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





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## Cutting

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### Fabric A (1351-Sea Glass Just Color! - Sea Glass), cut:

• (1) 8 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 8 ½" squares.

#### Fabric B (1351-Carnation Just Color! - Carnation), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" strips.
- (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric C (4341-42 Glitter Words - Cream), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 2 ½" x 18 ½" strip.

#### Fabric D (4337-22 Cats Medley - Pink), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 2 ½" x 34 ½" strip.
- (2) 8 ½" x 44 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 8 ½" x 44 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.
- (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " high x 6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " wide strips from the remaining fabric.

#### Fabric E (4340-11 Standing Kitties - Light Aqua), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips and (1) 2 ½" square.
- (1) 2 ½" x 24 ½" strip.

#### Fabric F (4339-22 Tossed Frames - Pink), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 2 ½" x 34 ½" strip and (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strip.

#### Fabric G (4342-42 Cat Collars Stripe-Cream), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x 30 ½" WOF strip
- (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" WOF strip

#### Fabric H (1351-Pigment White Just Color!-Pigment White), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 40 ½ WOF strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (10) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strip and (4) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips. (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (7) 2 ½" squares and (1) 2 ½" x 6 ½" strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 13 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

#### Backing (4338-22 Patchwork - Pink), cut:

• (2) 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 68" x 68" to make the back.

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# **Sewing**

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

#### **Block Assembly**





Fig. 1 Fig. 2

- 1. Sew together (4) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips and (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric C strips, alternating them to make (1) strip set (Fig. 1).
- 2. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the (4) heart templates onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 3. Press each template onto the wrong side of the strip set from Step 1 as shown in Figure 2. Cut out each heart on the drawn lines.

- 4. Center and press (1) heart onto (1) 8 ½ Fabric A square.
- 5. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete (1) Block One square.
- 6. To make the center block, refer to Figure 4 on Page 5 to sew the listed units into rows. Sew the rows together to make the block center.



#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

#### (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 1. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and bottom of the center block to make the quilt top.
- 2. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $40\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the quilt top.
- 3. Sew (1) 8  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the quilt top, pay attention to the fabric direction.
- 4. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1)  $8 \frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to make the quilt top. Repeat to make the bottom border. Sew the borders to the quilt top.

#### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

5. Press the quilt top and 68" x 68" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

#### **Binding**

- 6. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 7. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.




