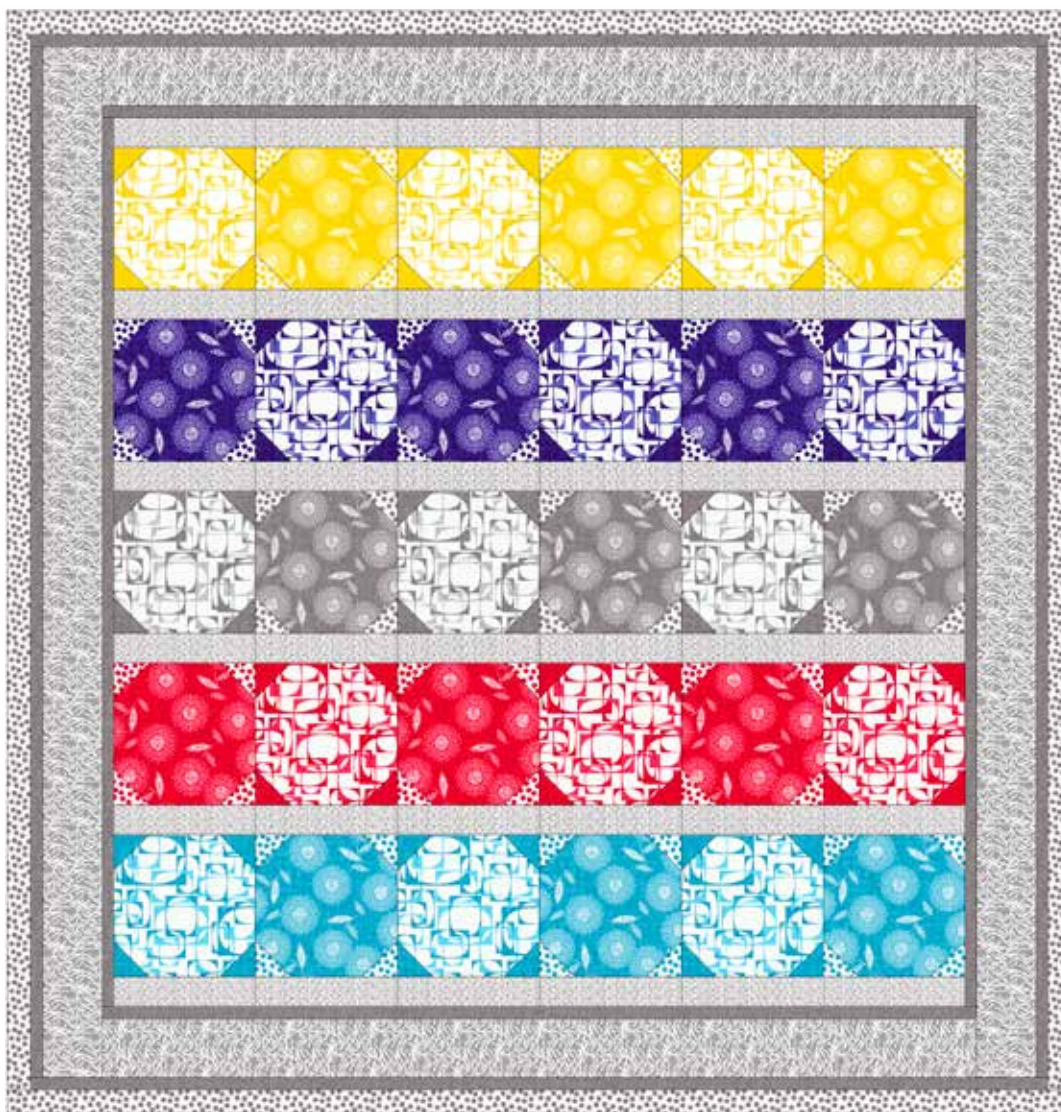

## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

**Fabric A (3077-44 Windows – Yellow), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric B (3081-44 Linen Texture – Yellow), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

**Fabric C (3078-44 Floral – Yellow), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric D (3080-44 Dot – Yellow), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

**Fabric E (3078-77 Floral – Royal), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric F (3080-77 Dot – Royal), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

**Fabric G (3081-77 Linen Texture – Royal), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

**Fabric H (3077-77 Windows – Royal), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric I (3077-99 Windows – Gray), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric J (3081-99 Linen Texture – Gray), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 87 ½" strips.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 86 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 75 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

**Fabric K (3078-99 Floral – Gray), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

**Fabric L (3080-99 Dot – Gray), cut:**

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 89 ½" strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 90 ½" strips.
- (9) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

**Fabric M (3078-88 Floral – Red), cut:**

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

## Cutting - Cont.

Fabric N (3080-88 Dot – Red), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Fabric O (3077-88 Windows – Red), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

Fabric P (3081-88 Linen Texture – Red), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Fabric Q (3077-11 Windows – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

Fabric R (3081-11 Linen Texture – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Fabric S (3078-11 Floral – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (3) 12 ½" squares.

