Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (4161-93 Magazine Covers - Multi):

• Fussy cut (8) 9" x 11" blocks.

Fabric B (Flame-16 Peppered Cottons - Flame), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric C (Cottage Rose-06 Peppered Cottons – Cottage Rose), cut:

- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

Fabric D (Charcoal-14 Peppered Cottons – Charcoal), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric E (Lagoon Blue-78 Peppered Cottons – Lagoon Blue), cut:

- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (4) 2 ¹/₂" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric F (Aluminum-60 Peppered Cottons – Aluminum), cut:

- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 2 ¹/₂" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.

Fabric G (4163-93 Headshots – Multi), cut:

• (1) 11" x 9" LOF strip.

Fabric H (Deep Space-98 Peppered Cottons - Deep Space), cut:

- (1) 5 ¹/₂" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5 ¹/₂" squares.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2" x 11" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (16) 2" x 12" strips.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 1 ¼" x 11" strips.
- (1) 1 ¼" x WOF strip, sub-cut (2) 1 ¼" x 10 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric I (4165-91 Gossip Newspaper – Black/White), cut:

- (3) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips, sub-cut (6) 4 ¹/₂" x 16 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) 4 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) 3" x 56 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) 3" x 55 1/2" strips.

Fabric J (4168-99 Marquis Words – Black), cut:

- (4) $5\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) $5\frac{1}{2}$ x $61\frac{1}{2}$ strips.
- (3) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end, matching patterns, and cut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Fabric K (4168-22 Marquis Words - Pink), cut:

• See instructions to cut (4) stars.

Backing (4167-90 Tossed Doggies - Gray), cut:

• (2) 73" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 73" x 79" to make the back.

Sewing

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) 9" x 11" Fabric A block. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A block. Trim the block to measure $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make (1) Unit 1 block (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (8) Unit 1 blocks total.



2. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Block One rectangle.

3. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

4. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $14\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.

5. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 block to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make a second Block Four rectangle.



6. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{14}{7}$ x 11" Fabric H strip to each side of the 9" x 11" Fabric G strip. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{14}{7}$ x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric G strip to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 6).

7. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $12\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x $14\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 block to make (1) Block Five rectangle (Fig. 7).

8. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

9. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

10. Refer to Figure 8 to arrange and press (1) Fabric K star onto the center of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H square.

11. Finish the raw edges of the star with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Corner Block.

12. Repeat Steps 10-11 to make (4) Corner Blocks total.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

13. Sew (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Three rectangle together lengthwise and in that order to make Row One.

14. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Five rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Four rectangle together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Two.

15. Sew (1) Block Three rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 4 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block One rectangle together lengthwise and in that order to make Row Three.

16. Sew the (3) rows, in numerical order, and (2) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strips together lengthwise, alternating them, to make the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) 3" x 56 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3" x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ x $61\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) Corner Block to each end of (1) $5\frac{1}{2}$ x $55\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.







Layering, Quilting and Finishing

19. Press the quilt top and 73" x 79" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

20. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric H binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.

21. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.





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
