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Cutting

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge.

WOF= Width of Fabric • LOF = Length of Fabric

Fabric A (3026P-88 36" Panel - Red), cut:

• (1) 34 ½" x 42 ½" strip.

Fabric B (3030-77 Stripe - Royal), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips, sub-cut (2) 2" x 42 ½" and (2) 2" x 37 ½" strips.

Fabric C (Blue Jay-41 Peppered Cottons - Blue Jay), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x 44 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 39 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric D (3032-46 Mini Wheels - Lime), cut:

- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 41 ½" WOF strips.

Fabric E (Ink-45 Peppered Cottons - Ink), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sew strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 2" x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips and (2) 2" x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

Fabric F (3029-88 Bubble Characters - Red), cut:

- (3) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew strips together, end to end with diagonal seams, and cut (2) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

Backing (3027-88 Patch - Red), cut:

• (2) 62" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together and trim to 62" x 70" for the back.

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Sew using a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise indicated. Always press towards the darker fabric while assembling, unless otherwise noted by the arrows.

Quilt Top Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 34 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A strip. Sew (1) 2" x 37 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A strip to make the center block. Trim the center block to measure 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " (Fig. 1).

2. Sew (1) 2" x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 2" x 39 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 2).



3. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 3).



4. Sew (1) 2" x 49 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 2" x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block (Fig. 4).



5. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 52 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of the center block. Sew (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 54 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the center block to make the quilt top (Fig. 5).

Layering, Quilting and Finishing

6. Press the quilt top and 62" x 70" backing well. Layer backing (wrong side up), batting, pressed quilt top (right side up) and baste. Quilt as desired and trim excess batting and backing when quilting is complete.

Binding

- 7. Cut the ends of the (6) Fabric E binding strips at a 45-degree angle and sew end to end to make (1) continuous piece of binding. Fold in half lengthwise and press wrong sides together.
- 8. Sew the binding to the front of the quilt, raw edges together. Turn the folded edge to the back, and hand stitch in place.
