## Fabric Requirements

### Blue Version

(A) 2953P-11 .....	1 panel
(B) 2956-77 .....	1 ½ yards*
(C) 2957-08 .....	1 yard
(D) 1351-Red** .....	⅓ yard
(E) 2954-11 .....	¾ yard
(F) 2956-88 .....	⅝ yard
Backing 2955-11 .....	3 yards

### Pink Version

(A) 2953P-22 .....	1 panel
(B) 2956-88 .....	1 ½ yards*
(C) 2957-08 .....	1 yard
(D) 1351-Blush** ...	⅞ yard
(E) 2954-22 .....	¾ yard
Backing 2955-22 .....	3 yards

Piecing and sewing thread

## Cutting

### Cutting Instructions

*Please Note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### **Blue Version**

##### **Fabric A (2953P-11 Panel – Blue):**

- Fussy cut (1) panel, approximately 23 ½" x 42 ½".

##### **Fabric B (2956-77 Stars – Blue), cut:**

- See instructions to cut (15) stars.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonals seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 27 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

##### **Fabric C (2957-8 Circles – White), cut:**

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (15) 6 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" strips.

##### **Fabric D (1351-Red Just Color! – Red), cut:**

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 30 ½" strips.

##### **Fabric E (2954-11 Bears in Frames – Blue):**

- Fussy cut (15) 6 ½" squares, each centered on a character.

##### **Fabric F (2956-88 Stars – Red), cut:**

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

##### **Backing (2955-11 Tossed Bears – Blue), cut:**

- (2) 54" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and cut (1) 54" x 72" piece for the backing.

## Cutting - Cont.

### *Pink Version*

#### **Fabric A (2953P-22 Panel – Pink):**

- Fussy cut (1) panel, approximately 23 ½" x 42 ½".

#### **Fabric B (2956-88 Stars – Red), cut:**

- See instructions to cut (15) stars.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonals seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" strips and (2) 2 ½" x 27 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### **Fabric C (2957-8 Circles – White), cut:**

- (3) 6 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (15) 6 ½" squares.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 28 ½" strips.

#### **Fabric D (1351-Red Just Color! – Blush), cut:**

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 30 ½" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

#### **Fabric E (2954-22 Bears in Frames – Pink):**

- Fussy cut (15) 6 ½" squares, each centered on a character.

#### **Backing (2955-11 Tossed Bears – Pink), cut:**

- (2) 54" x WOF strips. Piece the strips together and cut (1) 54" x 72" piece for the backing.



## Sewing

Sew using a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### Block Assembly

1. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the  $23\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $42\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $27\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. Trim the panel to  $25\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the center block (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1)  $2$ " x  $44\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 2).
3. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $46\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $30\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 3).

4. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web.
5. Roughly cut out each template about  $\frac{1}{8}$ " outside the drawn lines.
6. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
7. Refer to the quilt photo to arrange and press the (15) Fabric B stars onto the (15)  $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C squares.  
[Use the (15) hearts for the Pink version of the quilt.]

8. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the (15) Star (*or Heart*) blocks (Fig. 4).

9. Sew (4) Star (*or Heart*) blocks and (4) 6 ½" Fabric E squares together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) strip to each side of the center block (Fig. 5).

10. Sew (4) 6 ½" Fabric E blocks and (3) Star (*or Heart*) blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the top of the center block (Fig. 6).



11. Sew (4) Star (*or Heart*) blocks and (3) 6 ½" Fabric E blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) strip. Sew this strip to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top (Fig. 6).

### Quilt Top Assembly

12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric F (*Fabric D for the Pink version*) strip to each side of the quilt top. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric F (*Fabric D for the Pink version*) to the top and to the bottom of the quilt top (Fig. 7).

