





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# **Cutting**

### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### Fabric A (4336-22 9" x 9" Blocks - Pink), fussy cut:

• (8) 9 ½" squares each centered on a block.

#### Fabric B (1351-Orchid Just Color! - Orchid), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2" x 9 ½" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2" x 12 ½" strips.

#### Fabric C (4342-42 Cat Collars Stripe - Cream), cut:

- (11) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric D (1351-Light Teal Just Color! - Light Teal), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

#### Fabric E (1351-Carnation Just Color! - Carnation), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

#### Fabric F (1351-Sea Glass Just Color! - Sea Glass), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

#### Fabric G (4337-22 Cats Medley - Pink), cut:

• (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 7 ½" squares.

#### Fabric H (4339-22 Tossed Frames - Pink). cut:

• (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 7 ½" squares.

#### Fabric I (4340-11 Standing Kitties - Light Aqua), cut:

• (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 7 ½" squares.

#### Fabric J (4338-22 Patchwork - Pink), cut:

• (1) 7 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 7 ½" squares.

#### Fabric K (1351-Pigment White – Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:

- (2) 7 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (2) 11 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.

#### Backing (4339-22 Tossed Frames - Pink), cut:

• (2) 71" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 71" x 71" to make the back.


# Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.


#### **Block Assembly**

- 1. Sew (1) 2" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip to each size of (1) 9 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 11 ½" x 11 1/2" to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 squares total.


  Block One
- 2. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric C strip to make (1) Block One top row. Repeat to make (1) bottom row. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (8) Block One squares total.



- 3. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Unit 2 top row. Repeat to make (1) bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (2) Unit 2 squares total.
- 4. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square to each end of (1) 2 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric K strip to make (1) Unit 3 top row. Repeat to make (1) bottom row. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) 7 ½" Fabric H square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (2) Unit 3 squares total.
- 5. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Unit 4 top row. Repeat to make (1) bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (2) Unit 4 squares total.
- 6. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Unit 5 top row. Repeat to make (1) bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1)  $7\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (2) Unit 5 squares total.



- 7. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Block Two top row. Repeat to make bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (2) Block Two squares total.
- 8. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Block Three top row. Repeat to make bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (2) Block Three squares total.
- 9. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Block Four top row. Repeat to make bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block Four square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (2) Block Four squares total.
- 10. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to make (1) Block Five top row. Repeat to make bottom row. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $11\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row. Sew the rows together to make (1) Block Five square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (2) Block Five squares total.



### **Quilt Top Assembly**

### (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 11. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three square, in that order to make Row One.
- 12. Sew together (1) Block Four square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five square and (1) Block One square, in that order to make Row Two.
- 13. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Two square, in that order to make Row Three.
- 14. Sew together (1) Block Five square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square and (1) Block One square, in that order to make Row Four.
- 15. Sew the rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.


16. Sew (1) 2" x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Farbic K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 63  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

17. Press the quilt top and 71" x 71" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

#### **Binding**

- 18. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric C binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 19. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.



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
