 (B) F3300-77 3/8 yard
 (C) F3298-11 3/4 yard
 (D) F3295-71 1 7/8 yards
 (E) Solid White**..... 1/4 yard
 (F) Solid Red** 1 1/8 yards
 (G) Solid Black**..... 1 yard*

Backing
 F3296-77 5 yards

*Includes binding
 **Fluffy Solid Collection

Additional Supplies Needed

Batting 72" x 89"
 Piecing and sewing thread
 Quilting and sewing supplies

Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (F3294-77 Christmas Boxes – Navy), cut:

- (2) 12 ½" x 64 ½" LOF strips.
- Fussy cut (10) individual boxes.

Fabric B (F3300-77 Snowflakes – Navy), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 5 ½" x 64 ½" strip.

Fabric C (F3298-11 Allover Santas – Lt. Blue), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 64 ½" strips.

Fabric D (F3295-71 Christmas Stripe – Blue), cut:

- (2) 11 ½" x 64 ½" LOF strips.

Fabric E (Fluffy Solid White), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

Fabric F (Fluffy Solid Red), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.

Fabric G (Fluffy Solid Black), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

Backing (F3296-77 Snowmen & Penguins – Royal Blue), cut:

- (2) 89" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 72" x 89" for the back.

Sewing

Sew using a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. After cutting the (2) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " LOF strips, add fusible web to the remaining Fabric A fabric and fussy cut (10) individual boxes. Roughly cut out each box about $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn lines.
2. Cut out each box on the drawn lines.
3. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (10) boxes onto the $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip.
4. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the Fabric B strip (Fig. 1).

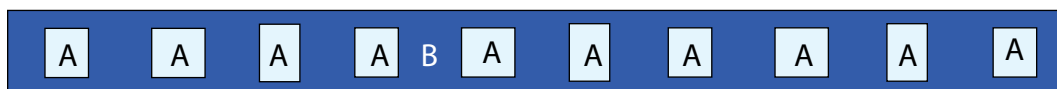

5. Sew (16) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E squares and (16) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F squares together, alternating them, to make (1) EF strip (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second EF strip.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

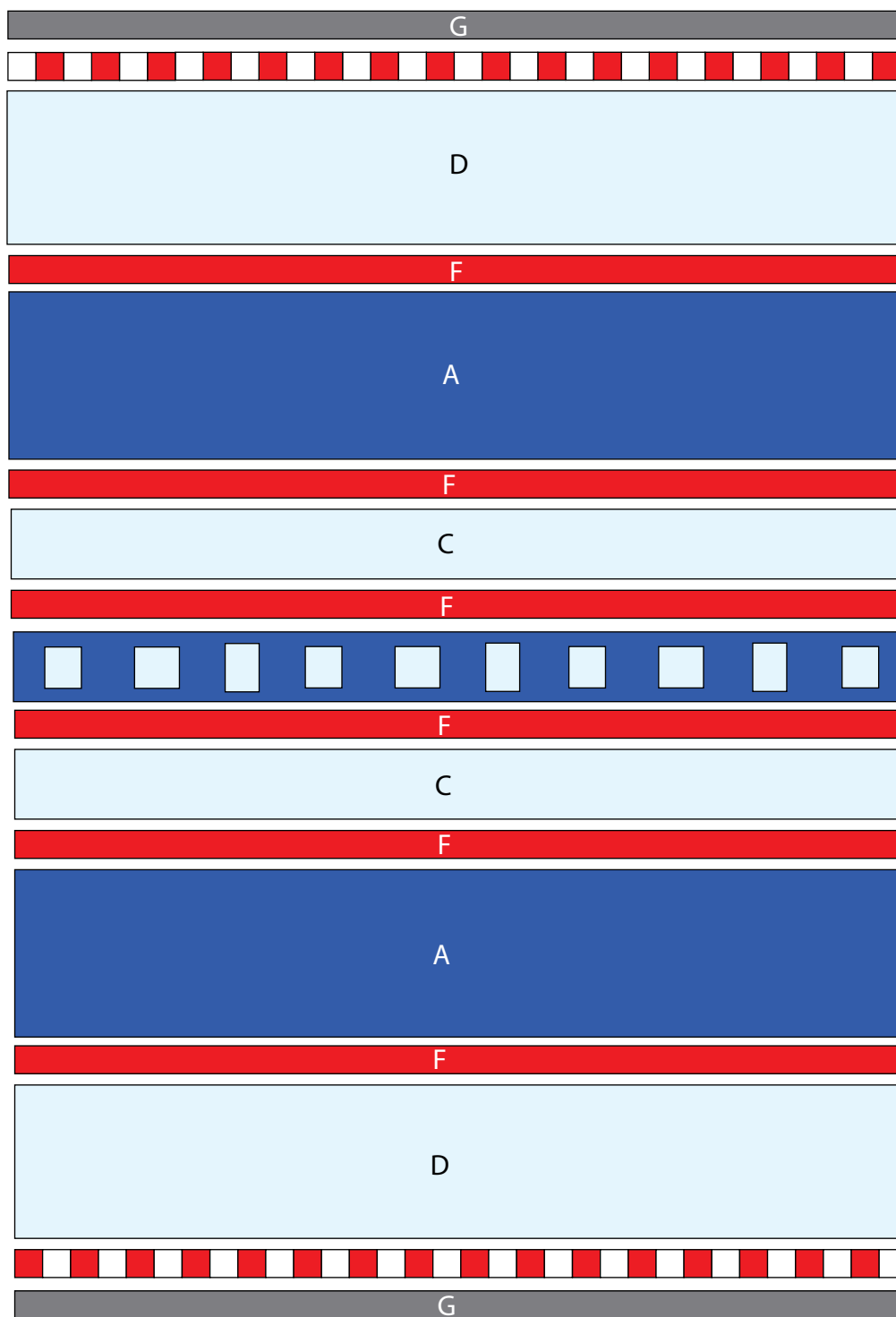
6. Sew the assorted strips together lengthwise in the order shown to make the quilt top. Pay attention to the orientation of the EF strips.

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

7. Press the quilt top and 72 " x 89 " backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

8. Cut the ends of the (8) Fabric G binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
9. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
