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# Cutting

# **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Note: Red Version fabrics listed second where different.

- Fabric A (3616-99 Vine Floral Black)
  - (3616-88 Vine Floral Red), cut:

• (12) rings using the template provided.

Fabric B (3615-99 Large Floral – Black)

(3615-88 Large Floral – Red), cut:

• (12) rings using the template provided.

## Fabric C (3618-99 Small Rectangles Geo – Black)

(3618-88 Small Rectangles Geo - Red), cut:

• (12) rings using the template provided.

## Fabric D (3620-99 Dotty Stripe – Black)

(3620-88 Dotty Stripe – Red), cut:

• (12) rings using the template provided.

## Fabric E (3619-99 Tone on Tone – Black)

- (3619-88 Tone on Tone Red), cut:
- (15) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (15) 2" x 21 1/2" strips and (15) 2" x 14 3/4" strips from each 2" strip.
- (1) 2" x 14 ¾" strip.
- (8) 2 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips for the binding.

## Fabric F (3617-99 Chain – Black)

## (3617-88 Chain – Red), cut:

- (2) 4 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x 69 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" LOF strips.
- (2)  $4 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 73" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

## Fabric G (1351-Pigment White Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:

- (6) 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" x WOF strips, sub-cut (12) 14 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 2" squares.

## Backing (3615-90 Large Floral – Gray)

#### (3615-88 Large Floral – Red), cut:

• (2) 85" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 81" x 85" for the back.

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# Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

# **Block Assembly**

1. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.


2. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (1) Fabric A, (1) Fabric B, (1) Fabric C and (1) Fabric D ring onto (1) 14 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 21 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" Fabric G strip. Pay attention to the position of each ring.

4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Block One (Fig. 1).

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (4) Block Ones total.

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 but change the position of the rings to match Figure 2 to make (8) Block Twos.



7. Sew (5) 2" Fabric G squares and (4) 2" x 14 <sup>3</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" Fabric E strips together, alternating them, to make (1) sashing row (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (4) sashing rows total.



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# **Quilt Top Assembly**

### (Follow the Quilt Layout on Page 6 while assembling the quilt top.)

8. Sew (5) 2" x 21 ½" Fabric E strips, (2) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together lengthwise to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

9. Sew (5) 2" x 21 ½" Fabric E strips and (4) Block Twos together lengthwise, alternating them, to make Row Two.

10. Sew the (4) sashing rows and (3) Block rows together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

11. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 69  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 73" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

# Layering, Quilting and Finishing


12. Press the quilt top and 81" x 85" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.


## Binding

13. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric E binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

14. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
