SUPPLIES

Wall Hanging Front - 1 Brushstrokes Fat Quarter Bundle Backing - 5/8 yard Batting - 22" x 30" Lightweight fusible web - 17" x 27"

CUT FROM EACH FAT QUARTER

Seam allowance of 1/4" included in all pieces.

Crimson, Kale, Indigo, Mulberry:

1 - 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"; 1 - Template A & B

1 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/4" (binding)

Tangerine, Gold, Sprout, Shamrock, Horizon Blue, Bahama Blue, Lotus Pink:

1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"; 1 - Template B 1 - 2 1/2" x 8 1/4" (binding)

1 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"; 1 - Template B; 4 - Template D

1 - 2 1/2" x 21" (binding)

Parchment:

5 - 2" x 5 1/2"; 5 - Template C

Mushroom:

4 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"; 5 - 2" x 5 1/2"; 5 - Template C

Pewter:

4 - 3 1/2" x 6 1/2"; 5 - 2" x 7 1/2"; 5 - 2" x 5 1/2"; 5 - Template C

Raven:

5 - 2" x 5 1/2"; 5 - Template C



INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Trace templates on paper side of lightweight fusible web. Fuse on specified fabric. Cut out on drawn line; remove paper backing and fuse to background color listed. Secure edges using coordinating thread and small zigzag stitch.
- 2. Sew rectangles together in columns; press as shown.
- 3. Sew columns together, alternating Column A with a color series Column B as shown on the quilt.
- 4. Layer back, batting, and front. Baste together with safety pins. Free motion echo quilt following the applique shapes. Trim excess batting and backing even with the
- 5. Sew the binding strips together end to end. Fold in half lengthwise. Sew to front, matching raw edges. Sew by hand to the back.



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
