Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3797-99 Dogs and Sayings in Boxes – Black):

- Fussy cut (14) 7" blocks.

Fabric B (3794-99 Paw Prints with Hearts – Black), cut:

- (4) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (64) large triangles.
- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles.
- (5) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (28) 2" x 7" strips.
- (7) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (28) 2" x 10" strips.
- (1) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 7" strips.
- (1) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (8) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric C (3795-99 Dots and Hearts – Black), cut:

- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut the strips into (32) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric D (1351-Teal Just Color! – Teal), cut:

- (8) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (64) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (256) triangles.

Fabric E (1351-White Just Color! – Pigment White), cut:

- (6) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (48) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (192) triangles.

Fabric F (3792-1 Dog Words – White), cut:

- (3) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric G (3794-88 Paw Prints with Hearts – Red), cut:

- (4) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 3 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (64) large triangles.
- (1) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (8) 4 $\frac{1}{4}$ " squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) small triangles.

Fabric H (1351-Sunshine – Just Color! – Sunshine), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric I (3791-99 Dog Snapshots – Black), cut:

- (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 63 $\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (6) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 73 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".

Fabric J (3796-11 Dogs on Dots – Aqua), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 7" squares.

Backing (3796-11 Dogs on Dots – Aqua), cut:

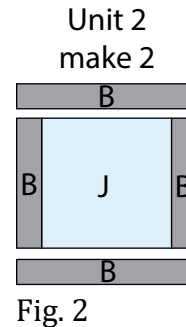
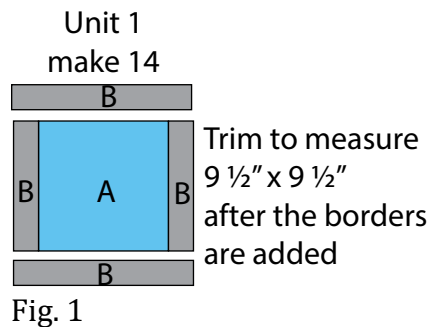
- (2) 81" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 81" x 81" for the back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $9\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (1) Unit 1 (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (14) Unit 1 blocks total.



3. Sew (1) Fabric B large triangle, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle together to make (1) Unit 3 block (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (32) Unit 3 blocks total.

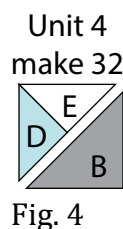
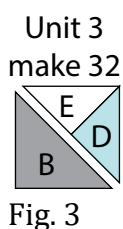
4. Sew (1) Fabric D triangle, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric B large triangle together to make (1) Unit 4 block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (32) Unit 4 blocks total.

5. Sew (1) Fabric G large triangle, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric D triangle together to make (1) Unit 5 block (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (32) Unit 5 blocks total.

6. Sew (1) Fabric D triangle, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric G large triangle together to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (32) Unit 6 blocks total.

7. Sew (2) Fabric D triangles, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric B small triangle together to make (1) Unit 7 block (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (32) Unit 7 blocks total.

8. Sew (2) Fabric D triangles, (1) Fabric E triangle and (1) Fabric G small triangle together to make (1) Unit 8 block (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (32) Unit 8 blocks total.



9. Follow Figure 9 and sew (4) 3 ½" Fabric C squares, (4) Unit 3 blocks, (4) Unit 4 blocks, (4) Unit 7 blocks and (1) Unit 1 together to make (1) Block One. Repeat to make (8) Block Ones total.

10. Follow Figure 10 and sew (4) 3 ½" Fabric F squares, (4) Unit 5 blocks, (4) Unit 6 blocks, (4) Unit 8 blocks and (1) Unit 1 together to make (1) Block Two. Repeat to make (6) Block Twos total.

11. Follow Figure 11 and sew (4) 3 ½" Fabric F squares, (4) Unit 5 blocks, (4) Unit 6 blocks, (4) Unit 8 blocks and (1) Unit 2 together to make (1) Block Three. Repeat to make a second Block Three.

