Cutting

Fabric A	 F2827P-22	 F2827P-11	1 panel	Cutting instructions on page 3.
Fabric B	 F2832-22	 F2832-11	½ yard	Cut 4 - 2 ½" x 27 ½" strips
Fabric C	 F2831-22	 F2831-11	¾ yard	Cut 2 - 1 ½" x 31 ½" strips Cut 2 - 1 ½" x 29 ½" strips
Fabric D	 F2828-22	 F2828-11	¾ yard	Cut 2 - 4 ½" x 33 ½" strips Cut 2 - 4 ½" x 29 ½" strips
Fabric E	 F2831-66	 F2831-66	½ yard	Cut 2 - 2 ½" x 33 ½" strips Cut 2 - 2 ½" x 29 ½" strips
Fabric F	 F2829-22	 F2829-11	⅝ yard	Cut 6 - 2 ½" x width of fabric strips (binding)

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance, with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Press as shown by arrows.

Quilt Center:

1. Trim Fabric A to one 23 ½" x 27 ½" rectangle and four 6 ½" squares according to Fig. 1.
2. Quilt Center should measure 23 ½" x 27 ½".

Borders:

3. Attach side inner borders using the 2 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric B strips. Attach top and bottom inner borders using the 2 ½" x 27 ½" Fabric B strips. (Fig. 2)
4. Attach side middle borders using the 1 ½" x 31 ½" Fabric C strips. Attach top and bottom middle borders using the 1 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric C strips. (Fig. 3)
5. Assemble one 2 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric E strip and one 4 ½" x 29 ½" Fabric D strip. Top/Bottom Outer Border Unit should measure 6 ½" x 29 ½". Repeat one more time. Make two. (Fig. 4)
6. Assemble one 2 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric E strip and one 4 ½" x 33 ½" Fabric D strip. Side Outer Border Strip should measure 6 ½" x 33 ½". Repeat one more time. Make two. (Fig. 5)
7. Assemble two 6 ½" Fabric A squares and one Top/Bottom Outer Border Strip. Top Outer Border Strip should measure 6 ½" x 41 ½". Make one. (Fig. 6)
8. Assemble two 6 ½" Fabric A squares and one Top/Bottom Outer Border Strip. Bottom Outer Border Strip should measure 6 ½" x 41 ½". Make one. (Fig. 7)
9. Attach side outer borders using the Side Outer Border Strips. Attach top and bottom outer borders using the Top Outer Border Strip and the Bottom Outer Border Strip. (Fig. 8)

Layering, Quilting and Finishing:

10. Trim selvages from the backing fabric and sew two 53" x width of fabric strips together. Trim the sewn pieces to make one 49" x 53" backing piece.

Binding:

11. Press the quilt top and backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.
12. Cut the ends of six 2 ½" Fabric F binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make a continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.

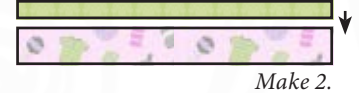

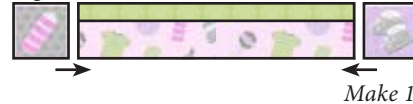

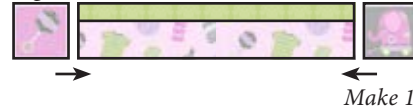