Fabric T (3080-11 Dot – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip, sub-cut (12) 3" squares.

Fabric U (3082-99 Small Dashes – Gray), cut:

- (11) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (6) 3" x 72 ½" strips.

Fabric V (3079-99 Noodle – Gray), cut:

- (5) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 5 ½" x 87 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 5 ½" x 74 ½" strips.

Backing (3079-11 Noodle – Gray), cut:

- (3) 98" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 98" x 101" for the back.

## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Place (1) 3" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.
2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square to make (1) AB Block (Fig. 4).

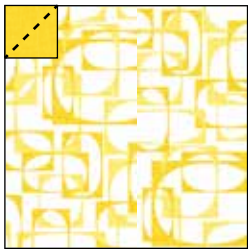

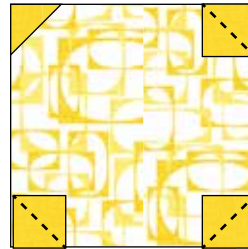

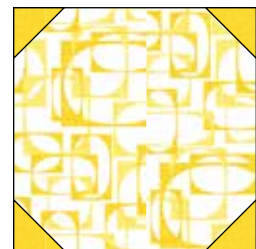

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (3) AB Blocks total.
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares and (12) 3" Fabric D squares to make (3) CD Blocks (Fig. 5).
5. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares and (12) 3" Fabric F squares to make (3) EF Blocks (Fig. 6).
6. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H squares and (12) 3" Fabric G squares to make (3) HG Blocks (Fig. 7).
7. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I squares and (12) 3" Fabric J squares to make (3) IJ Blocks (Fig. 8).

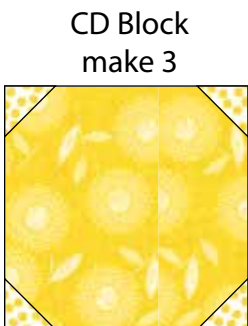

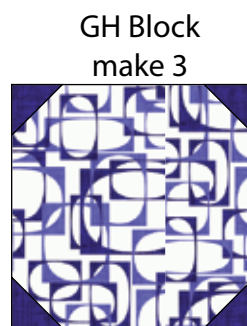

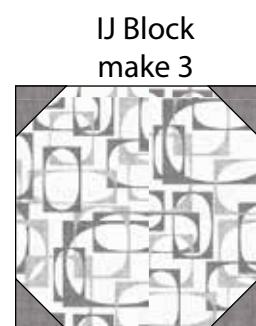

8. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12 ½" Fabric K squares and (12) 3" Fabric L squares to make (3) KL Blocks (Fig. 9).
9. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12 ½" Fabric M squares and (12) 3" Fabric N squares to make (3) MN Blocks (Fig. 10).
10. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12 ½" Fabric O squares and (12) 3" Fabric P squares to make (3) OP Blocks (Fig. 11).
11. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12 ½" Fabric Q squares and (12) 3" Fabric R squares to make (3) QR Blocks (Fig. 12).
12. Repeat Steps 1-2 using (3) 12 ½" Fabric S squares and (12) 3" Fabric T squares to make (3) ST Blocks (Fig. 13).

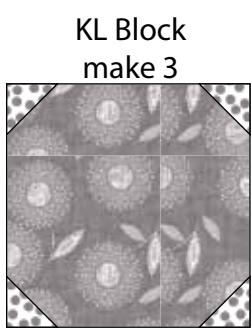

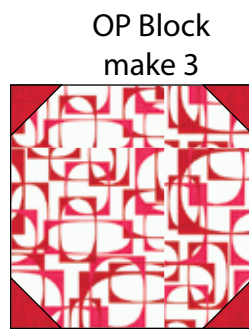

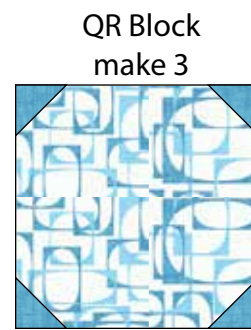

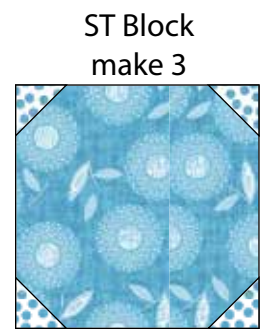

## Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow Figure 14 for Steps 13-18.)*

