## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.
WOF = Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric
Fabric A (6893-77 Toys Allover - Navy), cut:

- (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip, sub-cut (5) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric B (6894-01 Scenic - White), cut:

- (3) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips, sub-cut (20) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric C (6891-39 Tossed Allover Bones - Ecru), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 \prime$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric D (1351-Sea Glass Just Color! Sea Glass), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (40) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ x $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
- (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) $21 / 2$ " x $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 2 " x $361 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 3911 / 2$ " WOF strips.

Fabric E (6892-88 Beach Ball Dot - Red), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (36) $21 / 2 "$ squares.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ x $391 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " WOF strips.
- (5) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric F (6890-77 Argyle - Navy), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $21 / 2$ " squares.

Fabric G (6886-35 Packed Puppies - Tan), cut:

- (1) $4 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.

Fabric H (6889-44 Pup in Pot - Cream), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric I (6888-77 Pups Allover - Navy), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 \prime$ " $41 \frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $491 / 2$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.

Backing (6887-11 Puppy in Bathtub - Light Blue), cut:

- (2) 57 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 57 " x 57" to make the back.

Sew using a $1 \nmid 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Block Assembly

## Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to the left side of (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric $D$ square to make the top row. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D square to the left side of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (20) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric B square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $41 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B square to each side of (1) $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2$ " Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

3. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ " Fabric E square to each side of (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 4 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric G square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) Unit 2 squares total.
4. Sew together (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric F square, (1) $21 / 22^{\prime \prime} \times 8 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip and (1) $21 / 2$ "

Fabric H square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 4).
5. Sew (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 81 / 2$ " Fabric $D$ strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row (Fig. 4).
6. Sew together (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric H square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 81 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric $D$ strip and (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric F square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 4).
7. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps $4-6$ lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2$ " Block Two square (Fig. 4).
8. Repeat Steps 4-7 to make (4) Block Two squares total.

9. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 5). Repeat to make Row Three.
10. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 5).
11. Sew together the (3) Rows from Steps 9-10, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $36 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 361 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Center Block (Fig. 5).

## Quilt Top Assembly

## (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (1) 2" x $36 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $391 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 391 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 411 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 41 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

## Layering, Quilting and Finishing

15. Press the quilt top and 57 " $\times 57$ " backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## Binding

16. Cut the ends of the (5) Fabric E binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
17. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
