







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# **Cutting**

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

#### Fabric A (3975-9 Skyline Silhouette Stripe - Black/White):

- Fussy cut (2) 10 ½" x 60 ½" LOF strips, each centered on (3) skyline strips.
- Fussy cut (1) 14 ½" x 60 ½" LOF strip, centered on (4) skyline strips.

#### Fabric B (1351-Red Just Color! - Red), cut:

- (12) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (8) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 5 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### Fabric C (3974-99 State Words - Black), cut:

• (6)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$  x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$  strips.

#### Fabric D (3972-99 Sunglasses - Black), cut:

• (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (20) 5 ½" squares.

#### Fabric E (3977-99 State Labels - Black), cut:

• Back the fabric with fusible web and fussy cut (8) vertical postcards and (12) horizontal postcards.

#### Fabric F (1351-Grass Just Color! - Grass), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (6) 5 ½" squares.

#### Fabric G (1351-Aegean Blue Just Color! - Aegean Blue), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.

#### Fabric H (1351-Pigment White Just Color! - Pigment White), cut:

- (10) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips, sub-cut (40) 1 ½" x 5 ½" strips.

#### Fabric I (1351-Sunshine Just Color! - Sunshine), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.

#### Backing (3973-18 Travel Motifs - White/Multi), cut:

• (2) 68" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 68" x 84" for the back.

# **Sewing**

Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

### **Block Assembly**

1. Sew (1)  $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of (1)  $2 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.




- 2. Center (1) Fabric E horizontal postcard on (1) 5 ½" Fabric F square.
- 3. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make (1) Unit 2 block (Fig. 2).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (6) Unit 2 blocks total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and use Figures 3 through 5 for fabric identification to make the designated number of units.
- 6. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 5 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) 5 ½" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 6 block (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (20) Unit 6 blocks total.



7. Sew (5) assorted Units (2-5) and (5) Unit 6 blocks together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Unit 7 strip.



8. Sew (5) Unit 6 blocks and (5) assorted Units (2-5) together, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 8 strip.



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9. Sew (3) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric H strips, (1) Unit 7 and (1) Unit 8 strip together lengthwise, alternating the Fabric H strips and unit strips, to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make a second Unit 9 strip.



### **Quilt Top Assembly**

### (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)


- 10. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of (1)  $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 60  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip lengthwise.
- 11. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn strip.
- 12. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn strip.
- 13. Sew (1) 10 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the sewn strip to make the quilt top.

### Layering, Quilting and Finishing

14. Press the quilt top and 68" x 84" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

## **Binding**

- 15. Cut the ends of the (7) Fabric B binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 16. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