13. Sew (3) AB Blocks and (3) CD Blocks together, alternating them, to make Row One.
14. Sew (3) EF Blocks and (3) HG Blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Two.
15. Sew (3) IJ Blocks and (3) KL Blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Three.
16. Sew (3) MN Blocks and (3) OP Blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Four.
17. Sew (3) QR Blocks and (3) ST Blocks together, alternating them, to make Row Five.
18. Sew (6) 3" x 72 ½" Fabric U strips and the five rows, in numerical order, together, alternating them, to make the quilt top.

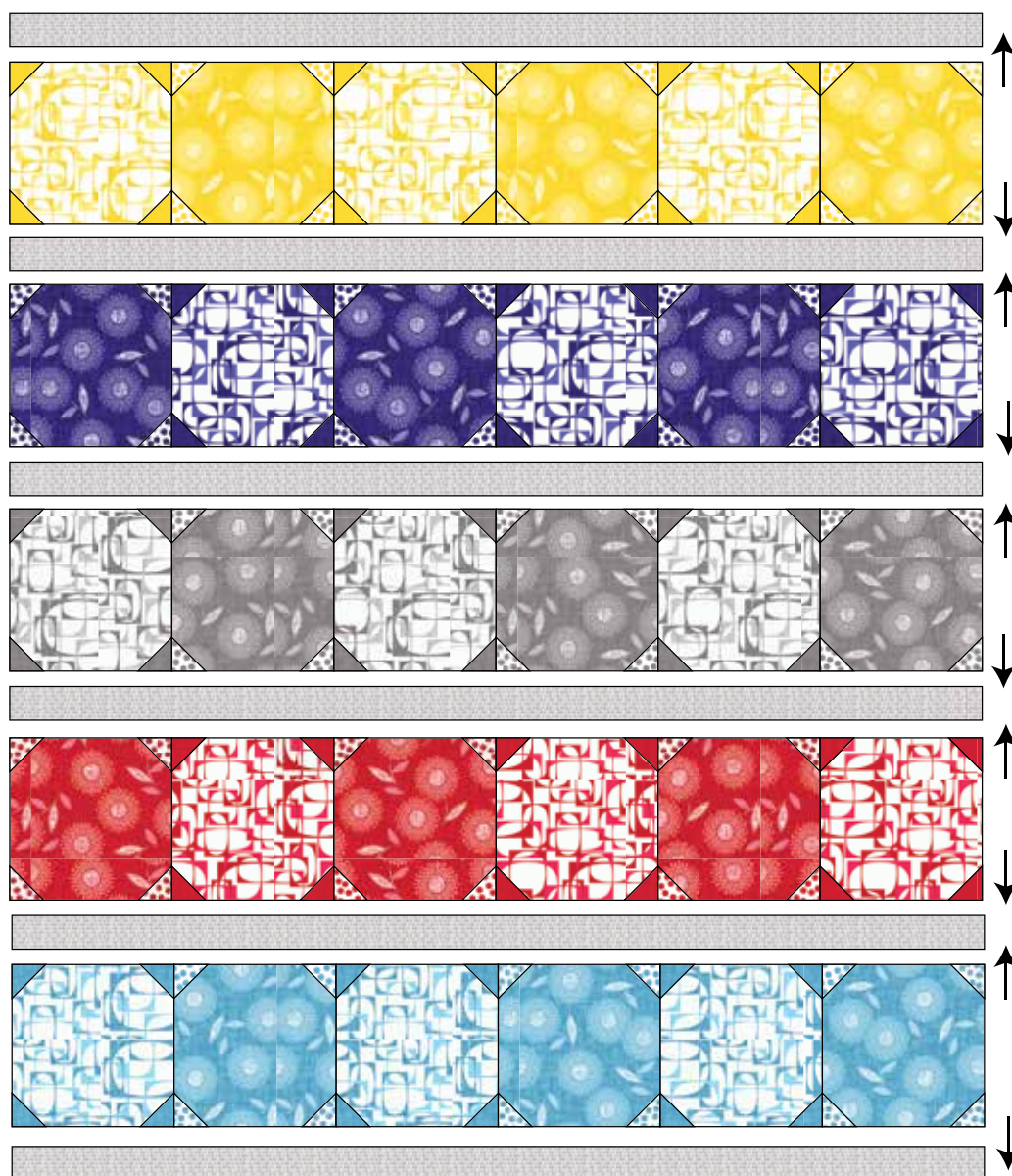
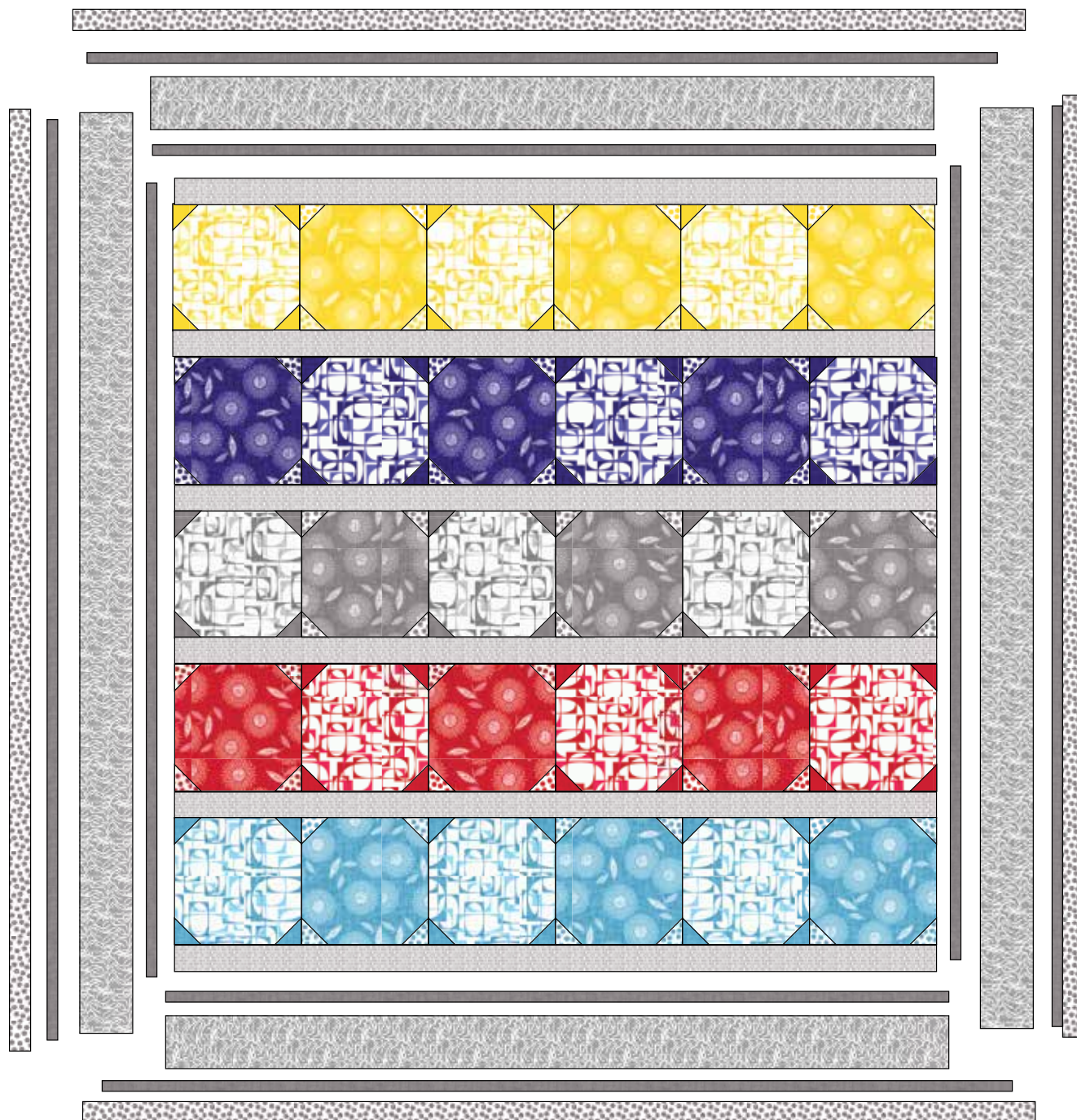

19. Following the Quilt Layout, sew (1) 1 ½" x 75 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 74 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
20. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 74 ½" Fabric V strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 87 ½" Fabric V strip to each side of the quilt top.
21. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 87 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 86 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.
22. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 89 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 90 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top.

### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

23. Press the quilt top and 98" x 101" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

### Binding

24. Cut the ends of the (9) Fabric L binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

25. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