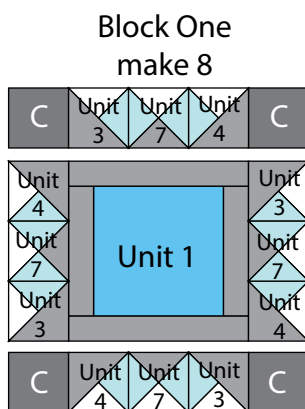

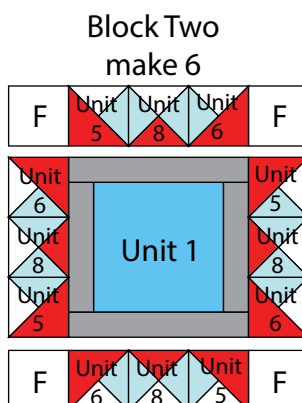

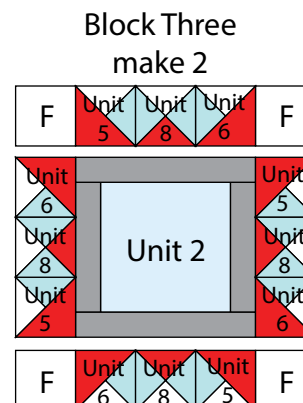

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

12. Sew (2) Block Ones and (2) Block Twos together, alternating them, to make Row One.

13. Sew (1) Block Two, (1) Block One, (1) Block Three and (1) Block One together, in that order, to make Row Two.

14. Sew (1) Block One, (1) Block Three, (1) Block One and (1) Block Two together, in that order, to make Row Three.

15. Sew (2) Block Twos and (2) Block Ones together, alternating them, to make Row Four.

16. Sew the (4) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 63 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 63 ½" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 73 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

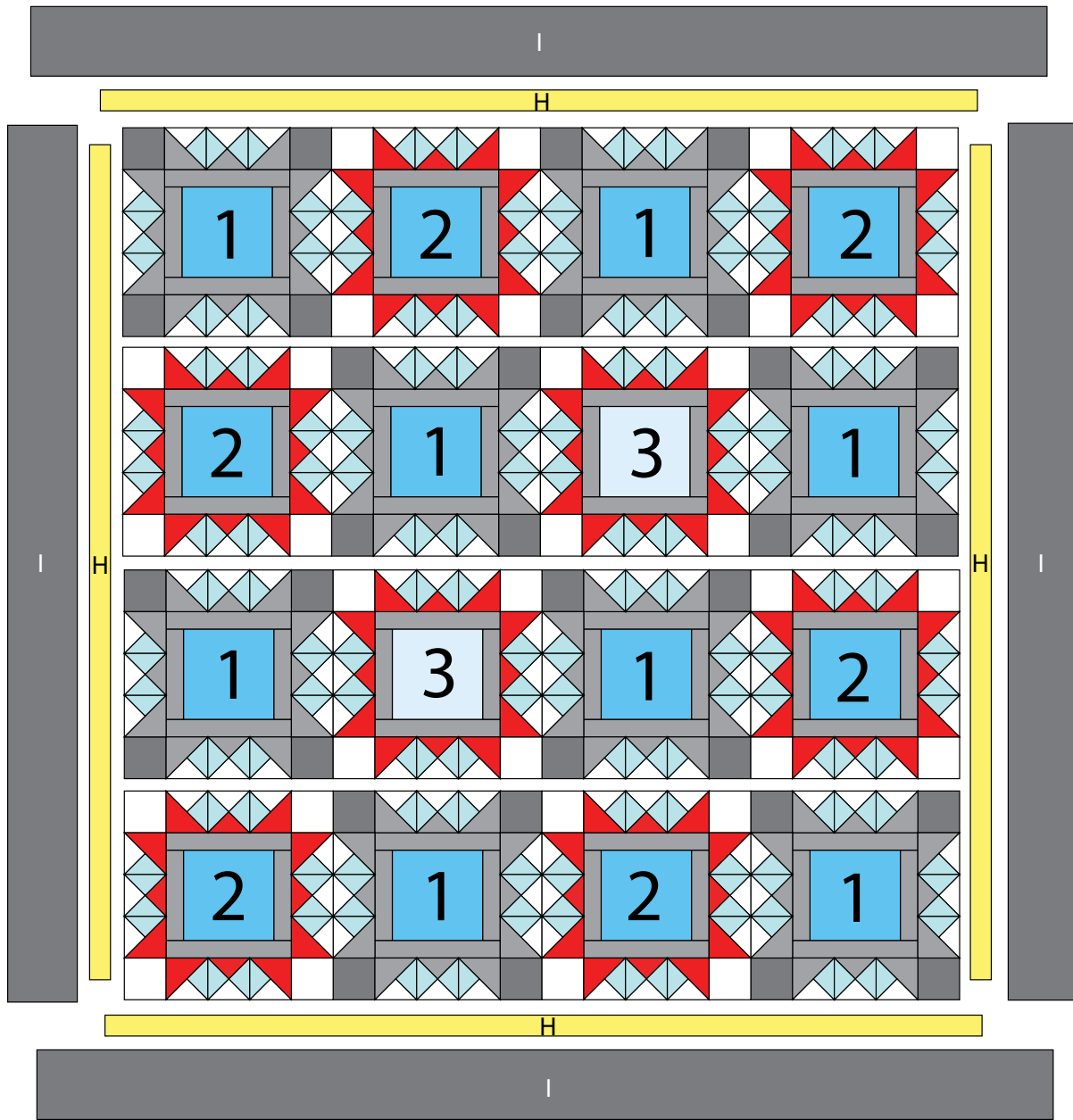
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

19. Press the quilt top and 81" x 81" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

20. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

21. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
