## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. WOF $=$ Width of Fabric $\bullet$ LOF $=$ Length of Fabric

Fabric A (4854-77 Block Repeat - Navy/Multi):

- Fussy cut (6) 9 3/4" squares each centered on a block.

Fabric B (4857-77 Anchors - Navy), cut:

- (1) $93 / 4^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 93 / 4 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (12) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 4$ " strips.

Fabric C (4858-11 Fish Allover - Blue), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (6) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric D (4855-1 Coral on White - White/Multi), cut:

- (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strip, sub-cut (4) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ squares.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) $3 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric E (4859-77 Tonal Damask - Navy), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (48) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric F (4861-11 Shells Allover - Blue), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 \prime$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (24) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric G (4859-60 Tonal Damask - Aqua), cut:

- (11) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips, sub-cut (31) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.
- (7) $21 / 2$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric H (4862-17 Stripe - Navy/Red), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips, sub-cut (20) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

Fabric I (4856-17 Beach Words on Shiplap - Multi), cut:

- (2) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ LOF strips.
- (2) $6 \frac{1}{1} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 441 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

Backing (4861-11 Shells Allover - Blue), cut:

- (2) 64 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 64 " x 78 " to make the back.


## Sewing

Sew using a $1 \nmid 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

## Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 93 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $93 / 4 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 133 / 4$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2$ " square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.
2. Place (1) $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2$ " $\times 6 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3).

3. Place another $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric E square on the right side of the $31 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 6 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.

Block Two
5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.
6. Sew (4) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (3) $21 / 2$ " x $121 / 2$ " Fabric G strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (5) Sashing Strips total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
7. Sew together (1) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square and (1) $21 / 2 \prime \times 121 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip, in that order, to make Row One. Repeat To make Row Three.
8. Sew together (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) $21 / 2{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 121 / 2$ " Fabric G strip, (1) Block One square, (1) $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $12 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip, (1) Block Two square and (1) $21 / 2 \prime \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, in that order, to make Row Two. Repeat To make Row Four.
9. Sew together the (5) Sashing Strips and (4) pieced Rows, in numerical order and alternating them, to make the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} 2^{\prime \prime} \times 581 / 2$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)


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
