60^{\prime \prime} \times 80^{\prime \prime}$ backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

13. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric J binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

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
