Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3666-41 Noah's Ark Patch – Cream/Blue):

- Fussy cut (1) 26 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " block.

Fabric B (3051-39 Brushstrokes – Bark), cut:

- (2) 3" x 32 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 31 $\frac{7}{8}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (2) 2" x 48 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- (3) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (2) 2" x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".
- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for binding.

Fabric C (3661-40 Noah's Boat – Light Cream), cut:

- (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips, sub-cut (8) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric D (45-Ink Peppered Cottons - Ink), cut:

- (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Fabric E (3664-11 Fish – Light Blue), cut:

- (2) 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips.

Fabric F (3665-43 Birds – Tan/Brown), cut:

- (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

Fabric G (3662-11 Tossed Animals – Light Blue), cut:

- (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 51 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 53 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing (3661-40 Noah's Boat – Light Blue), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 61" x 67" for the back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) $3'' \times 32 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $26 \frac{7}{8}'' \times 32 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric A block. Sew (1) $3'' \times 31 \frac{7}{8}''$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $30 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 36 \frac{1}{2}''$ to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF Fabric D and (1) $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times$ WOF Fabric E strip together lengthwise to make (1) DE strip set (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second DE strip set.
3. Cut the DE strips sets into (24) $3 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 6 \frac{1}{2}''$ DE strips (Fig. 3).
4. Sew (2) DE strips together to make (1) DD block (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (12) DD blocks total. Pay attention to the orientation of the strips.

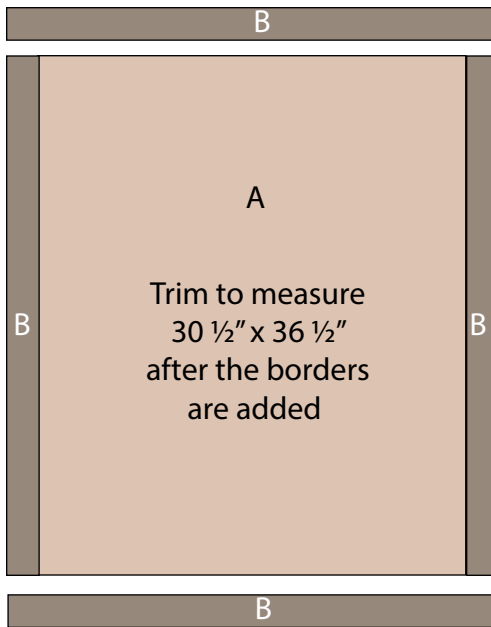

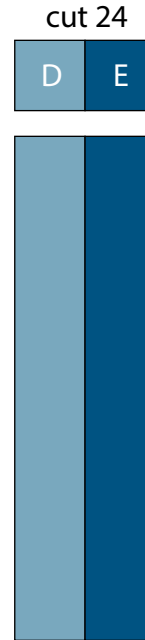

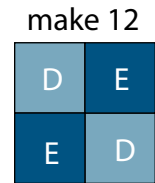

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

5. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric C square, (1) DD block, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}'' \times 12 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric F strip, (1) DD block and (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric C square together, in that order, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew (1) DD block, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric C square, (1) DD block, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric F square, (1) DD block, (1) $6 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric C square and (1) DD block together, in that order, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $2'' \times 48 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2'' \times 45 \frac{1}{2}''$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 51 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 53 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

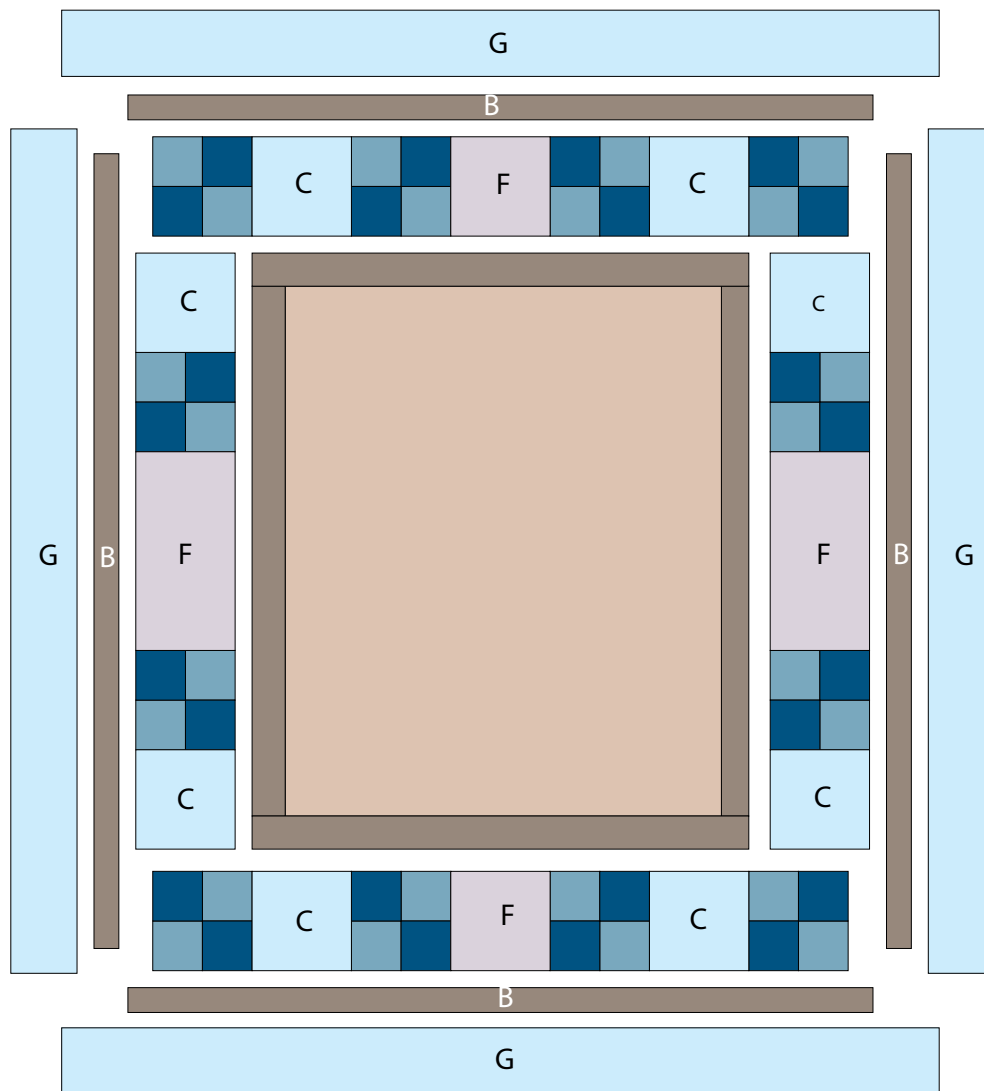
Layering, Quilting and Finishing

9. Press the quilt top and 61" x 67" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

10. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

11. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