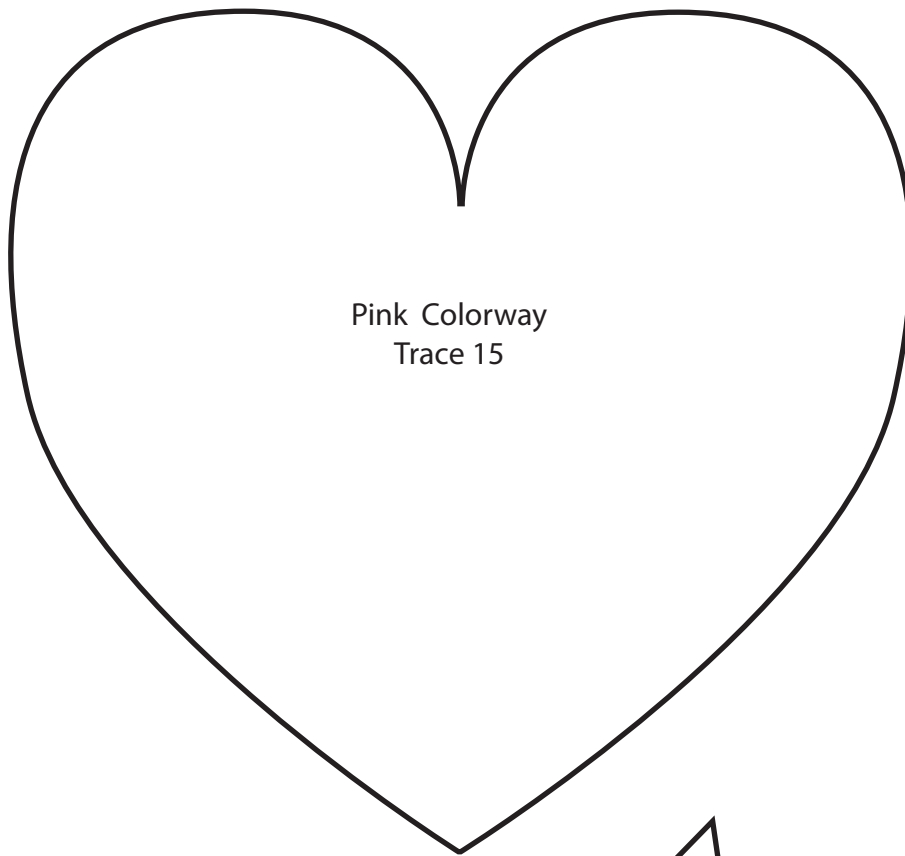
### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

13. Press the quilt top and 54" x 72" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

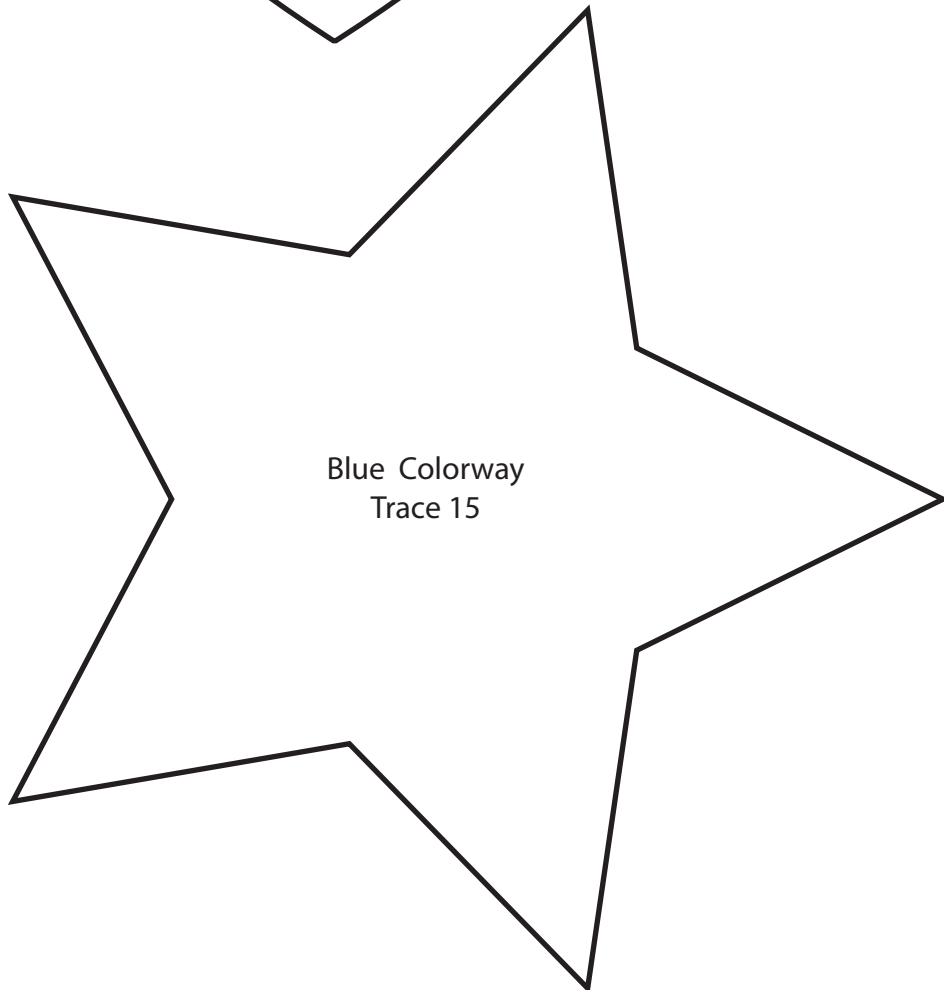
### Binding

14. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric B binding strips at 45-degree angles and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

15. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
