Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3418P-77 Panel – Navy) (3418P-58 Panel – Burgundy):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" panel.

Fabric B (3425-77 Texture – Navy) (3425-58 Texture – Burgundy), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43" strips.
- (2) 2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (7) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 ½" x 63 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 53 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 35 ½" WOF strips.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 85 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 2 ½" squares.
- (88) Template 4 triangles.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C (3424-11 Check – Lt. Blue) (3424-58 Check – Burgundy), cut:

- (3) 4 ¾" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¾" x 45" strips.
- (2) 4 ¾" x 33 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric D (3421-77 Animals – Navy) (3421-58 Animals – Burgundy), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 55 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 45 ½" WOF strips from the remaining fabric, piece as needed.

Fabric E (3423-90 Arrows – Gray) (3051-33 Brushstrokes – Mushroom), cut:

- (2) Template 1 triangles and (2) Template 2 triangles. Pay attention to the fabric direction when cutting.
- (88) Template 3 triangles.
- (88) Template 5 triangles.

Fabric F (3420-77 Landscape – Navy) (3420-58 Landscape – Burgundy), cut:

- (2) Template 1 triangles. Pay attention to the fabric direction when cutting.
- (2) Template 2 triangles. Pay attention to the fabric direction when cutting.

Fabric G (3422-77 Blanket Stripe – Navy) (3422-58 Blanket Stripe – Burgundy), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 63 ½" LOF strips.

Backing (3419-77 Patch – Navy) (3419-58 Patch – Burgundy), cut:

- (2) 93" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 73" x 93" for the back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise indicated.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2" x 26" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the block to measure 25" x 45" to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).



2. Place (1) Fabric E-Template 3 triangle on top of (1) Fabric B-Template 4 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 2). Sew the two triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

3. Place (1) Fabric E-Template 5 triangle on top of the Fabric B triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 3). Sew the two triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) EBE unit (Fig. 4). Trim to measure $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3".

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (88) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 3" EBE units.







5. Refer to the Quilt Photo for fabric direction and sew the Fabric E-Template 1 triangles, Fabric F-Template 1 triangles, Fabric E-Template 2 triangles and Fabric F-Template 2 triangles together as shown in Figures 5 & 6 to make the (2) EF side strips.





Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x 45" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $4\frac{3}{4}$ " x $33\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $53\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $35\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $55\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $45\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (26) EBE units together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.

10. Sew (18) EBE units together to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square to each end of both strips. Sew the resulting strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) EF side strip from Step 5 to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $63\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $85\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block to make the quilt top.


Layering, Quilting and Finishing

14. Press the quilt top and 73" x 93" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

15. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

16. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
